Asked to explain the no-talk policy in view of reports from Middle Eastern countries, McCloskey told a news conference: "We take the position that while negotiations are going on they're classified."

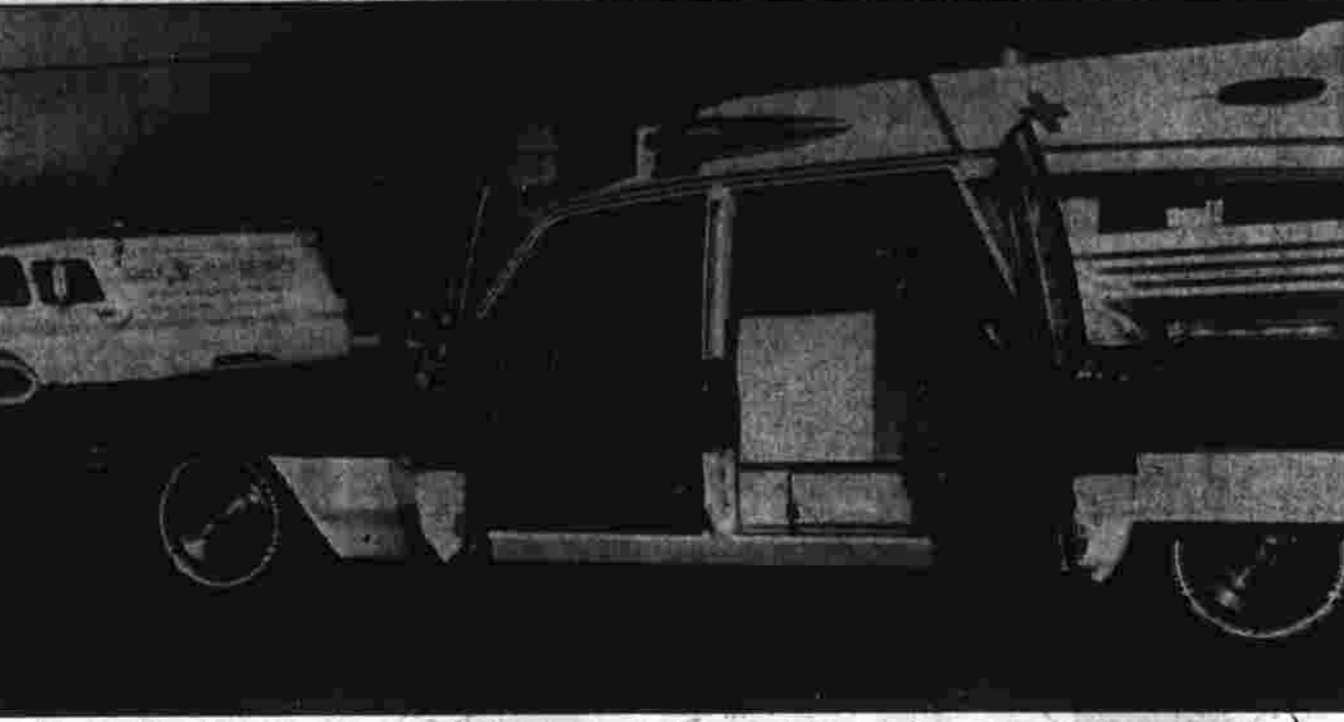
WASHINGTON (AP) — Pierre Salinger, former White House press secretary, believes the polls should close simultaneously during national elections.

Loses Election Bet, Leaves Country

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Late November Robert Ansett told his boss that he had such faith in Republican Barry Goldwater's chances for the presidency that he'd leave the country if he lost.

Hedge Shears Pierce Heart, Man Recovers

ATLANTA, Ga. (AP) — A father of three whose heart was pierced by the blade of a hedge shears in a track accident is so happy to be alive he is thinking of how he can help others.

"I guess the good Lord was with us," said William C. Sharp Sr. from a hospital bed Wednesday.

The 46-year-old business executive, who came to Atlanta from Valley Forge, Pa., last August, said he was still pinching himself over being alive.

His wife, Sylvia, said he felt there must be some reason for his being saved. He has decided to do something for others, perhaps in church work.

Sharp missed death by the narrowest of margins. "I pulled those hedge clippers out of my chest, and when I saw about six inches of red blood on the blade, I knew I was in real trouble," he said.

He almost died to death. A doctor said the blade injured the right ventricle. Open heart surgery and blood transfusions saved him.

The accident occurred at the Sharp residence in northeast Atlanta. He was preparing to clip some weeds in his yard when the shears slipped and pierced his chest.

Sharp said he attempted to stop over a fence, missed his footing and fell forward. In trying to break the fall he landed, feet and head, on the shears and received a deep stab wound.

Speakers Differ on Value Of Rapid Transit for Area

By ROBERT FITZPATRICK Should the Capitol Region start planning for a rapid transit system? Two speakers, Daniel T. Scannell of the N.Y.C. Transit Authority, last night's town planning forum in the University of Connecticut, did not see rapid transit as a favorable option as did Scannell.

"These appear to be an awakening in the United States that efforts must be made to get the people living within the urban complex to leave their cars at home for a transit facility and for those living in the suburbs to drive to a mass transportation medium as a means of going to work."

Scannell marshaled an impressive array of facts to back up his statement. He began his 30-minute talk admitting that the car has contributed "not only to the development and expansion of cities but also to the growth of the suburbs."

But before long he was bringing up facts and studies to show that the car was a menace to the vitality of the city.

Scannell said that the car was a menace to the vitality of the city. He pointed out that the commuter service carried 50,000 passengers in the space of an hour during a peak period.

