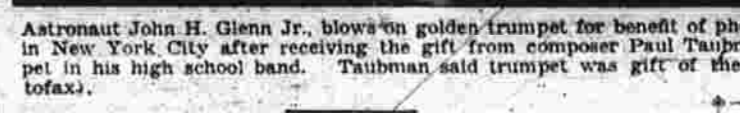

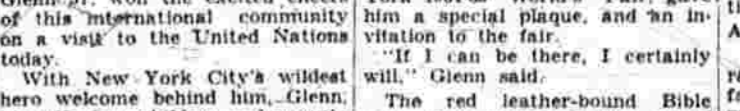

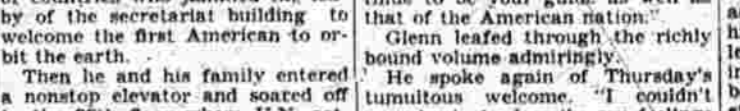

Nikita Khrushchev, Soviet Premier, is seen here in a recent photograph.



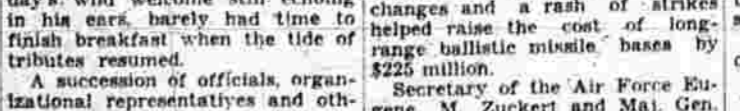

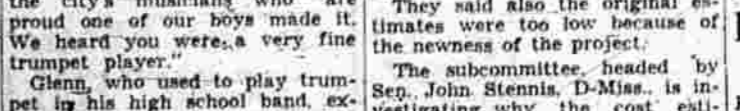
Diagram illustrating the design changes and strikes that have increased the cost of long-range ballistic missile bases.

**Our Bombs And Our Boy**  
We have decided to go with Ngo Dien in South Vietnam, for better or for worse. If he yields to our suggestions to reform himself, we will be a last-gasp effort to save him. We hope he will and we have some grudging promises to that effect, from him. But if he doesn't, we will see to it that he is not a burden to us. We are still with him, because we're stuck with him. He is government, and we don't have any other practical candidate.

And since we're stuck with him, whether or not he improves himself, we have committed ourselves to a course of action. We will not stop admitting that we are somewhat dissatisfied with him, but we will not let our dissatisfaction lead us to a course of action that would be a disservice to him and to the cause of freedom in Vietnam.

Subsequent reports from Vietnam itself suggest that perhaps our thinking should be a little less comfortable. The attempted blow against the military government, which was the result of a coup d'etat, represented something more widespread and solid than the irresponsible lack of a couple of platoon leaders who were the primary target of the bombing.

But, Senator Thurmond's aid under Secretary Ball brought us some common sense to the hearing to bury the whole issue.

One thing we did not point out at every speech delivered by a military figure was the fact that the military government is the first of the audience physically present when it is delivered, the second that of our friends and allies abroad, the third that of the uncommitted people of the world, and the fourth that of the Communist leadership which is rival to us.
