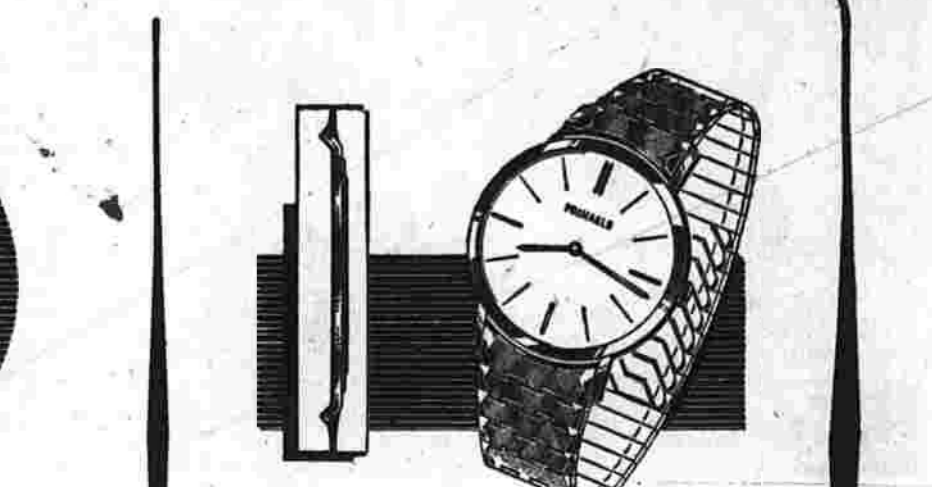

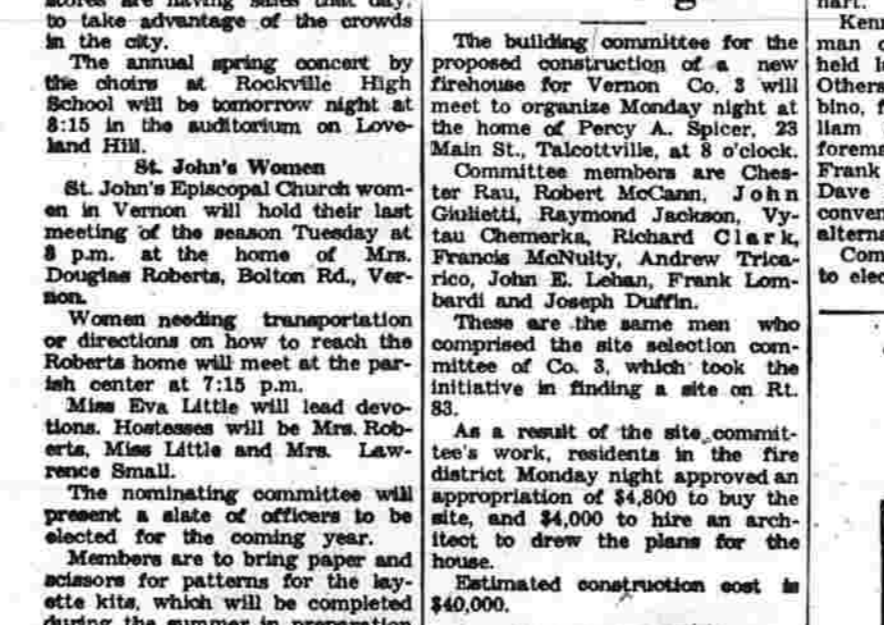

Columbia Motor Boat Law Passes Assembly

Rep. LaVerne Williams' bill to limit the operation of motor boats on Columbia Lake was passed in the State Senate Tuesday.

As amended, the bill gives the town the right to limit the use of the lake to town residents, non-resident taxpayers and tenants.

Identification markers, instituted by town ordinance, will be continued.

At one time, regulations adopted by the town concerning registration and equipment in 1960 were challenged by the State Boating Safety Commission.

When required, they have paid out in a very low accident rate. Williams said the town must now have its regulations revised and have them approved by the Boating Safety Commission.

Aunt Mamma's Molasses Squares are made by Miss Sylvia Claflin, 180 Henry St., from a recipe more than 50 years old. She modernized it to suit present-day tastes and appliances. Miss Claflin's 10 1/2 inch square pan was made especially for the recipe by a little old man who used to sit on the steps and share the warm squares with the family at their Aunt Mamma's in Whitinsville, Mass. They are especially good. Miss Claflin said served with squares of butter, p. cheese.

