Mayor Backs Stand On West End Sewer

Mayor Eugene T. Kelly last night told the Democratic Town Committee his views about the West End sewer.

He struck down arguments which have been raised by his fellow Democratic Director John Hutchinson and Republican Director Robert Barnes in connection with the controversial project.

Kelly said Hutchinson's stand that it should be financed by a sewer department bond issue would mean its death on the voting machines.

And he branded Barnes arguing that only those who benefit from a sewer should pay for it as impracticable in the West Side and illustrative of the "Republican philosophy" in past Manchester sewer schemes.

The project now planned will remain "the only reasonable solution," the mayor said, unless General Manager Richard Martin comes up with better engineering or financing plans in the months after the West Siders' recently proposed are awaiting action.

West Siders appealed because they felt the town should have financed the \$97,455 force main and pump station in its entirety.

West Side home owners were assessed 40 per cent and the town sewer users the Sewer Department bond issue should pay for the project.

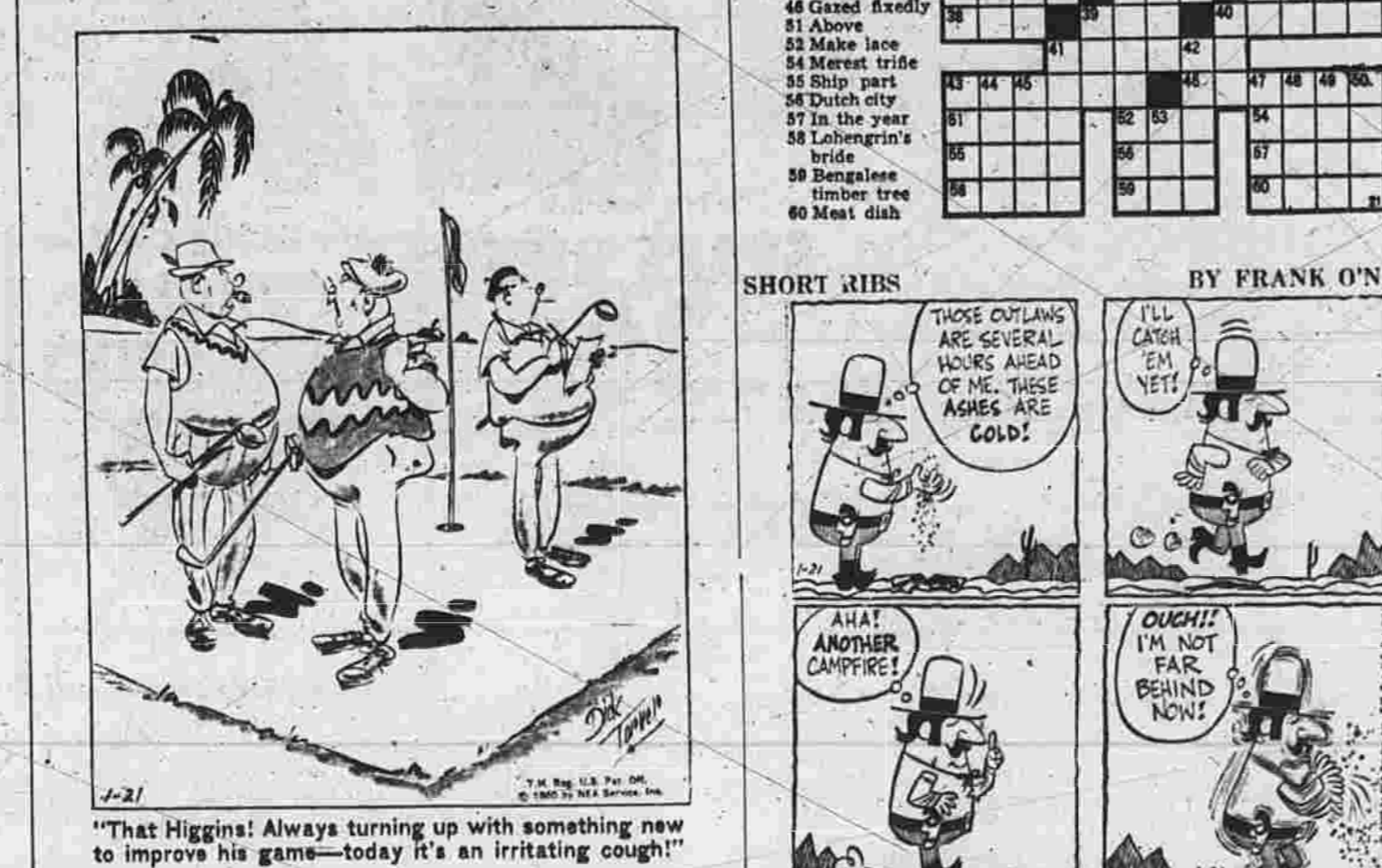
