No Nuclear Weapons Needed In Viet Nam Yet—McNamara

Says Cong Activities Increasing

WASHINGTON (AP)—Secretary of Defense Robert S. McNamara said today Communist aggression against South Viet Nam "has grown progressively more flagrant" but there is no military requirement for the use of nuclear weapons.

A regular North Vietnamese battalion of 400 to 500 men is now in the South, he said, adding that some 39,000 Communist troops are expected to join in the fighting.

These forces, plus other Viet Cong guerrillas already there, have lost 89,000 men killed, the secretary said.

McNamara, reporting on the Viet Nam fighting in a news conference carried nationally by radio and television, said the war is costing the United States about \$1.5 billion a year, \$500 million of it for U.S. land, sea and air forces directly involved in the fighting.

He opened with a 16-minute statement and then answered questions.

Among other things he said: "There is clear evidence that the nearly three months of bombings of highways, bridges, railroads and other infiltration routes in the North had caused the Communists morale problems and have made them extend their limited resources."

There are indications of a substantial buildup of Communist forces in the highland area west of the Da Nang airbase, a key U.S. position in South Viet Nam, over the past 12 months.

U.S. Planes Return Safely After Five New Viet Raids

SAIGON, South Viet Nam (AP)—U.S. and South Vietnamese planes struck roads and waterways in North Viet Nam in five raids today.

All the planes reportedly returned safely despite heavy ground fire in some areas.

Air activity in South Viet Nam also was unusually heavy as U.S. Air Force jets flew 68 sorties, most of them in mountainous central Viet Nam.

Large concentrations of Viet Cong troops in several central Vietnamese provinces have prompted heavy raids in the recent past.

The one U.S. fatality of the day occurred when a U.S. light spotting plane collided with a Vietnamese air force plane. The American plane crashed into the trees and burst into flames, killing the pilot.

Both planes had been providing cover for a jungle operation 20 miles northeast of Saigon.

The Vietnamese spotting plane returned to its base with one wheel gone and made a safe landing.

In the heaviest of the raids on North Viet Nam, 45 U.S. Air Force jets hit road traffic and bridges along Routes 7, 8 and 12.

The jets "severely damaged" the Bai Duc Thon highway bridge, 160 miles south of Hanoi on Route 12, a U.S. spokesman said.

The Air Force planes also hit two railroad boxcars and a truck depot and supply area.

In two Navy raids, six jets from the carrier Hancock attacked a camouflaged patrol boat about 60 feet long and reportedly sank it.

Two propeller-driven Navy planes from the carrier Midway spotted a new highway bridge 100 miles south of Hanoi and made craters in the approach to the bridge. They did not damage the bridge itself.

In operations Sunday, two U.S. Marines were killed in a Viet Cong attack; four air attacks on North Viet Nam hit approaches to a bridge, a ferry station and road traffic; and

U.S. Air Force and Marine Corps jets flew 44 missions against suspected Viet Cong positions in the south.

Twelve U.S. Air Force F105s and F106s attacked a three-span, 160-foot bridge in a narrow valley at Bai Duc Than, about 180 miles south of Hanoi. Officials in Saigon said the bridge approaches were destroyed.

Dominican Planes Hit Rebel Army Positions

SANTO DOMINGO, Dominican Republic (AP)—Dominican air force planes strafed rebel army positions today in an attempt to clear a route into Santo Domingo for a tank unit opposed to the return to power of ex-President Juan Bosch.

Rebel army forces passed out rifles and machine guns to about 3,000 civilians. Another 10,000 to 15,000 civilians were reported to be in possession of bottled gasoline bombs for use against any tank attack. Gasoline stations passed out gasoline free.

Two air force planes strafed a rebel army barracks behind the presidential palace, where ousted civilian junta leader Donald Reid Cabral is being held for his own safety. There was no report on damage.

Two other planes made five strafing passes at Duarte Bridge, where rebel tanks and artillery guarded the only route into the capital for the tanks stationed at San Isidro air base.

