U.S. 'Artificial Astronaut' Recovered After One Orbit

Cape Canaveral, Fla., Sept. 11 (AP)—The United States took a long stride toward manned orbital flight today by recovering a Mercury space capsule into orbit and recovering it after one sweep around the Earth.

The 2-ton capsule, which carried an "Artificial Astronaut," was lifted from the Atlantic Ocean 161 miles east of Bermuda by the destroyer USS Decatur at 1:14 p.m. EDT—just over three hours after it roared away from Cape Canaveral on the nose of an Atlas missile.

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration said the capsule will be returned to Cape Canaveral as soon as possible for study.

The pickup was made one hour and 24 minutes after the space craft landed in the sea.

The single orbit of the Earth had taken one hour and 46 minutes.

The capsule was launched from the Cape Canaveral test center at 10:04 a.m. EDT.

Its course ranged from an altitude of 241 miles over Australia to a low point of 99 miles directly over Bermuda.

Except for a landing 35 miles short of the planned impact point 200 miles from Bermuda it was a precision performance throughout.

The success signaled a new step in the nation's drive to send a human astronaut into orbit around the Earth.

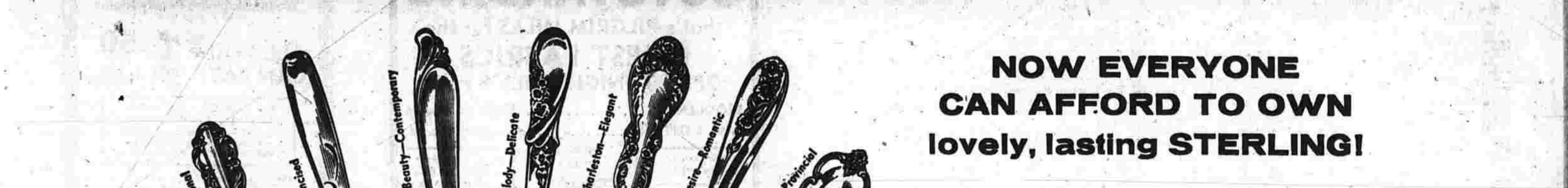

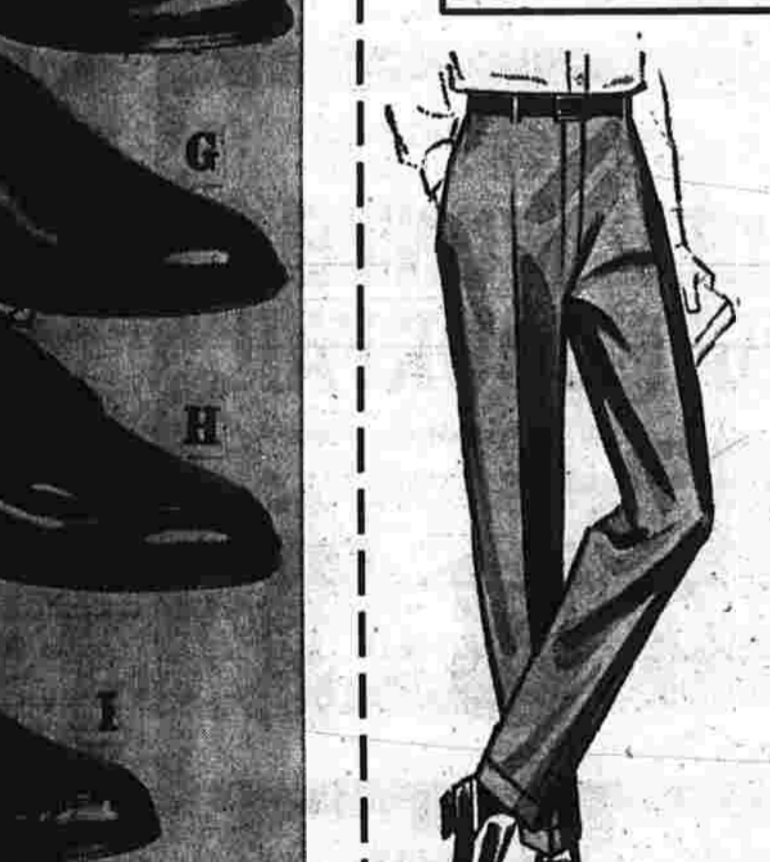
