





Apartments Denied CAPCC Wants State Funds, But Local College Control

After a lengthy public hearing last night the zoning board of appeals voted four to one to deny a request to construct a garden-type apartment complex on the Calhoun property off Oak Grove St.

Problem of state vs. local control prevented the Connecticut Association for Public Community Colleges (CAPCC) from making any legislative commitment to a project at its meeting last night in Manchester.

The project, according to Gerald Diamond, of the Development Corporation of America, would have cost an estimated \$1.5 million and rented for between \$10 and \$17.50 per month. A similar application had been submitted to the zoning board in January, but it was withdrawn without protest.