At the base, Brig. Gen. Elias Wessing y Wessing held command of about 1,500 troops and about 30 tanks. Although he appears to have accepted the forced resignation Sunday of Reid's junta, he is opposed to the return of Bosch, a liberal living in exile in Puerto Rico.

Officials said eight persons were known to have been killed in fighting. They included a 6-year-old.

Rebel leaders seized relatives, including the wives and children, of Wessing's pilots and some of them were taken to Duarte Bridge. Then the Santo Domingo radio broadcast that the pilots would kill their own families if they attacked the bridge again.

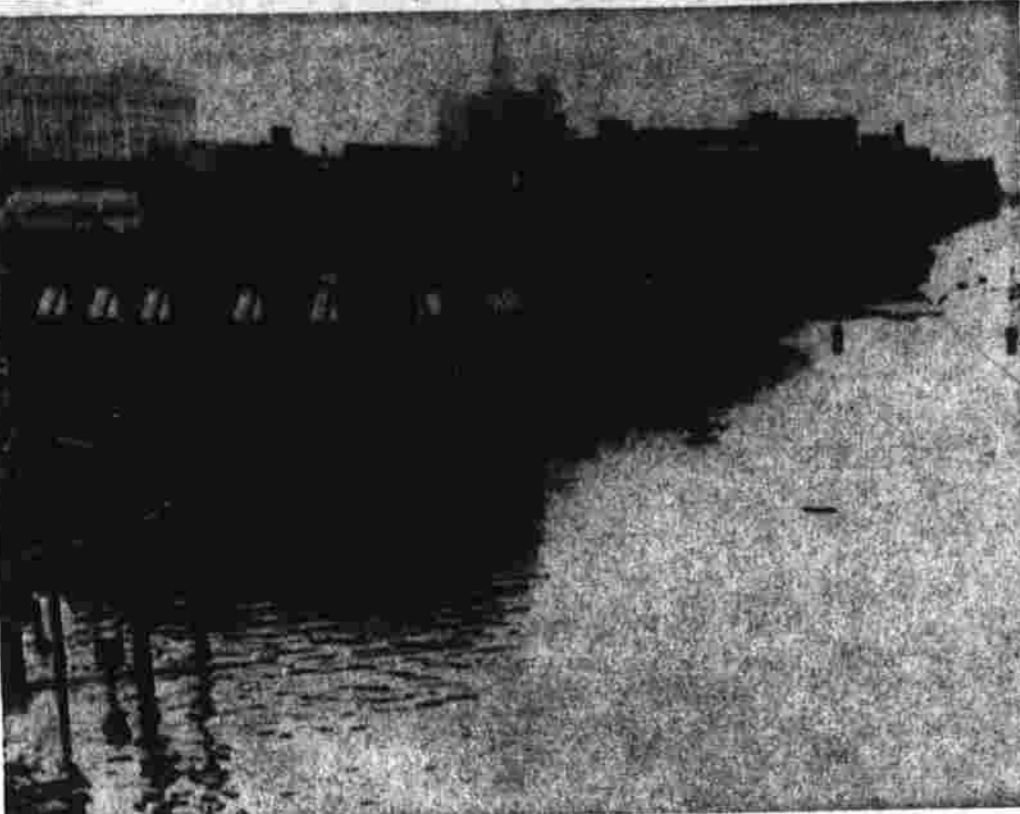

Flooded Mississippi Strains Davenport, Iowa, Sand Bags

Soggy Quad-Cities Await River Peak

CHICAGO (AP)—Flood-weary residents of the quad-cities area of Illinois and Iowa bolstered sagging makeshift dikes today and waited apprehensively for the Mississippi River to attain its crest.

A predicted peak of 22.5 feet, more than seven feet above the flood stage, is expected in the heavily populated area Tuesday or Wednesday. The peak was 21.5 today.

With sections of Rock Island and East Moline, Ill., and Davenport, Iowa, already flooded, volunteers continued sandbagging operations in hopes of keeping the rising Mississippi from pushing into new areas.

In Moline, adjoining East Moline, flood workers labored on to strengthen an emergency dike protecting the city's water plant. City officials feared the dike might give way and cut off water supplies to Moline's 48,000 residents.

