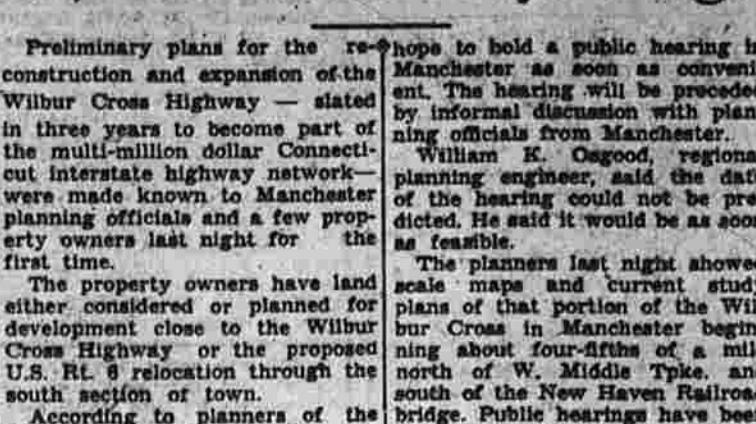
The property owners have land either considered or planned for relocation through the Wilbur Cross Highway project.

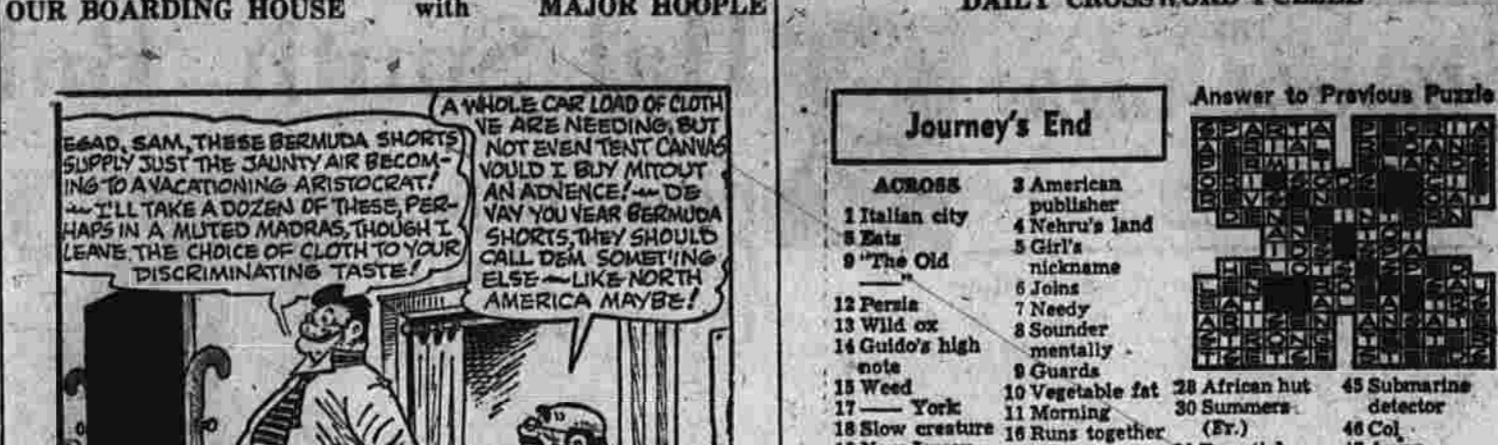
