Budget at Record, No Tax on Income

Ribicoff submitted today what he called an "austerity" budget without new income taxes. He also balanced it by diverting \$1.2 billion from the highway fund to the education fund.

Budget officials base their estimate on a "spending" economy, anticipating a 3 per cent increase over current revenue in the first year of the new biennium and another 3 per cent increase in the second year.

Other tax proposals by Dempsey include raising the corporate tax from 2 1/2 to 3 per cent, the gross earnings tax on gas, water and electric utility companies from 1 1/2 to 2 per cent, and the tax on telephone companies from 4 to 6 per cent.

Dempsey's budget also provides for \$1.2 million for school building grants, \$1.2 million for teachers pensions, a total increase of 500 state colleges and an additional 700 at the University of Connecticut.

The Governor said that the proposed highway budget of \$116.9 million will be the largest highway budget in the history of the state.

Dempsey said in his message that it was his opinion and that of responsible leaders on both sides of the politically divided legislature that "a tax increase is both a necessity at this time and a necessity to continued growth."
