December Is the Month To Cut Your Own Taxes

Instead of worrying about the tax consequences of your holiday purchases, spend your time to his advantage in making the tax on your 1964 income.

The rewards will be much greater and you won't have to leave the comforts of your own home.

This advice is not aimed at tycoons and Wall Street financiers and dealers. It applies to anyone who makes and spends money.

You can proceed in either of two ways — defer income until 1965 or increase your deductions for 1964. A combination of the two can be ideal.

First consideration in your thinking is that the tax rate on income will be cut again on Jan. 1, 1964. It was reduced already in 1963, and the rate on the first \$20,000 of income will be cut again on Jan. 1, 1965. Withholding rates were reduced to 1965 levels at the time of the first cut.

Since you will be paying a lower rate on your income for the year than this year, it follows that it would be wise to defer as much income as possible until the new year.

Many people, excepting those on regular salary schedules, control when their income is received. Commission salesmen may get checks as they send in the orders. If possible, let the orders stack up until after Jan. 1. Professionals, such as doctors, dentists, attorneys, accountants generally, receive their money after they send out their bills. New persons who exercise some control over when it comes in. So, too, with men or women in service businesses who send out bills for their work.

If you can control the income you certainly can control the deductions for the year.

Assume you will have a total income for the year of \$10,000 and that you already have paid \$275 in medical expense. There is no medical deduction on your return until

YOUR medical bills exceed \$1 per cent of income. If the \$100,000 man had an addition \$175 in medical fees he had not paid it. Think it's easy to get the \$175. It's not. It's a lot of money. In that way he would have paid \$1,500 in total expenses and \$150 in severable deductions.

So, if you are faced with medical payments and their payment in full will not give you a deduction for 1964, consider the possibility of deferring the payment until January. This would allow you to deduct expenses in the new year you might end 1964 with a deduction.

How about real estate taxes? Many states send out tax bills in December, but the deadline for payment is not until January. This gives you the choice of selecting your own tax year when the deduction will do you the greatest good.

It is possible under present tax laws to arrange your affairs as to lump medical deductions, extra real estate payments and overly generous charitable contributions into a year when you can deduct them. In alternate years, hold the payments down to the bare minimum and settle for one of the two varieties of standard deductions available on your return.

Once this routine is reduced to an exact science, it will be possible to save from 20 per cent to 25 per cent of many of your expenditures.

There is one time when you might want to reverse the deferred income procedure and lump as much as possible into this year. A new principle, known as income averaging, has been introduced into the tax laws this year. Now persons with widely fluctuating incomes may, in effect, spread their high earning periods over a five-year period.

If your income for 1964 will exceed by at least \$3,000 four-thirds of your average income for the last four years, you may want to use it.

Take for example: Your income for the years 1960 through 1963 has average \$9,000. Four-thirds of that is \$12,000. Now if you go beyond \$15,000 in 1964, you may want to use it.