Across the river in Bettendorf, Iowa, just north of Davenport, the battle to hold back the approaching river peak also was stepped up.

In Rock Island, where an industrial area already is under water, city officials said leaks were appearing in a three-mile dike. If the dike bursts, they said, the flood would pour onto a 300-home housing project of 1,300 residents.

The floodwaters, which have driven more than 60,000 persons from their homes in three states, were fed by heavy rains over the weekend.

The U.S. Weather Bureau said the worst is still to come.

The flood crest of the Mississippi moving downstream from Dubuque, Iowa, will combine with the flow from tributaries to produce more floods by next weekend, the Weather Bureau said.

The floods will occur from Keokuk, Iowa, through Hannibal, Mo., the bureau said. "This will be a critical flood situation for the entire area and local officials and the public should

take steps to prepare for the rises."

The Quad Cities area in Illinois and Iowa with a combined population of 260,000 was the prime danger spot. The area is composed of Moline, Rock Island and East Moline, Ill., and Davenport, Iowa.

In Rock Island, workers labored around the clock to reinforce the earthen dam, the only protection for the housing complex. Most residents had been evacuated after a warning from Mayor Forrest Muhleman that water was seeping through the dike. More than 1,000 volunteers worked with Army engineers to reinforce the levee.

Another dike burst in Rock Island Sunday, covering the equivalent of a 64-block industrial area with six feet of water. The 400 residents had been evacuated.

The latest reading of the waters in Rock Island, a city of 51,000 in the northwestern corner of Illinois near the Iowa border, was 21 feet. Flood stage is 15 feet. A crest of 22.5 feet is expected Tuesday or Wednesday.

One-third of East Moline's 2,000 residents have been evacuated. More than 20 blocks of the city's waterfront area are under water.

ORANGE (AP)—A gunman wearing a brown raincoat and a pearl gray cossack hat held up a branch of the People's Savings Bank today and escaped in a white convertible with \$3,900.

A bank spokesman said there were no customers in the bank on Orange Center Road when the man entered shortly after the 9 a.m. opening time.

"Don't fool around and nobody will get hurt," the man said. He directed manager John O. Monks to the tellers' area at gunpoint and ordered the two women tellers on duty to lie on the floor.

Smoke Kills Area Woman In Her Home

A 37-year-old South Windsor housewife apparently suffocated to death last night when a living room chair caught fire and filled the house with smoke.

Indian Forces Alert, Claim Pakistan Strike

NEW DELHI, India (AP)—India alerted its armed forces today and recalled all personnel on leave as Defense Minister Y. B. Chavan declared that large Pakistani forces were attacking along India's western border.

Chavan told 8,000 men — of Pakistani infantry supported by tanks was attacking Bihar, about six miles inside territory claimed by India in the disputed Ramnagar area.

He said Pakistani forces attacked Bihar Sunday night but were beaten off.

"This morning's news," said Chavan, "states that Pakistan is again attacking Bihar with a brigade of infantry and a sizable force of armor."

The Indians charged that Pakistan had for the first time thrown tanks into the area and that three of them were destroyed.

Pakistan said the fighting resulted from an outbreak of rioting by Indian troops.

"Pakistan had to take swift retaliatory action last night in the Chad Bet area of the Ramnagar following repeated firing on its positions by the Indian army," administration spokesmen said. He said Indian guns were silenced, with heavy Indian casualties.

The United States was reported to be sending military aid to India.

2-Cent Hike To Steelmen Seen Coming

PITTSBURGH, Pa. (AP)—The steel industry is reported ready to raise its offer of a two-per cent pay hike for the United Steelworkers Union in exchange for a strike postponement.

Smoke Bomb Stalls Maddox-Led Parade

ATLANTA, Ga. (AP)—More than 1,000 cheering, sign-waving whites paraded through downtown Atlanta Sunday behind segregationist Lester Maddox, ignoring heavy rain showers, but detouring when a smoke bomb was thrown in their line of march.

Maddox, the former restaurant owner who was the first person convicted under the 1964 Civil Rights Act, set up the march. He said it was to protest governmental takeover of private property rights.

