Vernon Joins 2 Other Towns In Refuse Disposal District

A handful of residents elected a special town meeting last night unanimously approved the town's participation in the Northham Refuse Disposal District.
The action brings to three the number of towns which will share in a solution of their refuse disposal problems.
The formation of the district is the result of a study conducted during the past year by representatives of Vernon, Manchester, Bolton and South Windsor.

Manchester directors unanimously approved a resolution last Tuesday which authorized their town into the district's activities. South Windsor approved participation at a town council meeting last Wednesday.
Of the four towns considering participation, only Bolton's action is unknown.

Members of the study commission will meet to consider composing as a possible method of financing the district. A decision will be passed on to a permanent commission which will be appointed from the participating towns.
Selectman Robert W. Deming is a member of the study group, presented the resolution at last night's meeting and explained that the district is not financially binding.

Deming indicated that 21 representatives to the district are now permitted under present state enabling statutes, but that the town may mutually agree to reduce that number.
Following the meeting, Deming estimated cost of the refuse operation at about \$60,000 annually. He said the town would be much more or much less, depending on what happens.

Deming also said that one proposal contained in the district's operations a reality by June, 1964, but several matters including the method of refuse disposal, must be decided before any firm target date is set.

While he was secretary to the Senate's Democratic majority, Sen. John J. Williams, R-Conn., who leveled the payoff charge in a Senate speech last week, said he had "no confidence what ever" in the Rules Committee and offered a substitute resolution directing the Government Operations Committee to conduct the inquiry.

The Operations Committee is headed by one of the Senate's best known investigators, Sen. John L. McClellan, D-Ark. Williams said an investigation by the Rules Committee, headed by Sen. H. Everett Jordan, D-N.C., would result only in "another batch of whitewash."

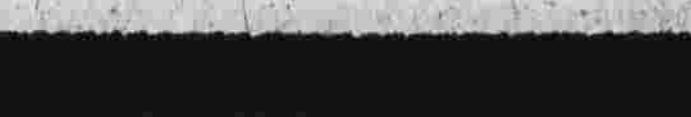

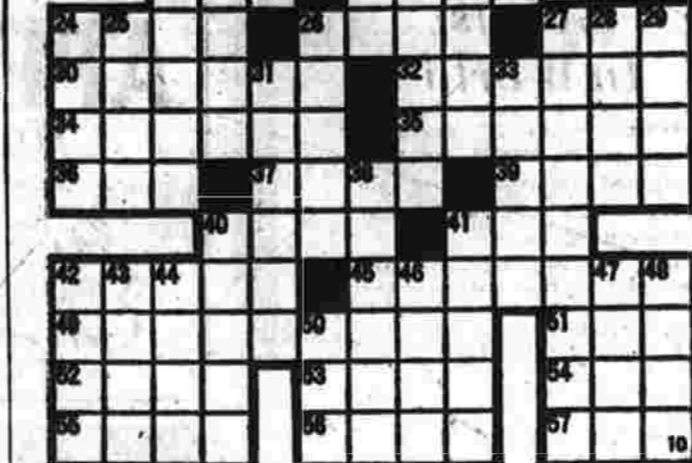

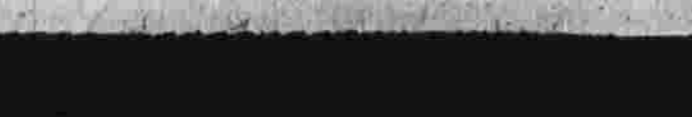
