directions. Soon a handful of paratroopers rounded up about 50 members of the Force Publique. They refused to give up their arms at first but when a Belgian officer began shouting they quickly handed them over.

Standing in front of the airport the AP correspondent could see Congolese troops heading in from across the airfield to the empty spaces beyond.

Every trainee across the Congo river from Leopoldville to Brazzaville, capital of the neighboring Congo Republic which has received 6,000 white refugees so far, was re-established through the intervention of a Congolese minister, the Belgian minister, and the UN.

Lumumba accused Belgian aggression against the new Congo Republic and charged the Belgians with deliberately provoking the Congolese movement in Katanga Province in an attempt to destroy the 13-day-old Congo state.

Lumumba and Congo President Joseph Kasavubu told Belgian Ambassador van den Bosch they would maintain order with their own forces and the approval of the United Nations for help against "Belgian aggression."

Van den Bosch replied that his country's troops, stationed in the Katanga region, were not to be used to protect human lives and only after "numerous Belgian citizens had been killed and injured or subjected to atrocious violence."

man now unjustly imprisoned in Red China and elsewhere in the Communist empire."

It was added to the end of the plank on the Communist world, which reads: "... we shall continue to have any evidence that the Chinese Communist government is genuinely prepared to create a new relationship based on respect for international obligations, including the release of American prisoners of war, we shall have immediate contact with all delegations through a special telephone network, and a small fleet of walkie-talkie operators."

In the early stage of his siege on the chair, Dodd sold a new man.

"You're not going to be able to get any Americans to defend this country if this keeps going on."

Later, he waved off word from platform writers that they would print the end of the plank correctly in the final draft.

"I don't care," Dodd said when he heard this. "It went all over the nation on radio and television and it will be in all the morning papers that way."

Democrats Approve Strong Rights Plank

Los Angeles, July 13 (AP)—The 1960 Democratic platform calls for speedy government action to end racial discrimination.

This is in contrast to the party's 1956 platform. Four years ago the party was willing to go more slowly. It rejected interference with what it called an orderly determination of civil rights complaints by the courts.

The 1960 platform does mean all-down strikes at lunch counters as reflecting dissatisfaction with the progress being made to end segregation.

The 1960 declaration promised the party would continue its efforts to eradicate discrimination based on race, religion or color. This would mean, it said, cooperative efforts on the part of individual citizens and state and local governments as well as federal action.

The new platform does this, it places emphasis on action by the legislative and administrative branches of the federal government as well as by the federal courts.

Duty to Enforce Laws

It said Congress has a duty to enact laws spelling out how individual rights should be protected, and the chief executive has a duty to enforce those laws by means as legal as well as moral measures.

It pledged a Democratic Congress to enactment of laws empowering and directing the attorney general to the injunction suits in federal courts to prevent denial of any civil rights on grounds of race, color or creed.

In emphasizing speed in this field, the 1960 platform declared the time has come to assure equal access for all Americans to all areas of community life, including voting booths, schoolrooms, jobs, housing and public facilities.

It is the duty of the President to see that these rights are respected and the Constitution and laws as interpreted by the Supreme Court are faithfully executed.

Leadership Required

What is now required is effective moral leadership and political leadership by the whole executive branch of our government to make equal opportunity a living reality for all Americans.

As the party and state in general, in every city and state in great or lesser degree, there is discrimination based on color, race, religion, or national origin.

If discrimination in voting, education or segregated lunch-counters are the issue in one area, discrimination in housing and employment may be pressing question elsewhere.

The peaceful demonstrations for first-class citizenship which have recently taken place in many parts of this country are a signal to all of us to make good at least the guarantees of our constitutional promises.

The time has come to assure equal access for all Americans to all areas of community life, including voting booths, schoolrooms, jobs, housing and public facilities.

Portable Color with Potted Plants

By ALAN SWENSON

You can change your garden scenery easily with potted plants. They're perfect for patios, porches and other areas where you want movable color.

Plants in various types of containers are available too. You can put foliage or blooming plants in tubs, pots or boxes where they look best.

As seasons change, simply rearrange plants according to the effects you want. On balconies or terraces try geraniums and petunias. For late color, plant chrysanthemums. In shade, use tuberous begonias or caladiums.

Along walls, hanging baskets of nasturtiums and geraniums are suitable for box plantings. Containers should be attractive and practical. Concrete bowls, wooden boxes, nail kegs and ceramic vases all can be used. Even paint or old oil cans used as planters may be disguised by simple coverings.

Good soil and careful preparation are essential for success of plants restricted in containers. Roots have only limited room. The amount of soil is necessarily small. This soil must be well prepared. Obtain garden soil that crumbles in your hands and has good structure. Mix peat moss, compost or leafmold in equal parts with soil and if soil needs better drainage, organic matter, peat moss, perlite and vermiculite.

Plants confined in containers need frequent watering. Our rule of thumb is to add water from the top until it drains out through bottom holes, or soil is thoroughly moist. Adjust this for the type of plant.

Apply liquid fertilizer about every three weeks, depending on plant size. Spraying with dissolved foliar fertilizer provides moisture and adds food through the leaves, too.

Prosecutor Edward J. Dolan said that Pekeas had killed two policemen and had slain four other persons on a New Brunswick estate last January.

Union Police Sgt. Midge Barry, who was with Leamy during the duel with Pekeas, said Mrs. Laura Mariani, 30, was a suspicious-looking man answering Pekeas' description was prowling in the wooded residential area near the Irvington city line.

