Defrocked Priest
Sues for Divorce

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — Defrocked priest Walter Ryan, 37, whose departure from his New York state home seven years ago prompted a \$2.3 million suit brought by his wife Alice against the Catholic Church, sued her for divorce Thursday.

He accused his attractive, 41-year-old wife of adultery, desertion and cruelty. Ryan married her in Baptist rites in Maryland 12 years ago under the assumed occupation of free lance writer. Shortly thereafter he left the church and became a real estate salesman.

Her suit in March of this year started a nationwide search that lasted two days. Ryan revealed his whereabouts in San Francisco, then to deny her charges.

She claimed she fathered her fourth daughter while on a brief visit to their Glen Head, N.Y., home in 1956, but a San Francisco Superior Court rejected her assertion in a June hearing.

The best informed officials here believe that the Soviet Union does not want to avoid war but that it will go through with the peace treaty if it can.

While the United States and the Soviet Union both seem to be in a position of having to live with the status quo, the situation is anything but stable.
