

Distress Calls Heard Did Belgian Airliner Land Without Force At Soviet Airfield?

Istanbul, Turkey, Jan. 8 (AP)—A Belgian Sabena jet airliner, carrying 27 persons from Tehran to Istanbul, landed at a Soviet airfield after being pursued by Russian jets. Sabena authorities in Istanbul and in Brussels, the line's headquarters, said the plane was forced by Soviet jets to put down at the city of Yerevan, near the Soviet-Turkish frontier.

Thompsonville Blaze Damage Over \$500,000

Thompsonville, Jan. 8 (AP)—Damage is estimated at upwards of \$500,000 in a fire that wrecked a business building in the center of town and took more than 100 firemen to bring under control. During the height of the blaze early Sunday, 40 persons were evacuated as flames threatened several nearby tenement buildings.

Winsted, Jan. 8 (AP)—Andre Hubert, 18, was killed when a car he was riding in went out of control and struck another on the Winsted Torrington Road late Saturday night. Police charged the driver, Gail R. Griswold, 19, with reckless driving, driving while drunk and misconduct with a car.

Fatally Injured

Stamford, Jan. 8 (AP)—A Darien man, Christos Komninos, 35, was fatally injured in an auto accident Saturday night on Long Ridge Rd. He died yesterday in Stamford Hospital. Police said the driver of the car, Peter J. Benekos, 28, also of Darien, lost control of his vehicle while passing another, hit a parked car and then rammed into a tree. Benekos suffered a shoulder, back and chest injuries.

Undersea Garden

Ram Head-on in Fog; At Least 200 Injured

Woerden, Netherlands, Jan. 8 (AP)—Two jammed passenger trains collided in dense fog near here today and Netherlands Railways announced that 90 persons perished. It was the worst train disaster in this country's history. The Dutch News Agency reported earlier that 50 persons had been injured but a farmer's wife living near the disaster scene said ambulances had streamed away carrying at least 200 injured to nearby hospitals.

Kennedy Aims Berlin Accord With Gen. Clay

Washington, Jan. 8 (AP)—President Kennedy says he and Gen. Lucius D. Clay are in full agreement on how to handle effectively any possible future crisis in Berlin. The President's statement was issued yesterday after he and Clay, who is Kennedy's personal representative in West Berlin, had talked for an hour at the White House.

Denounced as Stalinist Molotov Returning To Post in Vienna

Moscow, Jan. 8 (AP)—Ex-Foreign Minister Molotov and other associates would suffer degradation after the attack in the party congress last October. Molotov had attempted to fight back against the charges by sending a letter to members of the Central Committee just before the congress opened last Oct. 15. The letter was not published in full, though extracts were read.

GOP Unit with Birchers Brown Declares Nixon Not Fighting Ultra Right

Washington, Jan. 8 (AP)—Gov. Edmund G. Brown of California said today Richard M. Nixon "is not joining the fight against the ultra right wing, although these extremists are a strong force in our state and in his party." Brown said the former Vice President "must choose between principle and opportunism. He has chosen the latter. He has stepped away from those who are fighting the political primitives, and he apparently wants their money and support."

Sukarno Escapes Assassination Try

Jakarta, Indonesia, Jan. 8 (AP)—President Sukarno escaped unhurt from a bomb explosion last night while winding up a 4-day harrumphing tour to whip up support in the Celebes for his plans to seize West New Guinea from the Dutch. The bomb killed three persons and injured 25 others in a crowd watching the president arrive for a speech. It exploded a few hundred yards behind his motorcade.

25 on Vessel Feared Lost in Channel Crash

Dover, England, Jan. 8 (AP)—Twenty-five seamen were feared lost in the sinking of the Yugoslav freighter Sabac after a midnight collision in the fog-shrouded English Channel. Eight survivors and 17 bodies were recovered from the channel. The other eight men aboard the Sabac were feared lost.

Bulletins Culled from AP Wires

SAYS U.S. OFFERED TROOP'S Washington, Jan. 8 (AP)—The Roman Catholic Archbishop of Viet Nam said today the U.S. government offered two months ago to send combat troops to South Viet Nam to help resist Communist forces. Archbishop Ngo Dinh Thuc, elder brother of Viet Nam President Ngo Dinh Diem, told a news conference in Hanoi that the offer was refused. The offer would do so only as a last resort. The Archbishop said the Thailand, Nationalist China and South Korea also have expressed readiness to send troops if needed.
