New Road Program

Town directors spent a somewhat indecisive hour and a half at the Municipal Building last night, assembling from earlier proposals a new highway program to take the place of a project which was scratched from a public hearing agenda on Tuesday.

Some of the Republican minority on the board was present, however. Directors Richard Taylor and Francis DellaFera had previous discussions with A. Parkington regarding the project. The minority thus lost its last opportunity to influence the shape of the proposed bond-financed highway rebuilding program, which can only be scheduled for Oct. 29 at 8 p.m. at the Buckley School Auditorium.

Most of the hearing last night was caused by the apparently sticky problem of Hayes St. The road between Main St. and Manchester Memorial Hospital in 1961, there has been considerable interest in widening the road to insure unimpeded fire service. At the public hearing on Tuesday, Mayor Francis J. Mahoney announced that the highway reconstruction program the directors had been sent to discuss the Hayes St. access drive, and so it would be struck from the hearing agenda.

He did not ask for a vote of the full board, however, but he did announce the change. This move irritated the Republicans who do not wish to see a new road program which came out of last night's hearing. The project would cost \$600,000 worth of complete road reconstruction.

In the meantime, Mayor Mahoney has asked for a meeting between hospital officials, who own much of the land that could be used for a new access road, and other affected landowners, to work out a solution to the problem.

Chief Philip Corby, Deputy Chief Allan Barbeck, Lt. Arthur Snow, Harold Dodd, Walter Dorr, and Albert Gagnier approved it. Chief Egan also noted that preliminary work is progressing on plans for a third fire station in the northwest section of the town. The opening of the station and the 8-room addition to Pleasant St. fire station will be completed in order to be fully prepared for the new station. The opening of new men is scheduled for Tuesday, Oct. 29. Any male resident of South Windsor who is 21 years of age or older and is interested in joining the fire department may contact any fireman at the open house or may call Chief Egan, Fire Station No. 1, 10 Crombie Hill, Dr. Alton, South Windsor, for an application. He is also interested in joining the fire department. Chief Egan also noted that preliminary work is progressing on plans for a third fire station in the northwest section of the town. At its first meeting since the Oct. 7 election, the newly elected town council tabled for action at its next regular meeting appointments to appointive boards and commissions and town positions. Officers tabled were: Town attorney, dog warden, tree warden, tax assessor, fire marshal, independent auditor, zoning board of appeals, industrial development commission, board of library directors, public building commission, jury commission, board of tax review, insurance control commission, park and recreation commission, and clerk of the council. Added to this list by the council were the appointments to the personnel appeals board.

Mayor John Egan opened the meeting with an expression of thanks to the 45 residents for attending the meeting. He said "public notice to the previous council and former Mayor John Madden" for the work they accomplished. So the meeting could proceed on a "legal basis" the council voted tentative adoption of the rules of procedure of the previous council. A temporary committee was established to review these rules and report to the council by the second meeting in November. The committee includes Vernon Peterson, chairman; James Thrope and Carlo Piroletti. The other appointments made by the council during this meeting was to the refuse study committee of the Capital Regional Planning Association. Members representing South Windsor on this committee include Frederick Mahr, chairman; Joseph Carmo and James Thrope.

Water Problem
Councilman Thrope noted that he had received a petition from residents on Troy Rd. and Brookfield St. requesting the extension of the main water pipe from Sullivan Ave. to Troy Rd. and Brookfield St. Several families are without water on these streets because their wells have gone dry, and about one quarter of the families have to take their laundry elsewhere. As this seemed to be an immediate problem, Thrope suggested that the council suspend its regulations to begin action to bring water to these people. He noted as the pertinent questions in the matter: (1) who would bear the initial cost of the project; (2) how the project should be laid out. Regarding the cost, he suggested that either the town bear the initial burden (estimated about \$10,000) and "pass back" to the property owners; or there be a contract between the property owners and the Connecticut Water Co. Mayor Egan suggested that this matter be assigned to the health and safety committee. The council transferred \$500 from the contingency fund to the public supply and services fund for a uniform and equipment allowance for the selected constables. This allowance would be \$100 for each constable for two years, and would be paid to all constables elected in the last election. This action was recommended for favorable consideration by the previous council. It was felt that the part time elected constables might have difficulty paying for their equipment as they no longer

