

## Johnson Aims at Rights Bill on Rights

Washington, Feb. 15 (AP)—Senate Democratic leader Lyndon B. Johnson (D-Tex.) announced today that he would introduce legislation to give civil rights a priority in the Senate. Johnson said he would introduce a bill to give the Senate the right to act on civil rights bills without the usual 60-vote supermajority.

### Shea Tells GOP

## Consolidation Held Key Election Issue

By BOB SHAW

Consolidation was the key issue Republicans must face to reap victory in the March 20 primary, according to the Republican Party's chief strategist, Governor John P. Shea Jr., addressing a GOP Lincoln Day luncheon at the Manchester Country Club, said consolidating town and eighth district fire and sewer services is the only way to encourage industrial development and ease the tax burden on homeowners.

"The lack of water and sewer services is the only way to encourage industrial development and ease the tax burden on homeowners," Shea said.

Shea said the "parking lot" at Manchester could be salvaged if the new Pulte-Bruhn plant built across the town line in East Hartford.

In calling for consolidation, the GOP town chairman said "we can no longer afford to cater to the whims of the people who are motivated by sentiment and narrow self-interest."

"The overall good of the town must prevail," he declared.

He said the entire town, not just the eighth district, must take on the burden of industrial development in the northwest.

Shea offered consolidation as the key plank for the GOP platform aimed at regaining town control next fall.

He said also that the town must be prepared to take over the Manchester Water Co. if the firm "fails to measure up to the needs required for future development and (is) unable to substantially improve its present services."

Another program, Shea continued, might be a system whereby the town would acquire options on good industrial sites to stop inflated prices set by land owners from driving away prospective industries. This would strengthen the Town Development Commission's bargaining hand, Shea said.

Citywide possible programs suggested by the chairman were: (1) better use of the globe helmet tract; (2) continued highway improvement; and (3) improvement of the water system in accordance with "underwriters' recommendations."

Shea's suggestions for a GOP platform followed a scoring of the Democratic administration in office since 1958.

The only Democratic accomplishment, Shea claimed, were "carrying to completion programs initiated by pure Republican leaders."

Continuing, Shea said the administration accomplished little despite "21 opposition to the Country Club desire for a swimming pool, (2) the failure to hold a hearing on accusations by Democratic Director John Hutchinson against General Manager Richard Martin (4) the handling of the town's sewer issue, and (5) conduct at directors' meetings."

Of Hutchinson, Shea said, "since he has consistently disagreed with the Democratic policies, for which
