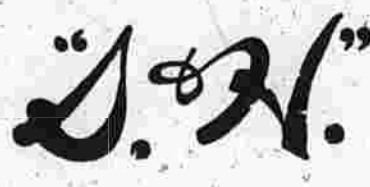

Helicopter Mail Flight Rescheduled Nov. 15

A proposed mail-carrying helicopter flight from Manchester to Bradley Field, postponed once because the Post Office Department asked longer advance notice, will probably take place Nov. 15.

Eugene N. Kelly, chairman of the Manchester Chamber of Commerce's aviation committee, said the November date is the most recent tentative proposal and will be subject to approval by the Post Office Department.

Regional Post Office Director John B. DeMott last month notified the Hartford and Manchester Chambers of Commerce, co-sponsors of the flight, that the post office's philatelic (stamp collecting) division needed more than a 1 1/2-month notice to set up such a flight. The initial proposal was made at the end of June with the flight scheduled for mid-August.

The helicopter trip, first of its kind in the area, would help promote shuttle service between Connecticut towns and Bradley Field, Kelly said.

Postal officials said the stamp collecting division is interested in the trip because the special air-mail would come under a first-flight category. Stamp collectors prize covers (envelopes) canceled for such flights.

Also, postal officials said, the Civil Aeronautics Board should be notified of the trip. According to plans, a helicopter

MacMurray Gives In, TV Debut Sept. 19

Hollywood (NEA)—After 10 years of turning down TV series—32 in all—Fred MacMurray finally said "Yes" and "My Three Sons" debuts on home screens (ABC-TV) Thursday, Sept. 29.

It had to be MacMurray because of two fellows, who got to talking about a show featuring a fellow like Fred MacMurray. The more they talked about a widower raising three sons, the more the fellow became like MacMurray.

Finally their character WAS Mac-

Murray and they HAD to have MacMurray.

That's when the fun started for the two fellows—Peter Tewksbury, Emmy-winning director of "Father Knows Best," and Don Fedderson, long-time producer of "The Millionaire."

Fun? Well, fun like trying to lasso a wild horse or cornering a kangaroo in a railroad round house or breaking into Ft. Knox, which, in a way, Fred MacMurray is.

MacMurray's agents were the first to say it:

"Impossible, Fred is not interested in a series."

Then MacMurray said it:

"So this fellow has to be me? Well, that's nice. Nice you thought about me. But really, I'm not interested. Thirty-nine shows—39 weeks of work. Good luck. I'll see you around."

So Fedderson said to Tewksbury:

"He's not fooling us. He wants more money."

"He collects gold," a mutual friend of Fedderson and Tewksbury interjected.

So they offered him more money.

MacMurray's answer was the same. "No."

Three times they offered him more money. Three more times MacMurray said "no." That's when an idea came to Fedderson and Tewksbury, who were on the verge of not ever again speaking to MacMurray and not ever again speaking to each other, either, about "My Three Sons" and about a "fellow like MacMurray."

Would Mr. MacMurray, they asked, be interested in a schedule which would require only 13 weeks of his time? Thirty-nine shows but only 13 weeks work for him?

"Well, now, that sounds interesting," MacMurray said.

Fedderson and Tewksbury thought and spoke fast. MacMurray could work on a daily sched-

ule, filming 12 complete shows in six weeks. Then, in seven weeks, they would shoot all of MacMurray's scenes for the remaining 27 shows.

He then could go fishing, or make a movie, or go to Europe on a vacation or just sit home while the cast worked on for 27 weeks completing the individual half-hour shows.

Well, that did it. MacMurray finally said "Yes"—and Fedderson and Tewksbury went to a rest home for a quiet weekend.

As the show's widowed father of three sons (Tim Considine, 20; Don Grady, 16; and Stanley (no cracks, please) Livingston, 9, MacMurray's all-male household also includes Grandpa played by William Frawley.

"It reads," you say, "like father really knows best because there's no mother around."

"It's Grandpa knows best," Frawley laughs, "I carry the whip."

"What the show really is," explains Tewksbury, "is everybody knows best. It's a stronghold of masculinity and a three-ring circus on an around-the-clock schedule."

What interested MacMurray the most about "My Three Sons"?

"Do I have to say it again?" he laughed.

I asked him to say it again so he said it:

"MONEY," he said.
