As Matrimony Grounds Girls Airlines Get Foreign Legion

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — (TWA) Foreign Legion's reputation as the average ranking of American airlines has been boosted by the influx of a continental flavor on planes that never leave the borders of the United States.

The airlines are under constant pressure to find suitable hostesses because of a brisk personnel turnover. Although the girls set the requirements as well as anyone, they, too, are susceptible to the one thing that keeps airlines of ficials taking aspirin.

"Foreign girls get married about as fast as American girls," complained one married airline personnel man.

United Air Lines employs more than 2,000 stewardesses. Ten per cent come from abroad. Forty English girls serve within this country.

Airline officials have found that passengers enjoy the international touch. Some companies have introduced costumes of other lands on some routes—to accent the accent.

At Continental Airlines, a distinctly western U.S. operation, overseas recruits sit in perfectly on domestic flights, according to Mark Kramer, vice president of customer service planning. Twenty per cent of the line's hostesses are foreign personnel.

The average British stewardess trains, United's records show, is 21.5 years old; 5 feet 5.3 inches, 114 pounds (118½ pounds), and has an U.S. accent.

The efforts to which U.S. airlines go to find girls is demonstrated by TransWorld Airways. Of nearly 100 hostesses employed by TWA, 140 have been recruited abroad.

Although the company is the only major one which permits hostesses to continue their employment after marriage, about 40 each month permanently exchange their flying costumes for an apron.

Several months ago TWA sent recruits to France for the first time. According to interviewees (most of the job is an arduous one, although delightful. Visa regulations must be met and the girls must have the proper high qualifications for the job. For every 600 girls hired, 1,000 are interviewed.) The foreign recruits possess varied backgrounds. Four Books Held Poisoning Minds, Morals of Pupils

LANSING, Mich. (AP)—Four books have been charged with "poisoning the minds and morals" of Michigan children.

Sen. Lynn O. Francis, R-Mich., read on the Senate floor to condemn the books during debate over an amendment proposed by Sen. Charles S. Bonny, D-Detroit, by an obscure literature bill.

"Call me an alarmist if you will," said Francis, "but you ought to take a look at what's going on. These books are poisoning the minds and morals of our children."

Francis, chairman of the Senate Education Committee, said he was mostly concerned because of a science-fiction novel, "Brave New World," by Aldous Huxley, was used as a text for required reading in the 10th grade at Forest Hill High School near Grand Rapids.

The school district banned the book two weeks ago after parents protested it was unfit for high school students. The censorship since had been referred to a faculty committee.

The 10th graders, meanwhile, never failed reading the book.

Francis objected to the presentation of an absolute dictatorship, never failed reading the book.

"I have objected to works such as, 'Marriage licenses are sold like dog licenses,' and 'You rule with the brain and the ballota, never with the fist...'

Huxley's amendment to the obscure literature bill would include photographs, records and tape recordings. It is intended to tight-

en up the law, he explained. Francis added if it also covered schools and libraries.

"This is rather silly," Bonny said, when Francis made his remarks. "You are not going to find obscure literature in our schools and libraries."

Francis then cited the book-banning at Forest Hill and checked three other books as unfit to read. These he listed as:

"Tropic of Cancer," by Henry Miller; "Catcher in the Rye," by J. D. Salinger; and "Lady Chatterley's Lover," by D. H. Lawrence.