Police said the bomb, which gave off a reddish-pink smoke, was thrown in front of the marchers by an unidentified white man. Few marchers were aware of the incident as a police captain quickly routed them down another street.

Maddox, who spoke to the group later beside a city park, charged that the federal government is enforcing only the portions of the U.S. Constitution "resulting in centralization of government, loss of private property rights and loss of individual freedom."

WASHINGTON (AP) — Rapidly rising passport applications indicated today that more Americans than ever before will travel abroad this year.

This is despite the fact that the cost of travel has risen sharply and some say partly because of a President Eisenhower's effort to discourage the outpouring of U.S. tourists overseas.

A part of the campaign to curb the gold drain, Johnson is plugging "Use the U.S.A." vacation trips.

According to preliminary estimates here, about 12 million Americans were abroad in 1964. This figure, a new high does not count travel to Canada and Mexico which are considered within the dollar area.

The travel count for 1965 won't be until next year. But applications for passports are a sign of what is to come — and business in the Department of State.

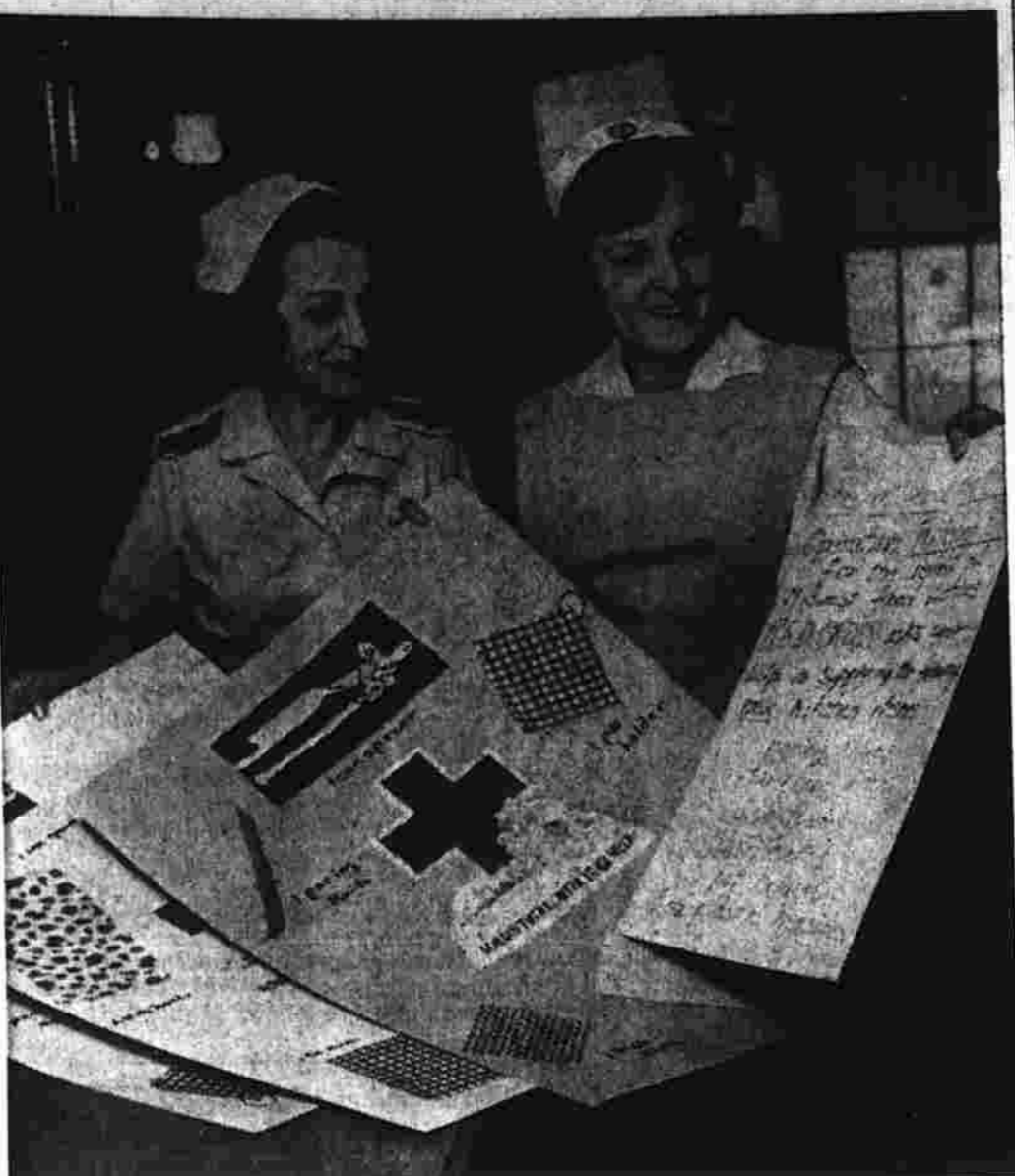

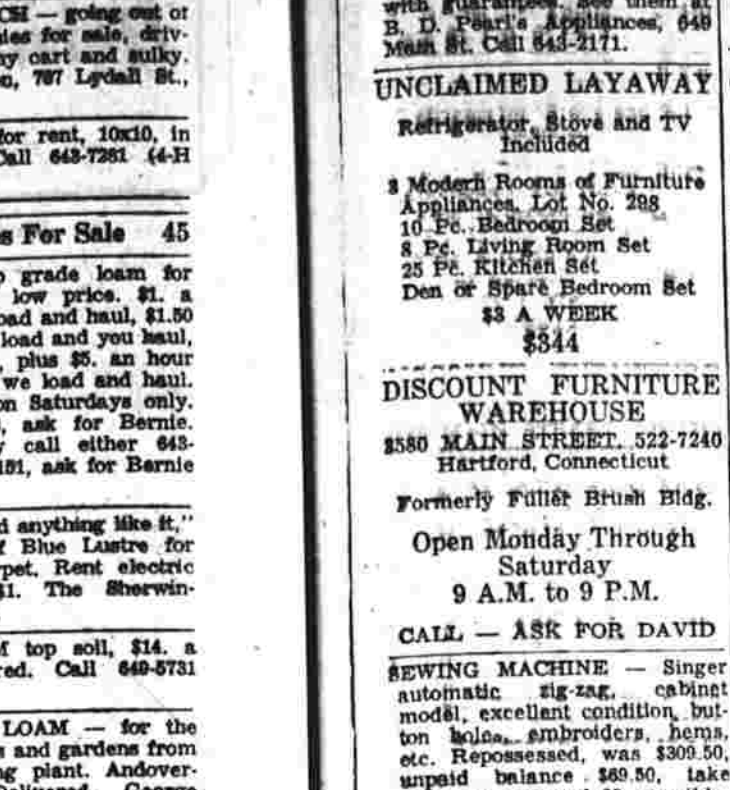

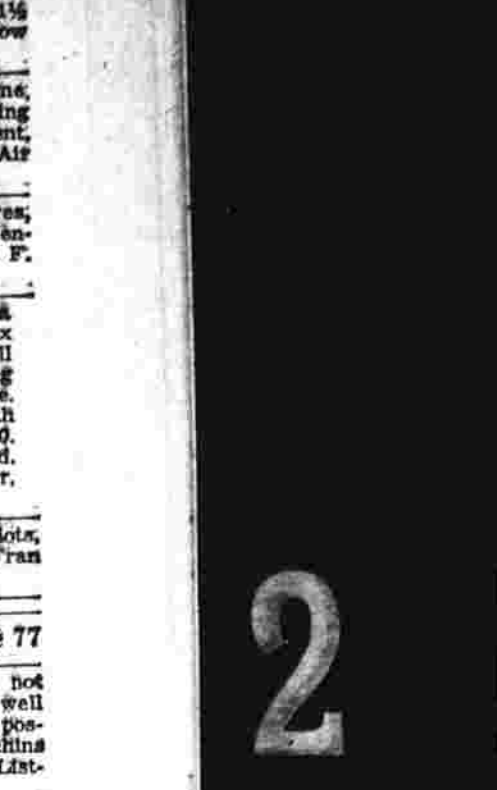
