In discussion or in studying political subjects. Three to five days of the vacation are spent in militia training.

The President dedicates a monument in Battery Park at the end of Manhattan, consisting of two rows of 10-foot-high granite tablets bearing the names of the dead and a 20-foot bronze eagle, seemingly about to drop a wreath.

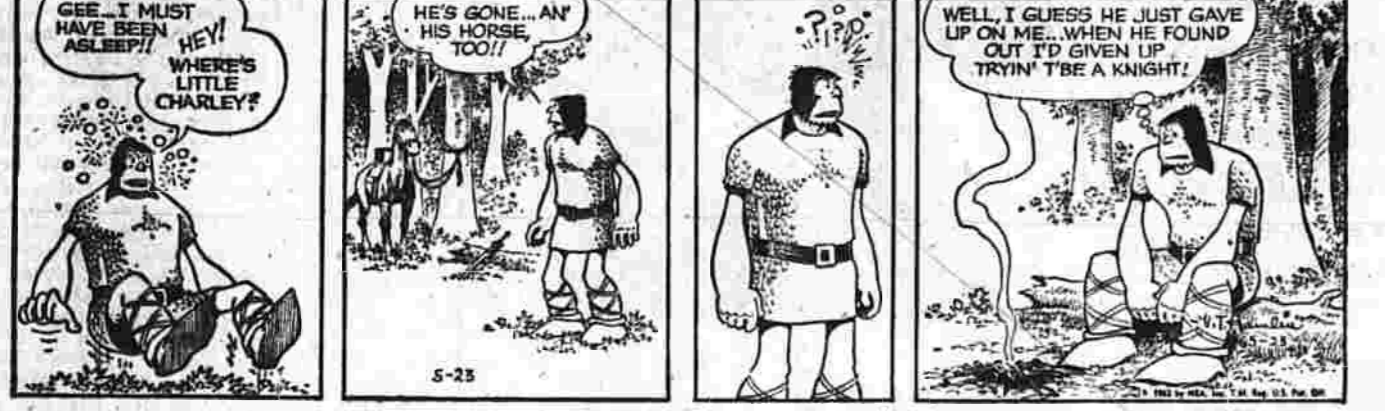

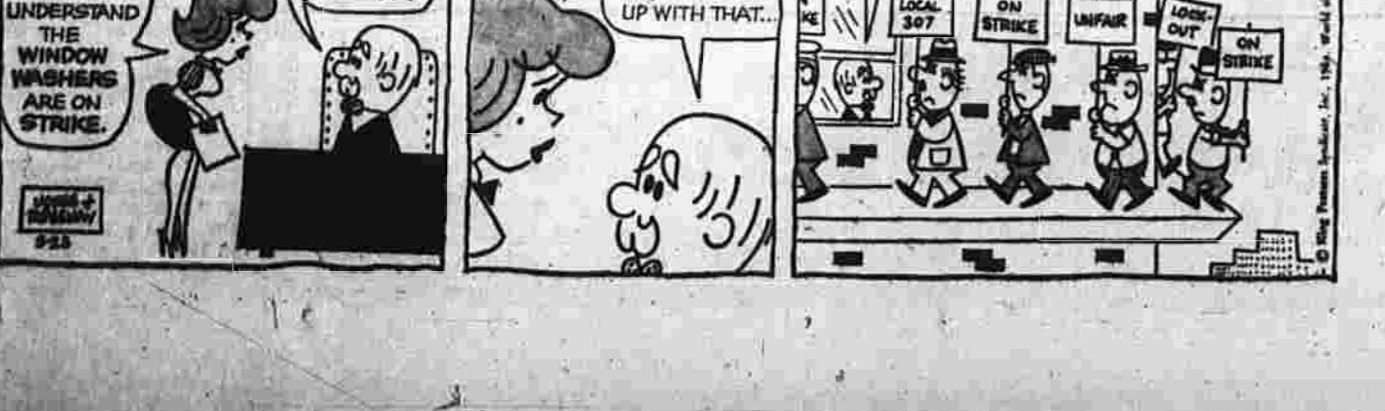

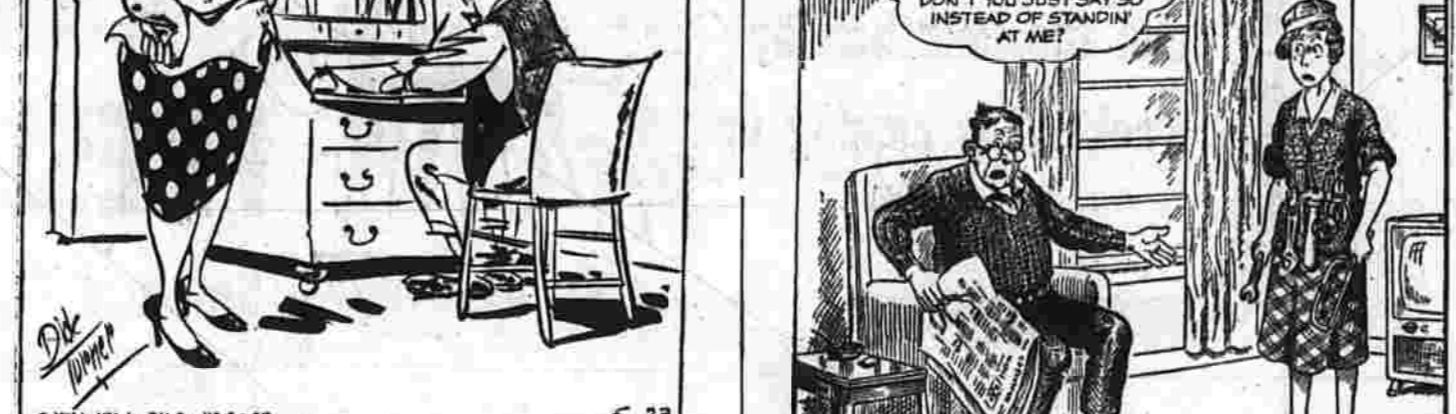