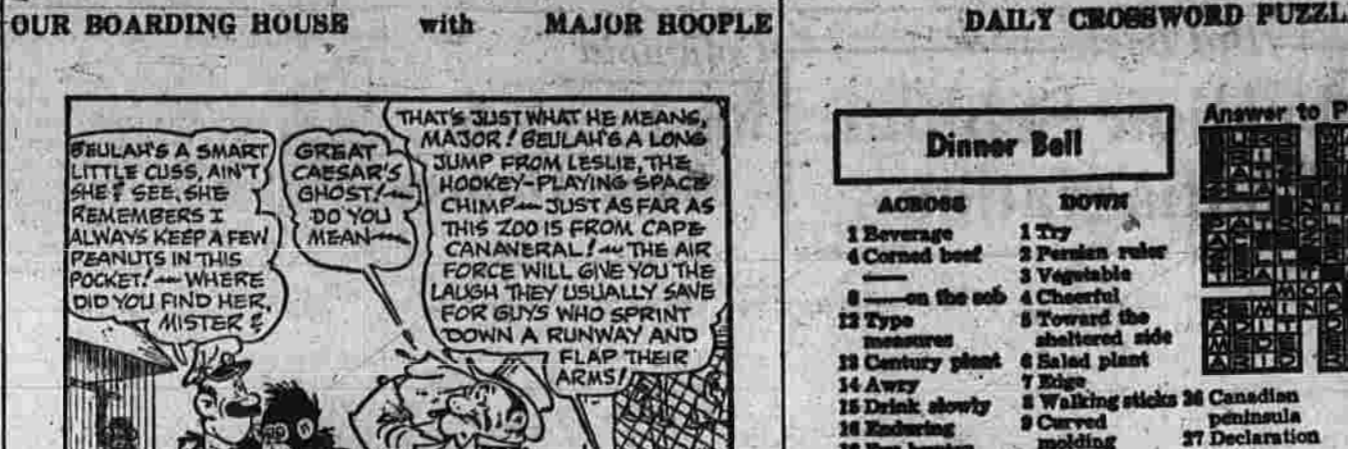

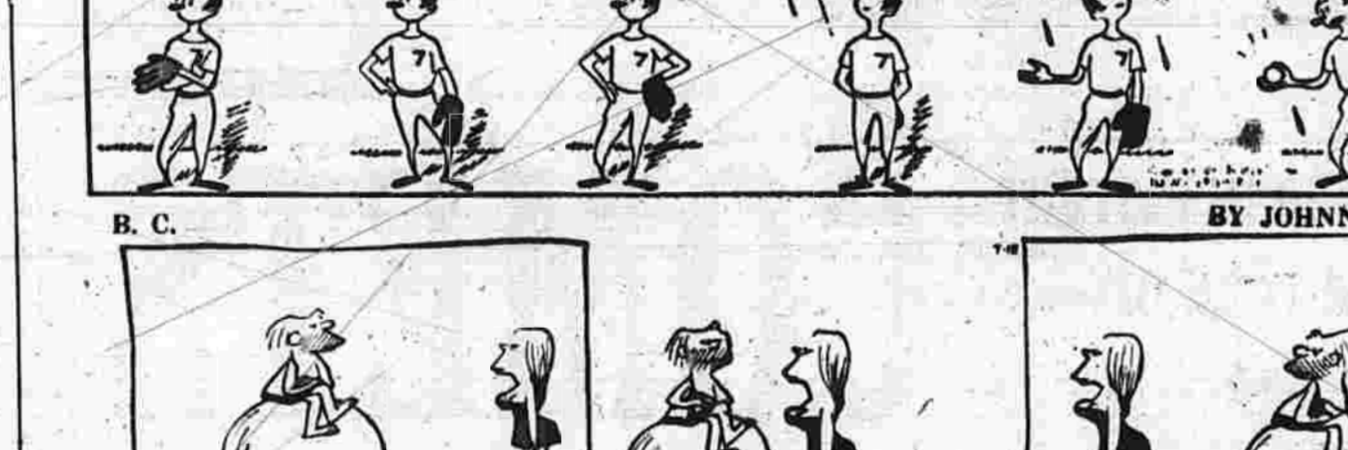

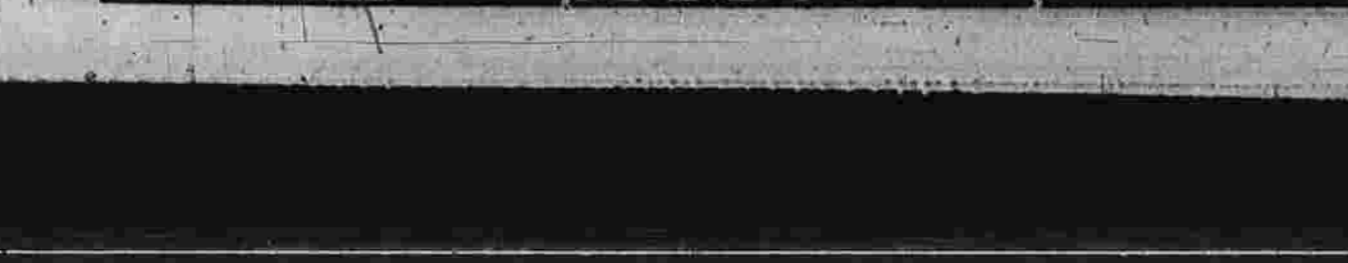