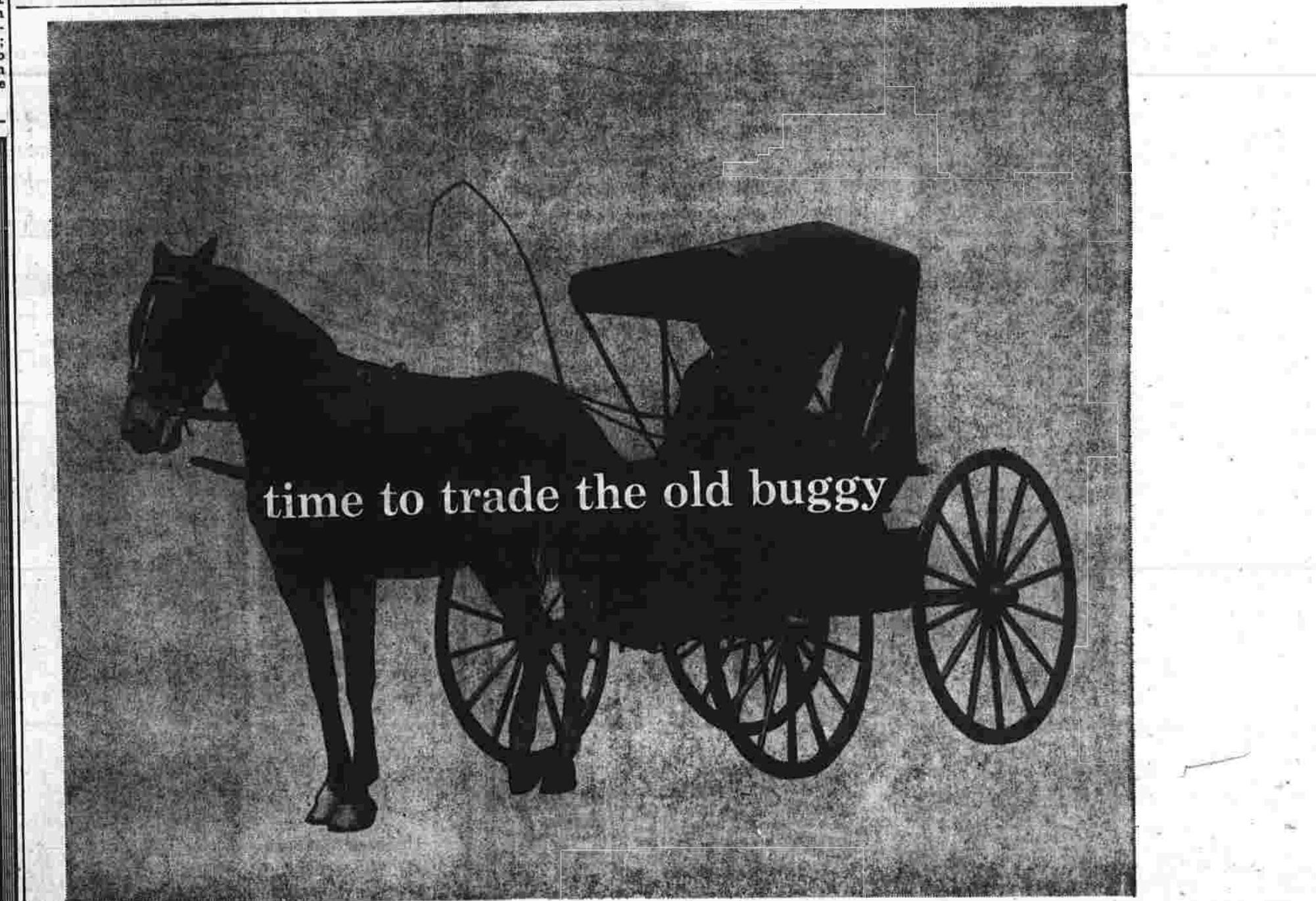
