Spiritual Sight
Called Pathway
To Brotherhood

"Universal brotherhood" depends upon recognizing the "spiritual individuality," said a Christian Science lecturer in Manchester yesterday.

It takes "spiritual insight and moral courage" to serve our fellow men in true brotherhood, he said. This is the challenge of today.

Gordon H. Smith of Milwaukee was the speaker, under the sponsorship of First Church of Christ, Scientist, Manchester. He spoke in the Manchester High School auditorium.

"Our world today demands justice and compassion in an ever-expanding awareness of men's brotherhood," Mr. Smith observed. "We are our brother's keeper on both a 'next-door' and a global basis. . . . The demand is upon each one of us to contribute his part."

But this cannot be done on the basis of "physical materialities" and the lecturer declared. "The faculty of attempting to love another as yourself from the standpoint of the physical personalities is apparent from mankind's slowness in bringing any lasting peace and harmony to a world in convulsion of discord. . . ."

"To love one's neighbor means more than for one mortal to love the imperfections and errors presented by the physical senses as a caricature of man. This isn't what man needs. He needs to be commanded to love our neighbor as ourselves."

"We need to raise ourselves from the material to the spiritual, regarding 'the tyranny of materialism' that would sweep aside the individual and the dignity of man."

Actually, he said, nothing "can ever blot out man's divine prerogative—the creative, all-loving God. . . . This individual spiritual identification is the basis of true brotherhood."

"This is the basis of prayer in Christian Science, the lecturer said. It enables the individual to overcome the "assortment of fears, doubts and prejudices" which are the "hidden mental causes of sickness and other discord."

It helps him to rise above the "belief that he is a mortal separated from other mortals, each having a little mist of his own controlled by differing motives, wills, and ambitions."

Such prayer "acknowledges without reservation that God's presence is the only presence there is," he said.

In this way "we can fulfill the first commandment to love God supremely—to love Him with every heart, mind and strength."

Mr. Smith stated that "the reverence and calm which accompany this spiritually mental activity dissolve the fear of any evil power" and "a tranquility experienced in healing."

Record Amount
To MMH in '62
Connecticut Blue Cross paid a record \$1,109,831.74 to Manchester Memorial Hospital last year as reimbursement for members' care, according to a report released today.

The hospital had 4,780 non-emergency cases, 498 maternity cases and 1,962 emergency room cases involving Blue Cross members. The 1962 case represent 36.6 days of hospital care.

Reimbursements by Blue Cross to the hospital since it became a member in 1953 now total \$5,331,052.08. In 1961, payments totaled \$1,049,583.49.

To all hospitals last year, Blue Cross paid out \$41,222,118 in care received by its members, the highest amount ever paid in a one-year period and an increase of \$3,167,964 over 1961 payments.

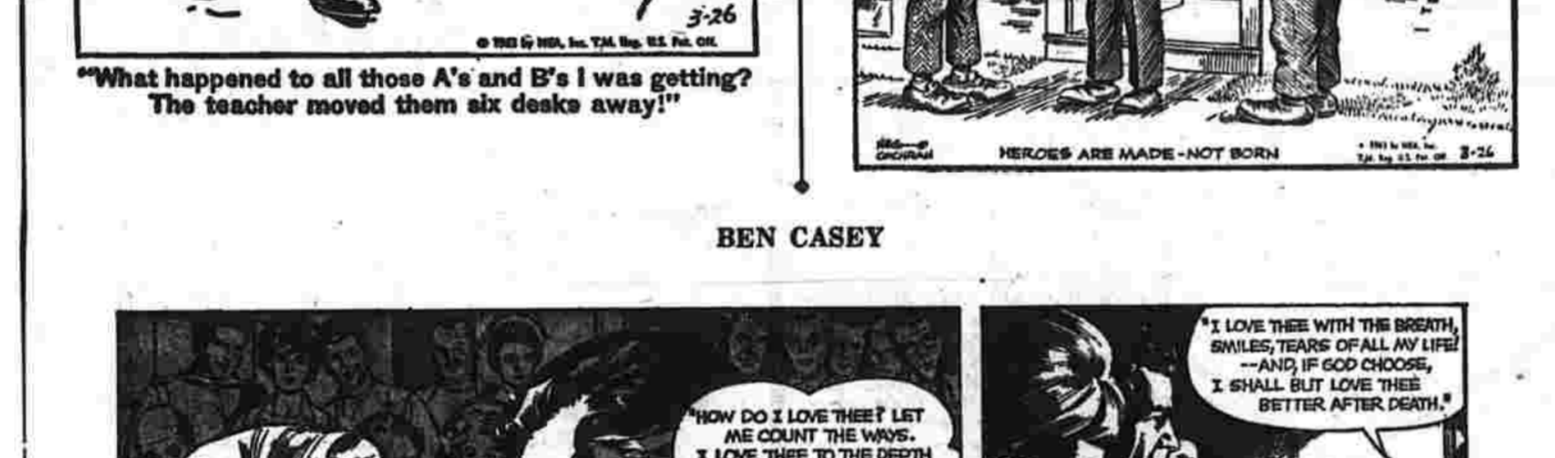
