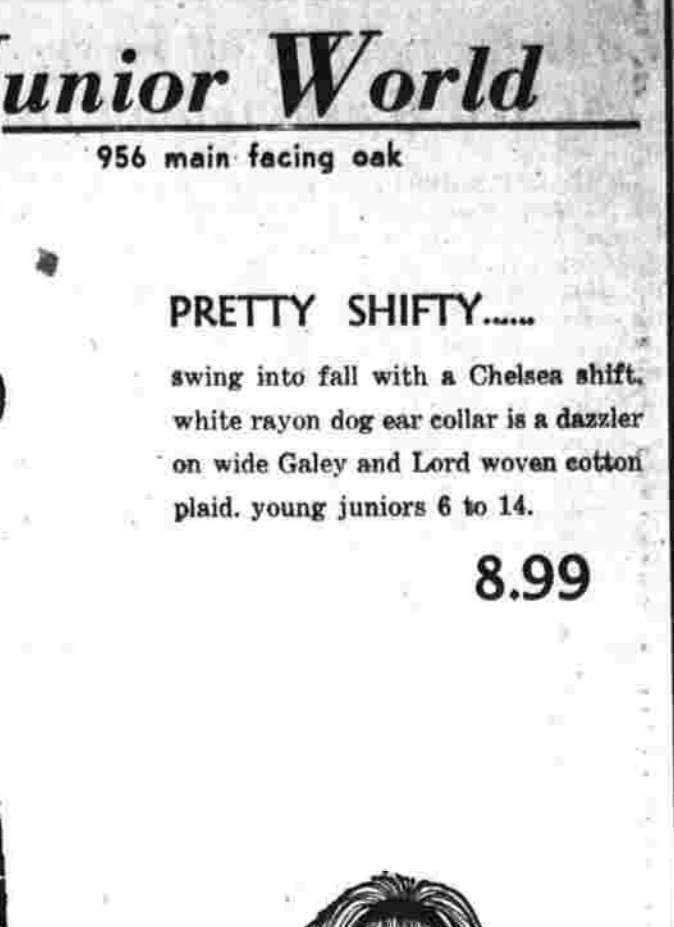

Oliver J. Minney of 45 St. Paul Dr. became a six-gallon donor at the Red Cross Bloodmobile visit Saturday at South Methodist Church. Even with Minney's help the mobile unit collected only 79 pints. The next visit will be Sept. 17 at St. Mary's Church from 1:45 to 3:30 p.m. Minney began his 48 donations during World War II and has continued to donate every three or four months since then. As he figures it, he might need some himself sometime. He also said it has been possible for him to help specific families who have needed blood, and that in itself has made it worthwhile. "Beide," he said, "it's really not strenuous. It's just a matter of going to the Red Cross. I'm a group supervisor in the materials accounting department at Treat and Whitney Division of United Aircraft. He is 52 years old, married with four children.

