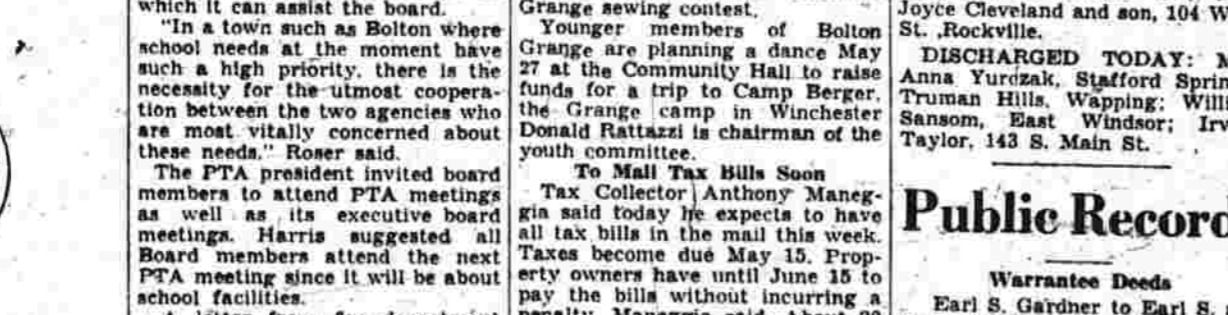

Pension Unit Asks Opinion Of Its Role

The board of directors will be asked tonight to decide whether the pension board should have been consulted by General Manager Richard Martin before he took a poll of town employees regarding a proposed new pension plan.

The pension board last night, in a much larger mood than the one a week ago when they took a vote of censure against the general manager, decided to ask the directors for some clarification of the board's role.

Pension board chairman James Arthur said last night that he had been asked by the board to call for complete control and management of pension matters.

On that ground, he said, he had asked the town manager to overstep himself in taking a survey of the town employees and find out if they would like a pension plan similar to that being started for the police force.

In reference to a passage in the minutes which gave a resume of the action taken by the pension plan, Martin said the board's recollection of the actions differed, but that he did care who received credit for the plan.

Rejected Counts Martin said he rejected the vote of censure because it was unconstitutional and gave him no chance to defend himself.

His concluding remarks were figures on which he based his 1961 recommendation for the pension fund budget.

Chairman Arthur and members Leroy Morris and James Higgins voted to amend the minutes of the previous meeting to include more of the background material, at the suggestion of Arthur.

The three men then voted to ask the board of directors for its opinion of the pension board's actions in the last two weeks, and an opinion on whether the board should have been consulted, at least informally, before the poll of town employees was taken.

Finally, the three men voted to ask a note of thanks to the general manager for his cooperation in the 1961 budget recommendation, and to express agreement with the general manager's reasons for increased pension board's authority.

Martin increased the pension board's authority by \$4,000 to allow a time lag between the date of the town's contribution to the pension fund and the date of the payroll on which the contribution is figured.

Pension board member Henry Becker, author of the vote of censure last week, arrived at the meeting, because he had been delayed by a late train from New York, he said. He asked that his vote be included in the minutes of the meeting, separately from the other votes. He supported the idea of sending Martin the additional minutes of the previous meeting, and of appealing to the directors for a clarification.

Among other opponents of the proposed increase in the corporation tax were spokesmen for the Manufacturers' Association of Bridgeport, the Naugatuck Valley Industrial Council, and the Connecticut American Brass Co.

Paul Andrews of the Naugatuck Valley Industrial Council said that if the corporation tax were raised by the same percentage as the sales tax it would rise only to 1 7/8 per cent instead of 8 per cent.

Dempsey has proposed that the tax on life insurance premiums of Connecticut-based companies go up from 2 1/2 per cent to 3 per cent.

But spokesmen for the Connecticut liquor industry said the liquor hearing that is being held by the legislature's finance committee yesterday, are essential to the state budget.

Step to Cease-fire Parley Halts Battle On One Laos Front

(Continued from Page One) meeting in Vientiane today to discuss the situation.

President Kennedy's roving envoy, Averell Harriman, announced today that he had arranged a cease-fire but was only an initial contact.

The fighting in the limited area was stopped after the meeting, but Phoumy's statement did not say if this was by agreement or was something both sides did without instructions.

Spokesmen said, however, it was presumed fighting might continue on other fronts, especially in the south where the enemy has gained ground in recent days.

Even so, the meeting yesterday and today's follow-up were hailed as one of the few really encouraging signs since British and Soviet Russia named their cease-fire call a week ago.

The rebel officer contacted by Sino was Maj. B. Vattho. Phoumy said Sino headed for Na Mon, the town where the rebels agreed to meet him, but was unprepared to enter the rebel-held village.

