House Ways, Means For 22-Month, Cent Increase in Gas Tax

Washington, Aug. 25 (AP)—The House Ways and Means committee today voted down a compromise proposal to solve the highway financing crisis.

By passage of the Ways and Means Committee revenue raising proposal, continuation on the 41¢ per gallon gasoline tax would be able to continue next year at a rate of \$1,800,000,000 and in 1969 at a rate of \$2,000,000,000.

This is only slightly under the present 42¢ per gallon tax. The committee also agreed to a 22-month increase in the federal gasoline tax.

It turned down a vote of 15-12 Rayburn's compromise which would limit the penny increase in the gas tax to one year instead of 22 months.

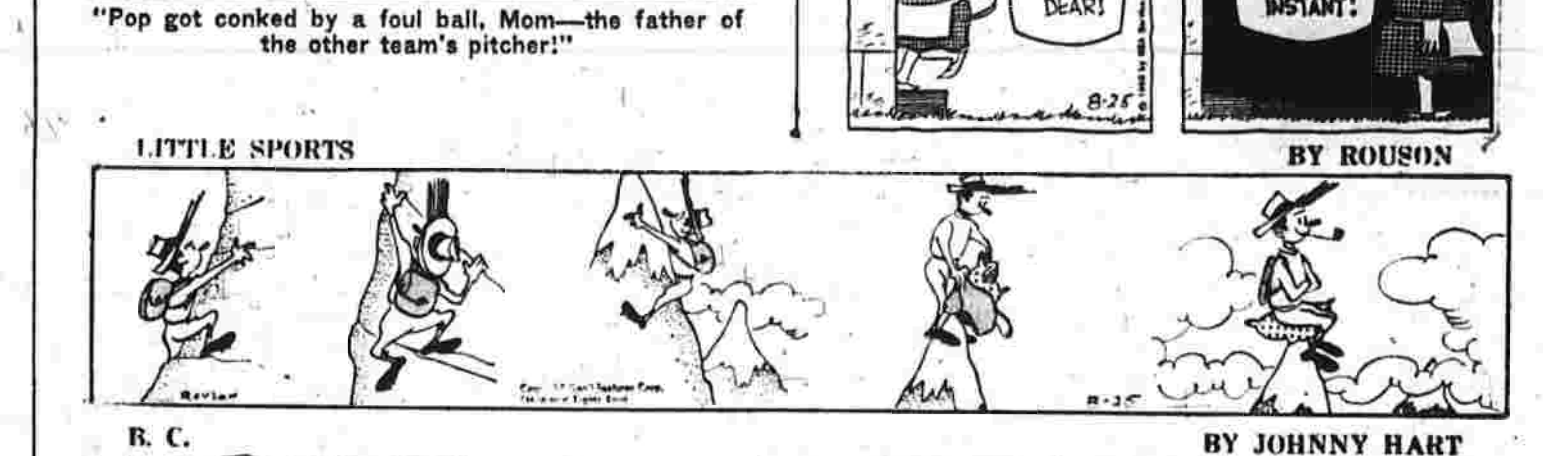
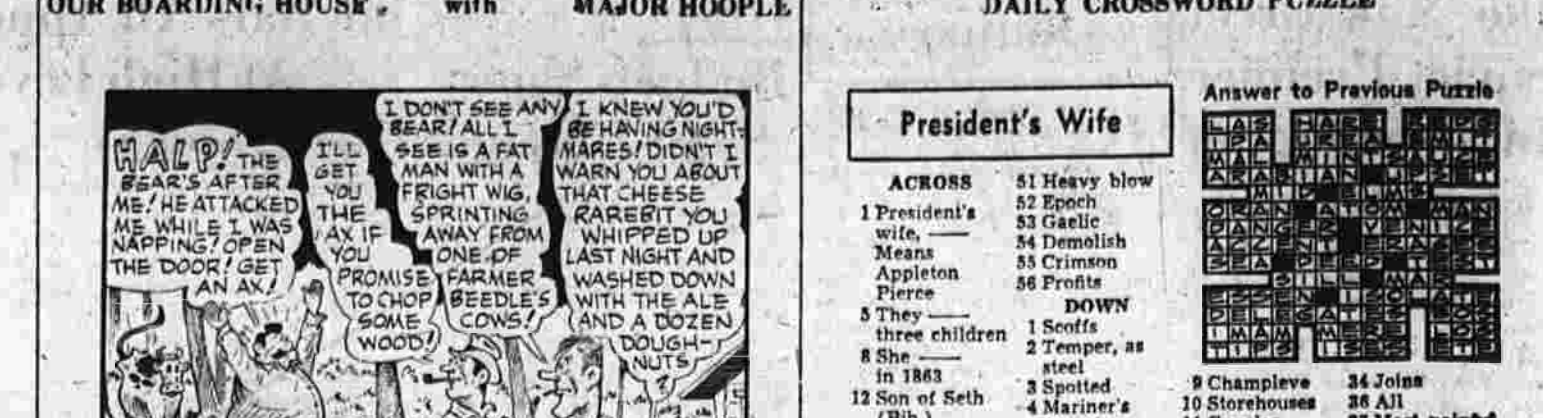