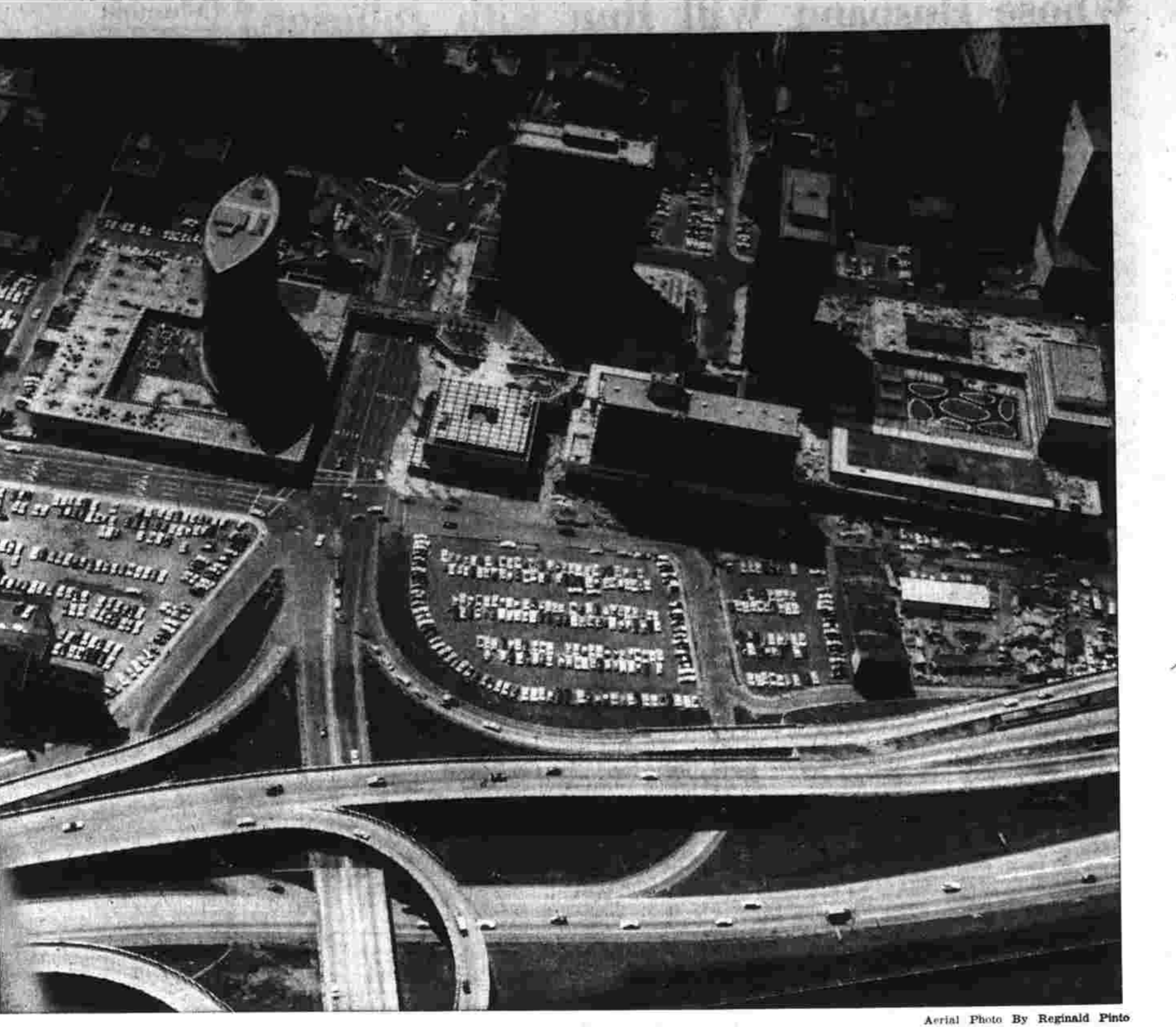

## Barnett Says Barry For Law and Order

Francis Barnett, three-term state representative and rector from Glastonbury, said last night that "no politician before Goldwater was nominated had the intellectual fortitude to come out for law and order."

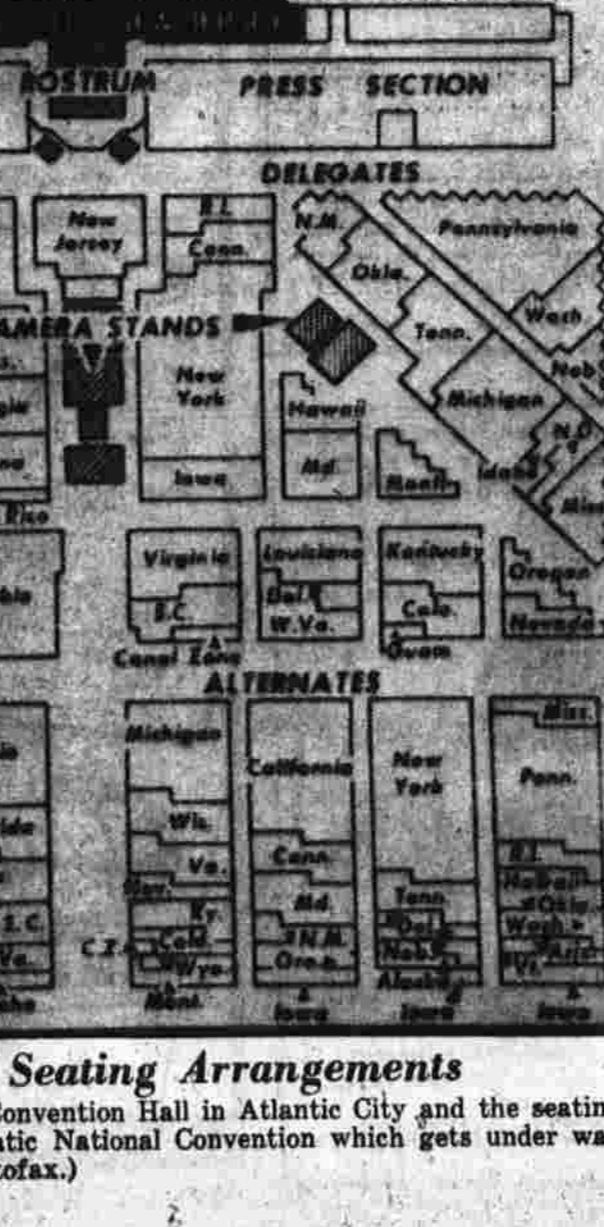
Three Americans Missing in Congo
