That was the hope and prayer expressed yesterday by Donna Lacroix, 16, and eldest of the eight Lacroix children, orphaned by the death of both parents.

Whether this will be possible is still in question, but the children know and are grateful that many persons are trying to resolve various problems for their future.

Rockville-Vernon Few Citizens Comment on Town Budget

Managers of the town of Rockville-Vernon last night asked questions about, but did not oppose, items in the proposed \$2,482,374 town budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1.

Douglas R. Hayes, chairman of the board of finance, explained the budget may undergo slight revisions when the board gives final approval to the request next month.

The approved budget will be recommended to voters for adoption at a town meeting April 3, 4 Tuesday. The proposed budget is \$271,183 greater than the present budget.

Hayes said there will be a surplus carried over to the coming year but said he has no estimate of the amount. It will be known next week, he said.

The tax rate, which will be influenced by the amount of surplus, will be set after the annual meeting. Hayes could give no estimate on what the tax rate will be.

Comments on the budget last night concerned:

Recreation — John L. Daigle suggested that \$100,000 of the \$100,000 recreation budget earmarked for park and recreation purposes constitute a tax inquiry against Rockville residents who pay for their own recreation.

A \$2,000 appropriation made under the recreation heading for development of the town-owned Eckler Farm property in Vernon Center, was explained after the meeting as money for picnic tables, land clearing and possibly an outdoor fireplace.

The Eckler property will be taken

over by the town April 1. Fredrick Becker currently has the use of it.

Education — The \$1,717,500 school budget is the largest single item in the finance picture. School Supt. Raymond B. Ramsdell said about \$200,000 will be returned to the town general fund from state school aid sources.

Questioned on the \$77,227 bus transportation request, Ramsdell said he felt it is less expensive than cost of a town-owned bus operation. He added, however, the school board is slated to study town operation of buses. At present the town contracts for bus service with bus owner Elmer M. Tharall.

Debt Service — Hayes said the \$380,000 debt service appropriation includes \$150,000 in interest and principal on the town's uniform fiscal year bonds. At this time, it does not include an approximately \$100,000 outlay on the proposed Skinner Rd. school bond.

This may later be put in the \$2-93 bond. Hayes said, depending on the date of sale of the bond issue.

According to a prepared statement from the Red Cross office: The home nursing course is taught for its use in civil defense emergency situations as well as for its use in the home under ordinary situations of illness.

The Algerian nationalist press service in Tunis boasted that the attack caught the French by surprise and said it was nearly an hour before they fired back.