The meeting was actually north of Vang Vieng, a No-Man's Land along the border between the rebel stronghold at Vang Vieng and the government command post south of the Nam River.

All the points are on the north-south road that runs between Vientiane and Luang Prabang, the royal capital of Laos.

Rebel forces yesterday proclaimed safety of routes from the Plain de Jarres and Vientiane to Luang Prabang, and to allow delegations from both sides to attend a truce meeting in the village of Na Mon.

The safe conduct guarantees and rebel political aims were announced by Capt. Keng Le, the paratrooper officer who led the rebels last August and headed the rebellion that invaded Vientiane in December.

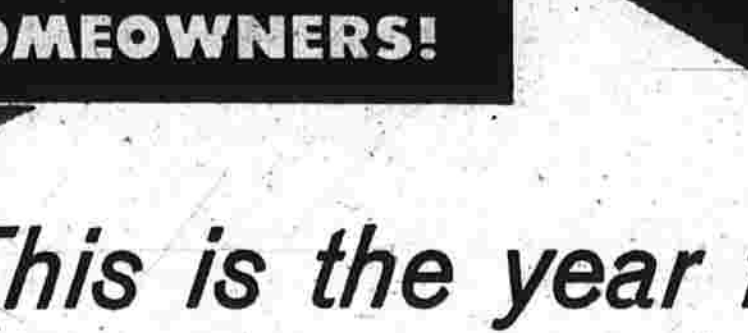

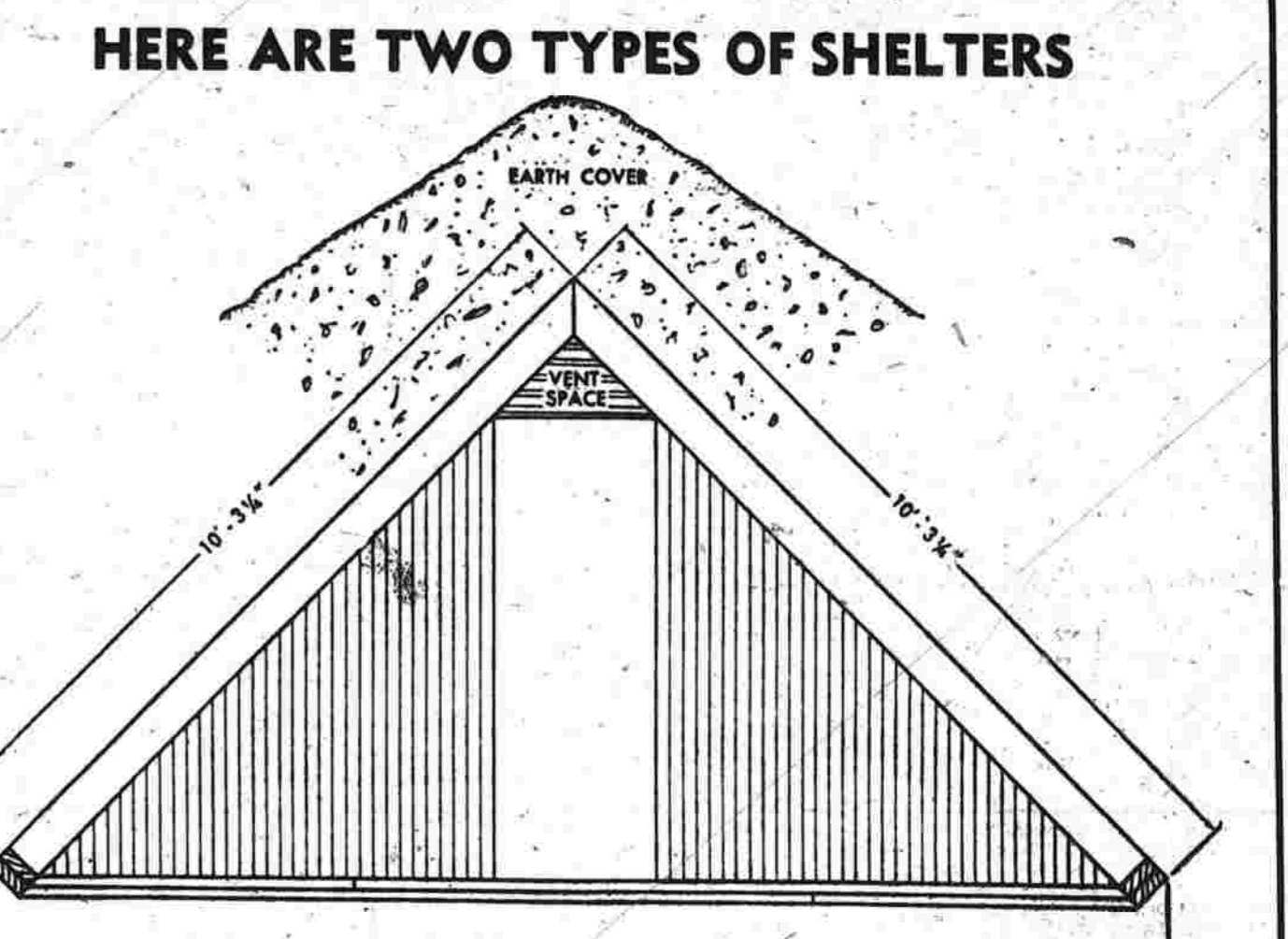

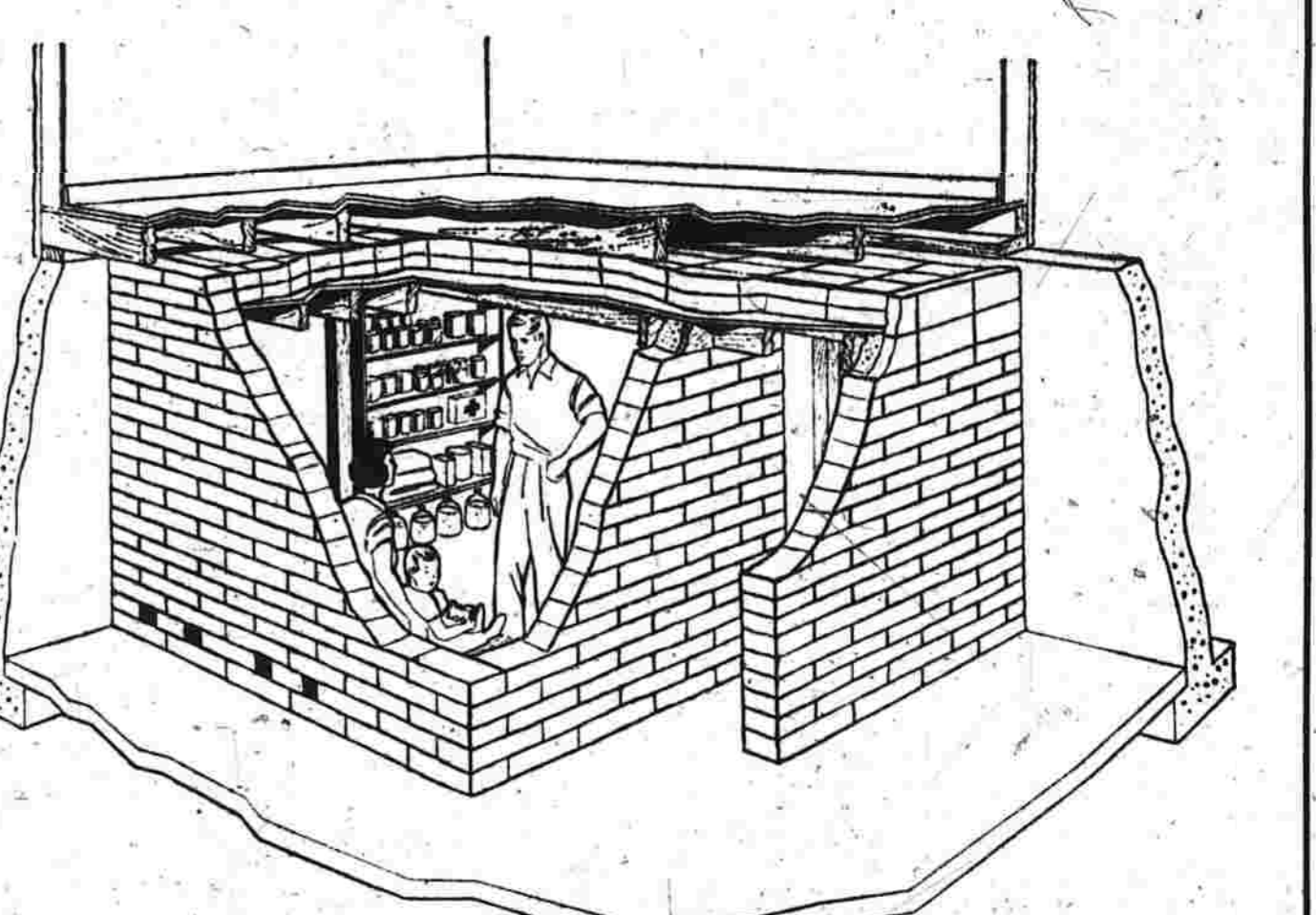
