Hebron Latest Town Report Shows \$8,435 Gain in Fiscal Year

Figure in the Hebron town report for 1958-59. Just released shows that budget operations resulted in a gain for the town of \$8,435.33, mainly attributed to economies in government and recovery of highway funds not previously accounted for by the town.

The budgeted indebtedness of the town has been reduced from \$109,000 to \$88,000. An additional \$10,000 which financed the change to the uniform fiscal year will be returned each year during the 1960 and 1961 fiscal years. The town is further obliged for its proportionate share of the bonded indebtedness of the regional school district.