Aunt Mamma's Molasses Squares

- 1 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup shortening
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 cup molasses
- 1/2 cup raisins, ground
- 1/2 teaspoon soda
- 2 tablespoons hot water
- 2 1/2 cups flour
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon salt

Mix sugar and shortening in mixer at high speed. Add eggs and beat until creamy. Add molasses. Mix the soda and hot water and add to batter. Sift spices and salt with flour and add slowly to batter. Add ground raisins, which have been soaked in warm water before grinding. Spread in 13 x 9 inch pan and bake 25 to 30 minutes in 350 degree oven.

Miss Claflin was born in Denver, Colo., and received a B. S. degree in Education from Teacher's College, Columbia University, N.Y. She taught in Rockville for two years, Southbridge, Mass., 14 years, and Manchester, 17 years, five at Hollister St. School and the remainder at Bowers School.

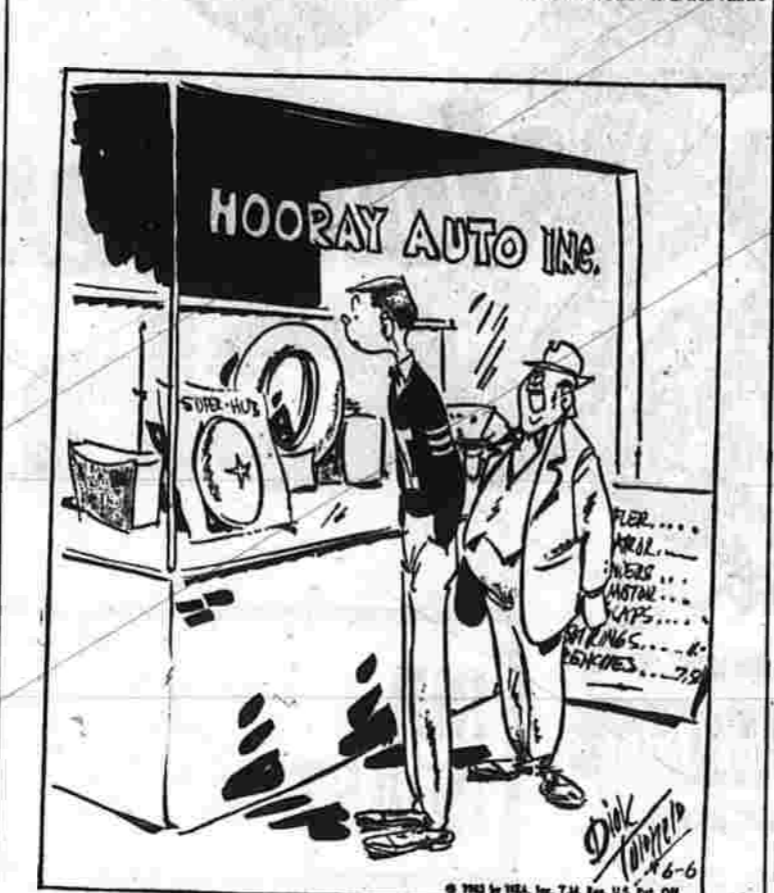

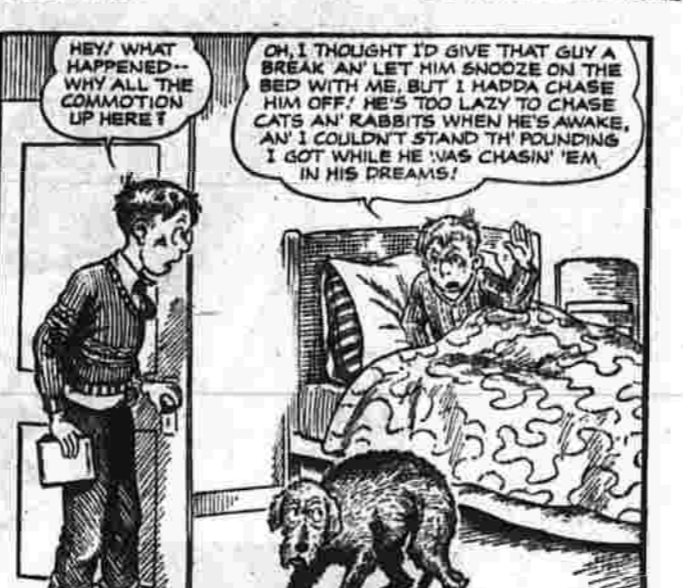
