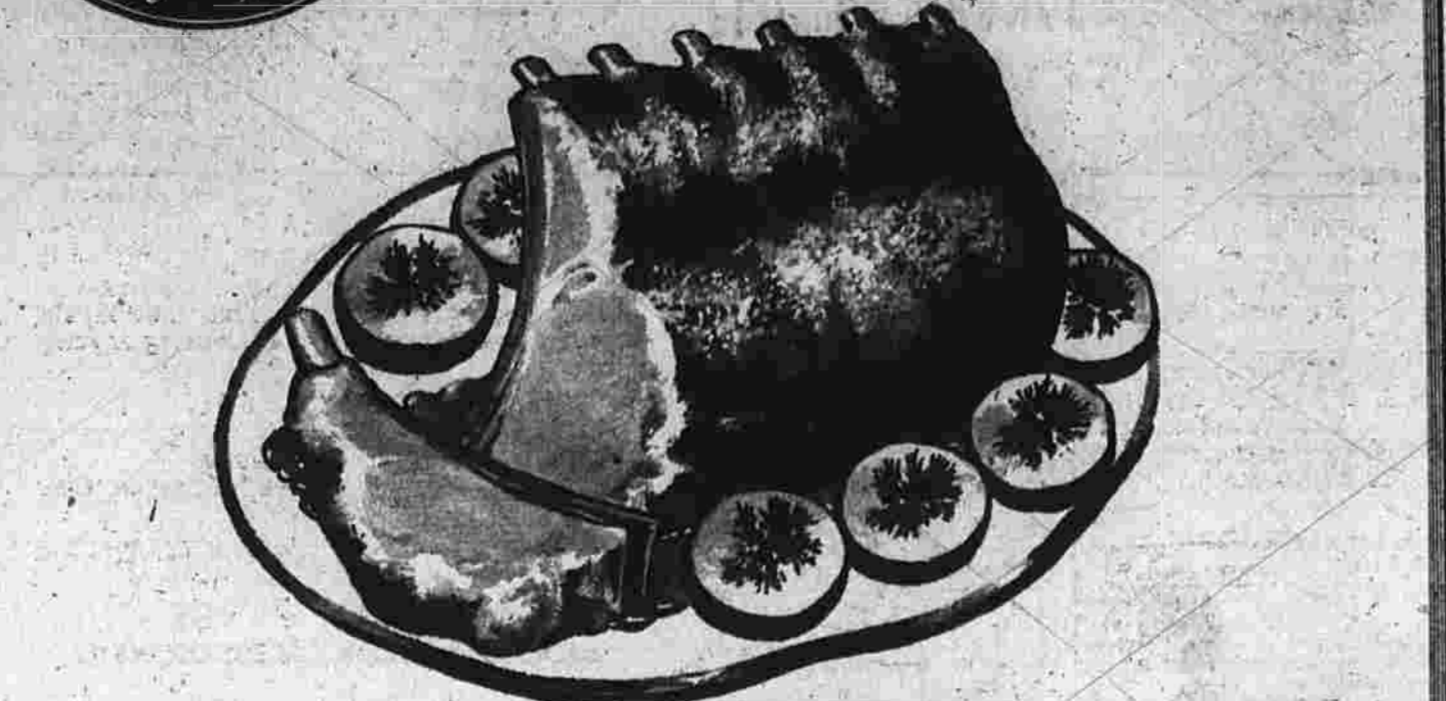

Reds Rap Bonn Bases in Spain

Moscow, March 4 (AP)—The Soviet government protested to West Germany today against any plan to establish supply and training bases in Spain.

The protest was contained in a note headed to West German Ambassador Hans Kroll today, Deputy Foreign Minister Alexander Kori.

Contents of the note were not immediately disclosed but the Russian press reported that the Germans were negotiating with Spain for supply and training bases, and that such activity was a threat to peace.

The Soviet press has been full of denunciations of the proposed bases in Spain, and has also demanded that the Germans be expelled from Spain.

A writer in Pravda today accused Denmark and Norway, accusing them of permitting German bases to be established on their soil. The article demanded in effect whether the Danes and Norwegians had forgotten Hitler.

"Denmark and Norway are already no longer neutral," the West German press said, "but are territorial claims to neighboring states."

Pravda today said that the Soviet government was "not prepared to discuss the question of the establishment of German bases in Spain."

Quake Area Facing Threat of Pestilence

was carrying 1,500 French crates from Casablanca. The U.S. Coast Guard, which was on duty in the area, put its entire crew at the disposal of the Moroccan government.

A water purification unit from the U.S. Army Engineers began operations in Agadir yesterday. It is able to supply five tons of much needed drinking water per hour.

A U.S. Air Force colonel announced that 3,600 tons of 12 tons of food, 1,500 beds and 3,500 blankets have been flown in by American planes so far.

Dr. Cyril F. Naylor, a representative of the World Council of Churches, visited the city yesterday and distributed thousands of blankets, food parcels and medical supplies.

But the plight of the Moslem refugees remained acute. They built up in the tent cities hungry, exhausted, many with unhealed injuries.

The Moroccan Council of Ministers is meeting in Agadir today to decide whether Agadir can be rebuilt. King Mohammed VI said that the city would be rebuilt but doubts have been voiced that the area could economically be made habitable. Before the quake it was the port for a rich agricultural and mining section.

A Moroccan official denied reports that the entire city would be demolished, but only after all living persons had been rescued. Less than a fourth of the city was undamaged after the quake.

INLOCK SOLVES

TRICKY PROBLEM

By Alfred Shelnwold

Declaring his hand is usually stronger than the dummy. When the reverse is true, the problem of finding an entry to the dummy becomes entangled in the problem of reaching your own hand.

If you're a fast count, you can count five cards in this hand: five clubs, two diamonds, one heart and one spade. The trumps are there, but it isn't so easy to cash them.

After you take the ace of spades, you lead a club to dummy's ace. Then how do you get back to your own hand to run the rest of the clubs?

If you're thinking of the jack of diamonds, better think again! East would be delighted to take the queen of diamonds and four spades.

The Way Back

The way to get back to the South hand is never to leave it. Hold up the ace of spades until you can reach your own hand. If you take the ace of spades and then cash the top clubs in the "bills," "Aha!" you exclaim on the next deal. East says: "I don't take a third spade. East says: 'I don't take a third spade and then shift to the king of hearts.' A very pretty defense, except that you don't have a singleton spade in real life. East would just cash his spades and you'd make your contract.