To duplicate this with the car, it would take a 20-lane limited access highway—going in one direction. The report, said Scannell, did not consider what would happen to all those cars once they got into Manhattan.

But New York is a larger city than Hartford, he said. "The study said that Atlanta, with an area population of 1.1 million and the prospect of an unlimited access highway converging upon it by 1970, was faced with an intensification of congestion on its approaches and streets, and an increased demand for parking."

According to Capitol Region Planning Agency population projections, the capital region will reach a saturation point in the year 200 with a population of 1.7 million.

Before proposing the regional subway, the engineers considered an alternative "Express buses operating over the regional expressway system to off-street bus terminals on the fringes of central Atlanta, a local, mass transportation facility connecting these terminals to central Atlanta."

 1/4 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce  
 1/2 cup medium cream

LONDON (AP) — Snowstorms lashed Britain from end to end today and turned the land of rain and fog into an icebox.

Villages were isolated, train and automobile traffic crowded, international flights were delayed, some for hours.

A finger of the blizzard also reached into France. More than two inches of snow struck Paris before dawn.

Blizzards also descended on Poland and Czechoslovakia. Thousands of East Germans were ordered out to clear their main highways and railroad lines. Berlin had a heavy snow. In Britain, up to 10 inches of snow fell from the Scottish border to the English Channel. Winds piled drifts as high as 10 feet.

The countryside was littered with abandoned vehicles. Hundreds opened their doors to stranded travelers.

The daily influx of millions of commuters into London was chaotic. Trains were late or not running at all. Schools in many areas were closed.

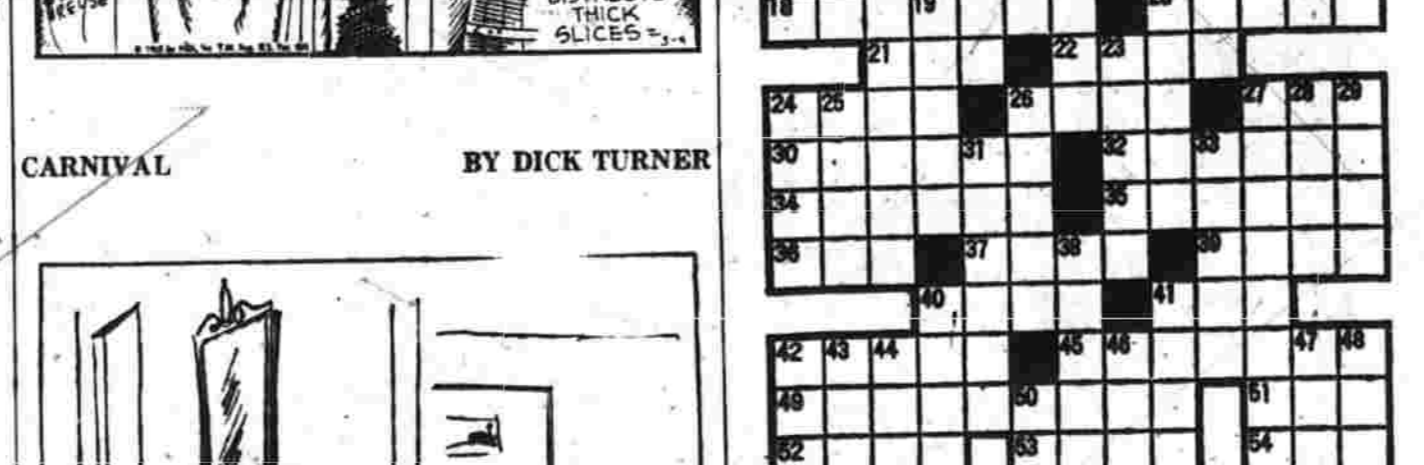

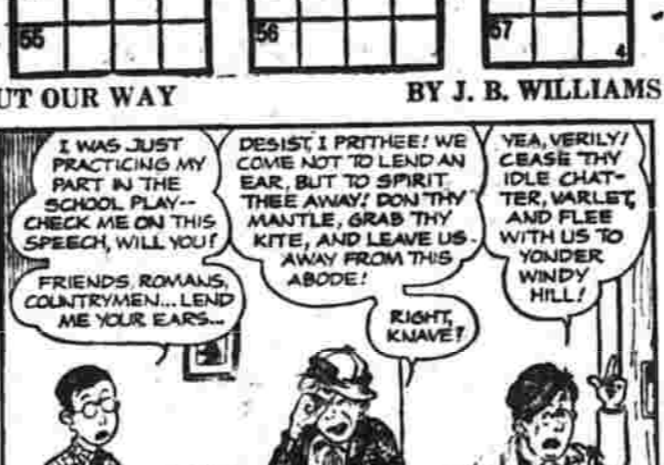
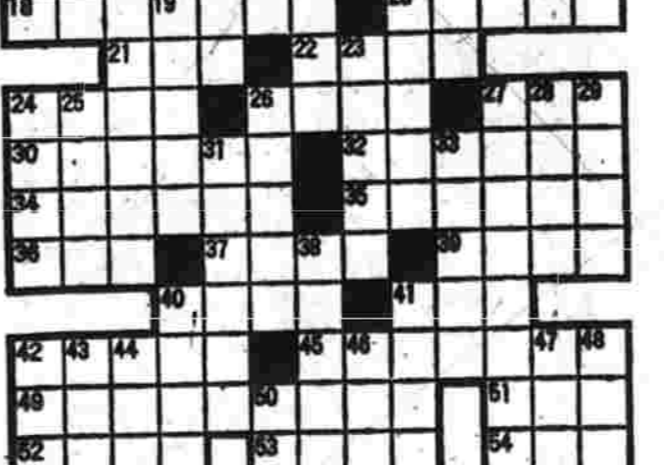
