South Windsor Citizens Enter Pleas to Hike Library Fund

About 30 citizens were present at the public hearing of the \$307,749 proposed municipal budget Wednesday.

The most notable plea during the hearing was for retention of \$2,130 to the library for books.

The great lack of books in town, especially for the use of school children, was deplored by several citizens. Joseph Mills noted that even the school libraries were closed for the most part, by the FTA's. The reference department in the town libraries, he said, "are so weak that high school students must go to other towns' libraries."

Dr. Robert Williams also pleaded for retention of the fund for books. "It is ludicrous," he said, "that we are looking for money in high school to produce a better education for our children, when there are better places to cut a budget than books."

Mr. Warren J. Hartwick thought that "there is a misplacement of values in our society" when high schools obtain larger appropriations than libraries. He suggested that the \$2,130 for books be found in the larger appropriation for the contingency fund. (The contingency fund had been increased from \$20,000 to \$50,000 "to provide a more realistic budgetary appropriation.")

Miss Joanne Kilgore asked the council to restore the requested \$500 for the two library aides, instead of the Council's proposed \$281. The aides are needed, she said, to supplement the hours of the two regular librarians. The regulars may be open 10 hours a week each but the library is open for at least 16 hours a week. The Council's proposal would only allow the aides to work 5 hours a week each, \$1.25 an hour. More books and more personnel are needed, Mrs. Kilgore added. If the library is to be open more.

Business For The Cut
Some 30 of the country's top businessmen and lawmakers in Washington the other day and they went over for a chat with President Kennedy. Their purpose was to tell him, and to tell the country, that they believe in a tax cut now, without any postponing or deferring of the budgeting process, and that they believe that such a tax cut is the way toward an eventual balancing of the budget.

Unintentional Debate
President Kennedy's return to Mr. Nixon on the issue of Cuba, if we may be pardoned for saying so, has been a most unfortunate, about as lacking in realistic intelligence as the Nixon speech which provoked it and as the Kennedy speeches which once addressed themselves to the Cuban problem, before their utterance had become a President.

As The Mets Go
From one triumph after another in the past few days, the Mets have become a laughing stock. The Mets are not finding it easy to reconcile their own innate gentleness of character with the somewhat aggressive behavior of their own who might describe a second season come-lattée.
