Rockville-Vernon Failure to Build Restaurant Brings Suit by Motel Lessee

The operator of the Mt. Vernon motor court on Rt. 83 near the Willow Creek highway has filed suit against the owner of the property for breach of contract and has asked an attachment of the amount of \$350,000.

The suit and attachment are brought by William H. Fitzsimmons of Talcoville against Joseph L. Bury of 41 White St., proprietors in Rockville and Vernon.

Fitzsimmons claims his share of the contract has been fulfilled but that Bury unjustly enriched himself at the expense of the plaintiff.

According to the writ of attachment the crux of the problem is that Bury failed to build a restaurant near the motel, although he had promised to do so.

Fitzsimmons claims the \$175,000 for rent paid in the year 1959 was written for a 12 1/2-year lease.

The plaintiff also claims \$300,000 as a penalty for the breach of the lease. He also asks whatever other compensation is appropriate.

When Fitzsimmons was negotiating for the lease, the writ stated a representative of Bury said a restaurant would be built on a foundation already constructed on the motel property.
