Coverty

Extra Monies Approved; School to Cost \$1,318,347

At the town meeting last night, the figures of \$1,318,347, was given as being the complete cost of the Coverty High School. The school will open in September.

An additional appropriation of \$117,750 was voted at the meeting to complete the construction, furnishing and equipping of the school.

The breakdown of the total cost of the school includes \$1,214,000 (approved March 1, 1960); plus \$90,000 approved last night; \$21,837, a special appropriation approved some months ago; and \$10,811, a transfer to the school building account made last night (\$17,750 premium received on the school bond issue, and \$8,063 interest earned on the proceeds of the bond issue).

Against the \$60,000 appropriation last night, the town will be eligible for federal grants amounting to \$15,145 on science, mathematics, language and library equipment.

The meeting also approved a board of education to be appointed by the town at the meeting of the school board on Feb. 20. The board will have a representative from each ward and a representative from the school board.

The snow removal account was increased by an extra appropriation of \$6,000 approved at the meeting last night.

The school building committee was instructed to go to the board of education regarding items of physical equipment and physical equipment amounting to \$27,764. The committee was asked to report that this amount be included in the school bond issue.

It was also voted to have the board of finance, another town meeting will be called to authorize the board of finance to issue bonds in the amount of \$1,318,347.

About 200 attended the meeting at Robertson School. Charles N. Hartford was elected moderator. Decisions in the 2-hour session were made by voice or standing vote. There were 333 ballots cast.

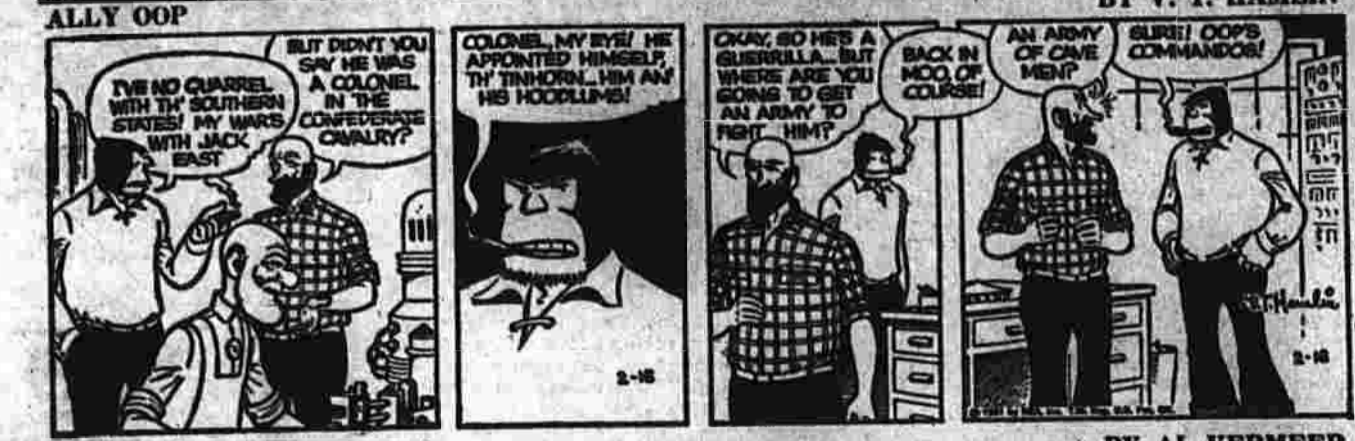

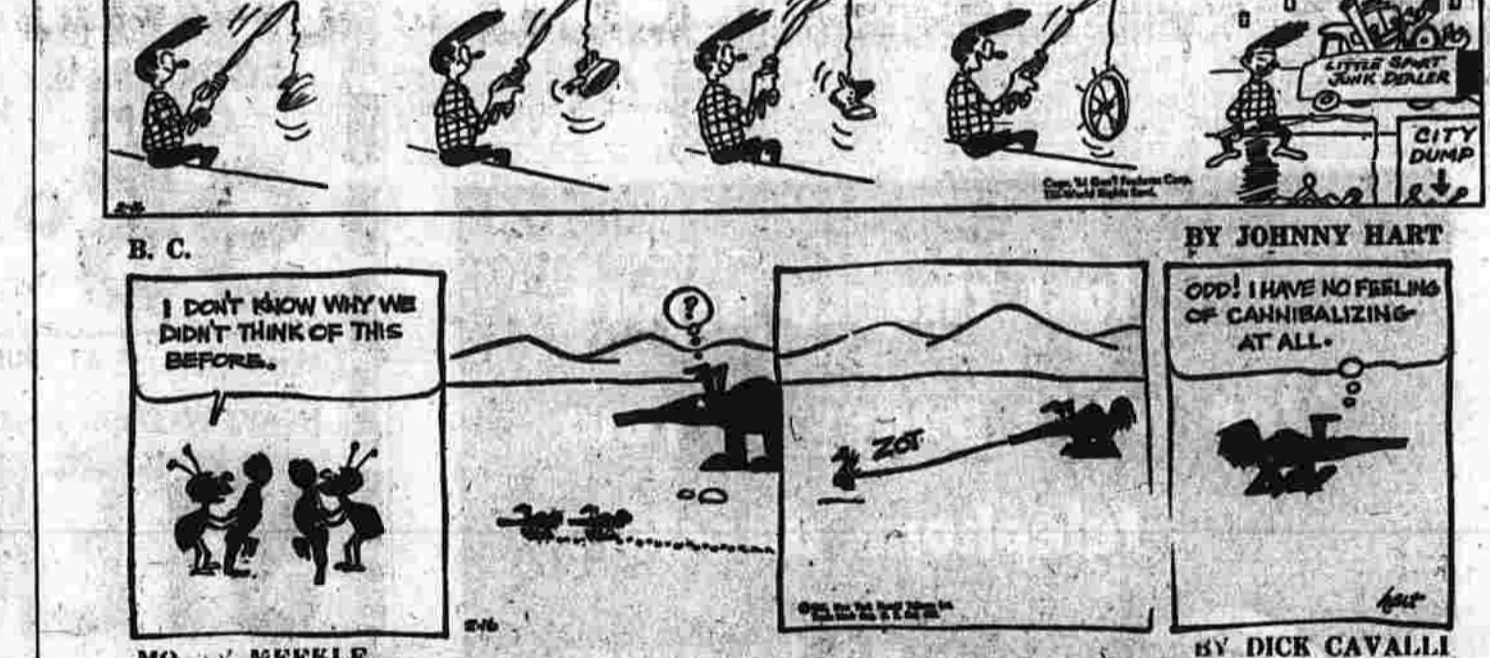
