"Then Roger's thoughts turned to the days ahead and how he will live with his grandparents. Until recently the Dahmens had lived on a farm near Mayfield, Colo.

The high point of his young life, Roger recalled, had been two years ago when he spent the summer on that farm.

"It was a fine summer," he said reflectively. "I drove the tractor and I helped all around."

His eyes brightened. "Farming is the best kind of life. I decided right then I wanted to be a farmer."

"I still do — even now."

Nationalist China has renounced firm against Mongolia despite repeated pleas by the United States not to veto the Communist state.

The Nationalist contend that Mongolia is not fit for U.N. membership because it joined Red China in the Korean War against U.N. and South Korean forces.

The Soviet Union has countered that it will veto Mauritania in reprisal if the Nationalists block the Kremlin's Asian ally.

The Russians, who were maneuvered by the West into letting the Mauritanian application come up first, made another futile attempt to get the council to act first on Mongolia.

They were reported apprehensive that, if they take the first blocking action in the council, it might rouse the resentment of some nonaligned nations on whom they are counting to support Red China's bid for a U.N. seat.

The Soviets had wanted to get Nationalist China to throw the first veto in hopes it would rouse the ire of the Brazzaville group.

The 11 French-speaking African nations indicated that if Mauritania were blocked as a result of Nationalist action they would vote to seat Peking in the Chinese seat when the assembly takes up the representation question later this fall.

A suggestion for creation of a regional organization of African states came from Foreign Minister Alo Koteba Yifu of Ethiopia yesterday in a General Assembly speech. Yifu said such a group could serve as a buffer against pressure carved by East-West friction.

Gen. De Gaulle Offers Algeria Role to Rebels

sums special constitutional powers permitting him to "take such measures as he deems necessary."

The first reaction in Algeria among Europeans to De Gaulle's speech was anger.

An explosion at Oran interrupted the TV transmission in that city a few minutes before De Gaulle's speech was to be aired. It was broadcast normally in Algiers, the capital. The Oran incident was handled in a series of blasts used by the anti-Gaullist secret army organization to cut off radio and TV.

French authorities in Algeria announced the arrest of 21 secret army organization agents, including bomb and gun experts, and the seizure of 50 rounds of the rightists' favorite plastic explosive.

In his address De Gaulle told the leader of the Muslim Nationalist rebellion that he is ready to seek peace and called on them to take part in "regulating the conditions of self-determination and drawing up the elements of a French-Algerian cooperation."

It appeared clear from this that De Gaulle was willing to bring the nationalist leaders into a provisional executive.

