Police Ask Change In Retirement Plan

Improvements in the pension plan for town policemen, expressing the need for increasing pension payments and reducing the required years of service and retirement age, has been proposed by the town Patrolmen's Association.

The proposed changes would increase the retirement age to 50 per cent of their pay at retirement, enable them to retire at the age of 50, providing they have completed at least 25 years of service.

At present, police retire with a pension of about 35 per cent of their wages and are eligible for retirement at 55, providing they have completed 30 years of service.

John Baldyga, a police department mechanic, said that the retirement of the policemen who retire between 1970 and 1980 will be close to 80 years old before they are eligible for pensions under the present plan.

According to Pension Board chairman Henry Becker, an actuarial review of the policemen's pension plan would be a substantial increase in the pension cost if the plan were implemented.

Becker said the board's secretary, Homer Anderson, says the cost would increase because the payments would be higher and because the policemen would be over five fewer years than they do now.

While the last increase in the pension plan does not require an increase in the town's share of the cost, Anderson says "doubts that this would be true for the proposed plan."

He said the increase in the cost of the plan probably could not be financed through increases in the policemen's contribution to the plan, since they are now paying 10 per cent of their salary for pensions and contributing toward social security as well.

No specific costs for the improvements have been computed, however, Anderson is currently working out the costs.

Becker said that the policemen submit their reasons for asking the change in the pension plan in writing for the board to review. The proposal is in writing for the board to review. The proposal is in writing for the board to review.

State Rep. Atty. Paul Groobert, with the backing of Town Democratic Chairman Ted Cummings and other highly placed members of the town committee, appears to be the leading candidate for endorsement as the 4th Senatorial District's delegate to the forthcoming State Constitutional Convention.

The Democratic Town Committee will meet on March 31, to endorse its candidate and to fill two vacancies on its slate of delegates to the April 7 convention of the 1st Congressional District, called to select seven Democratic delegates to the Constitutional Convention.
