MOSCOW (AP) - Soviet protest against a reported West German proposal to lay an 800-mile nuclear mine belt across Europe has drawn a U.S. State Department reply that no such plans exist.

The Soviet news agency Tass said protest notes were given U.S. Ambassador Roy Kohler and West German Ambassador Horst Grepper as well as to the British and French envoys.

The notes said a nuclear mine belt would menace millions of lives and imperil the peace of Europe. West German authorities are reported to have suggested the mine belt at last month's NATO Council meeting in Paris.

U.S. and British defense experts were said at the time to have dismissed the scheme as wildly impractical.

Following the NATO meeting, U.S. Defense Secretary Robert S. McNamara confirmed that small nuclear demolition devices, which could be installed in mountain passes to halt an attacker, had been stockpiled in Europe as part of the NATO defense system.

Following the Soviet protest, a State Department spokesman in Washington said "there are no plans for the employment of any atomic mine belt along West Germany's eastern border."

LEOPOLDVILLE, the Congo (AP) - Premier Moise Chombani's government is said to have hired some 200 white mercenaries in Belgium, Spain, France and West Germany. Recruiting there is still under way.

GENEVA (AP) - The U.N. Central Opium Board says no significant progress has been made in 20 years in curtailing illicit traffic in narcotics. This is particularly true of morphine and heroin, the board said in a report to the U.N. Economic and Social Council.

JAKARTA, Indonesia (AP) - A Communist-led crowd of 50,000 marched on the presidential palace today, demanding dismissal of a Cabinet minister. They blame for the high cost of living and calling for seizure of all foreign holdings in Indonesia.

## Party Lever Upheld by High Court

WASHINGTON (AP) - The U. S. Supreme Court has affirmed the constitutionality of Connecticut's master party lever on voting machines.

The high court Monday upheld the decision of a three judge federal court which last June 22 in Hartford dismissed a complaint by three voters that the party lever violated their rights.

Indiana is the only state which has such a party lever system.

Both Gov. John Dempsey and John M. Bailey, the state and national Democratic chairman, have said they would oppose a bill prohibiting the mandatory party lever.