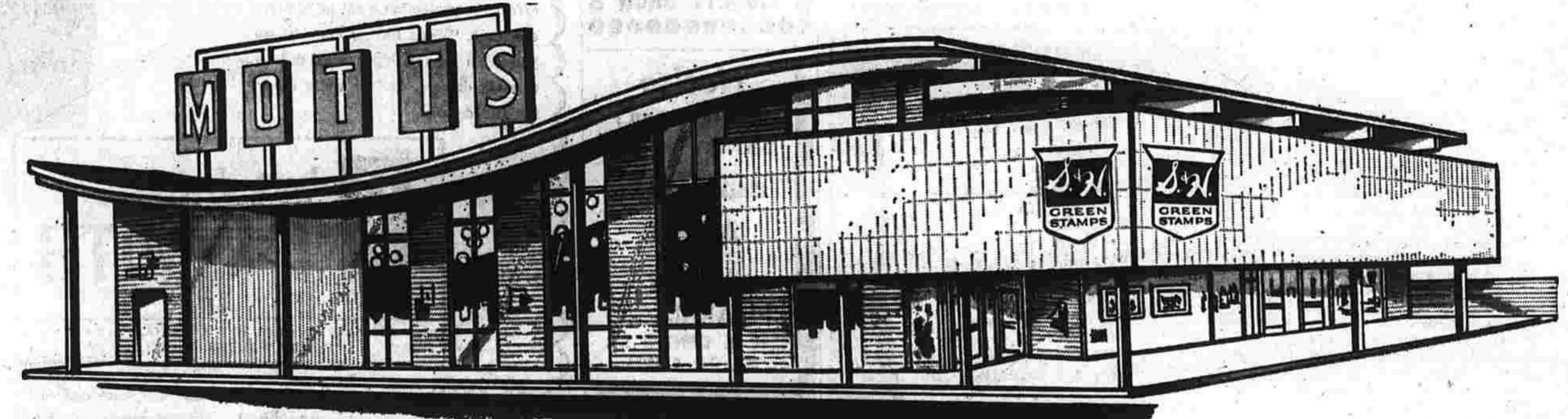

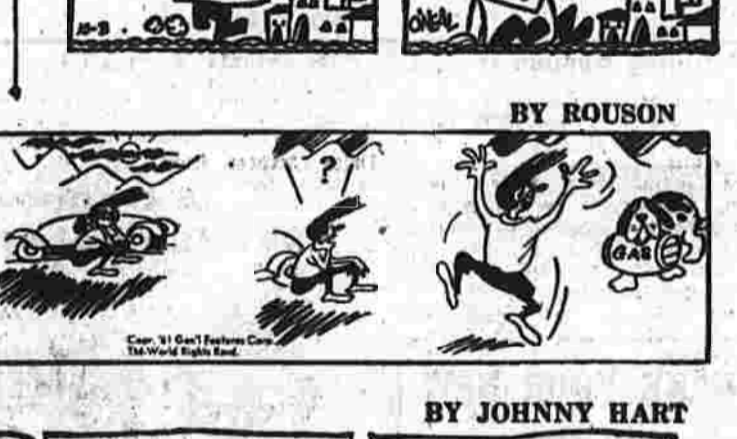
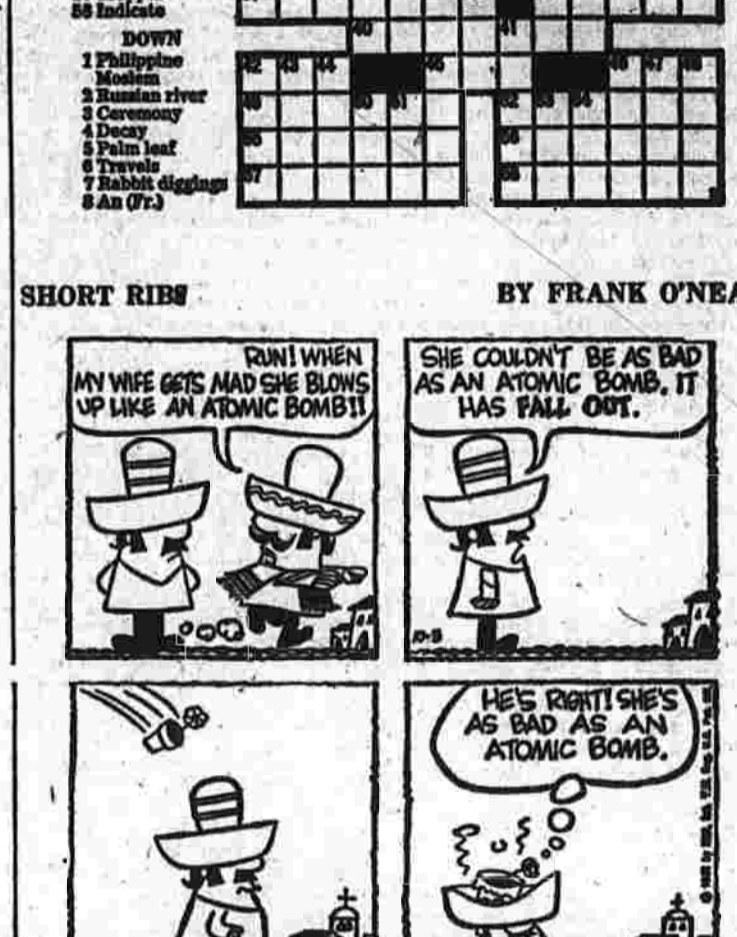

Rockville-Vernon Minority Law Limits Extent of GOP Victory

Approximately fifty-eight of the 100 Vernon voters went to the polls yesterday and returned the Republicans to power for the coming biennium.

The voters' turnout—47.5 percent—was the largest in the history of town elections, representing about 48 per cent of the total number (8,821) of registered voters.

Two years ago, 47 per cent of the then 7,400 registered voters went to the polls.
