Many Spoils to Winner Of Space Race to Moon

BOSTON, Two (AP)—The United States and the Soviet Union are locked in a tight race to reach the moon first. The winner's rewards will be great: national prestige, scientific knowledge, perhaps military dominance in space.

"For these reasons the moon has retained a record which probably goes back billions of years to the infancy of the solar system," the estimated \$20 billion prize.

That's a lot of money, says James Webb, administrator of the National Space Administration. "But as big as that \$20 billion looks, we are spending only one per cent of our gross national product on space."

The United States plans to attempt a soft-landing of an instrumented capsule on the moon if it reaches there as scheduled Friday.

It is not being sent on the moon as people like to infer it is being sent right here in the United States.

Rockville-Vernon \$5 Million Budget Okayed by Voters

Vernon's first consolidated budget was approved at a three-hour public hearing last night, despite an unsuccessful attempt to reject the budget and adjourn the meeting. No cuts were made in the \$5 million budget.

The last by opponents of the budget came shortly after the hearing opened. A motion proposed to adjourn the meeting was rejected by moderator Alty Herbert Hansbury. His finding was doubted, and a show of hands was ordered.

The adjournment motion was defeated 86 to 43. Following that vote, except for some heated discussions, the approval of the budget was smooth.

The major controversial item within the budget was a \$2,000 increase in salary for Vernon's mayor, Thomas J. McCusker.

Rockville Mayor Leo E. Flaherty Jr. said at the hearing, "If you cut this item, you will bear the brunt of this town."

"I received \$2,000 for the six years I was mayor," Flaherty said, "and I lost money every year."

Some objectors noted that in addition to the \$2,000 for the mayor's salary, the town would also pay about \$10,000 for an administrative assistant, bringing the cost of administrative salaries to \$12,000.

Mayor Flaherty noted that it may be some time before an administrative assistant is selected, and when chosen, it will be several months before he is fully acquainted with the town's administration. He requested that Mayor-elect McCusker, and that a \$5 million budget is in view.

"Everyone must rely upon this man (McCusker)," Mayor Flaherty said.

"If you scrap this salary, you might as well have rejected consolidation. You elect McCusker, you ought to pay him," Flaherty added.

One resident who observed, "We are talking about one-one thousandth of the budget. Couldn't we talk about a larger item?"

Budget opponents, or those opposed to the mayor's proposed salary, appeared disappointed after the passage of the \$5,000 item. From the 150 voters left the meeting in small groups, so that about half of those originally in attendance were left when the meeting ended at 11 p.m.

Robert W. Deming, chairman of the finance committee of the Board of Representatives, answered many of the questions pertaining to budget items.

Deming noted the extreme difficulties encountered in affixing the budgets of the three established governments, the city, town and district, and combining them all under one unified budget.

Added to the difficulties were the fact that for comparison purposes, the city's last budget was only 7 1/2 months. Unlike the town and the district, the city was not under a uniform fiscal year.

Town's Receipts Pass Estimates

Revenue paid into the town's General Fund as of May 31 totals about \$150,000 above estimates, according to a report issued by Collector of Revenue Ernest M. Mitchell and, with this month's receipts still to be added, the figures corroborate an earlier estimate that the 1964-65 surplus will reach or surpass \$250,000.

The board of directors, in May of 1964, had estimated General Fund receipts totaling about \$828,000. The total has reached approximately \$878,000.

June receipts, added to an estimated \$70,000-\$80,000 surplus in departmental allocations, will assure the \$250,000 total surplus estimate.

The board, when it set next year's budget, had estimated a \$197,000 surplus from current funds. In addition, other town funds have also reported receipts above the original estimate.

The Town Fire District Fund is already \$12,000 higher than had been estimated. The Downtown Parking District Fund is \$1,500 plus its goal, the Dog License Fund is \$5,000 above estimates and the Town Sewer Fund, \$700.

The Town Water Fund, which is still \$16,000 from its mark, is expected to pass its goal with receipts received in June.

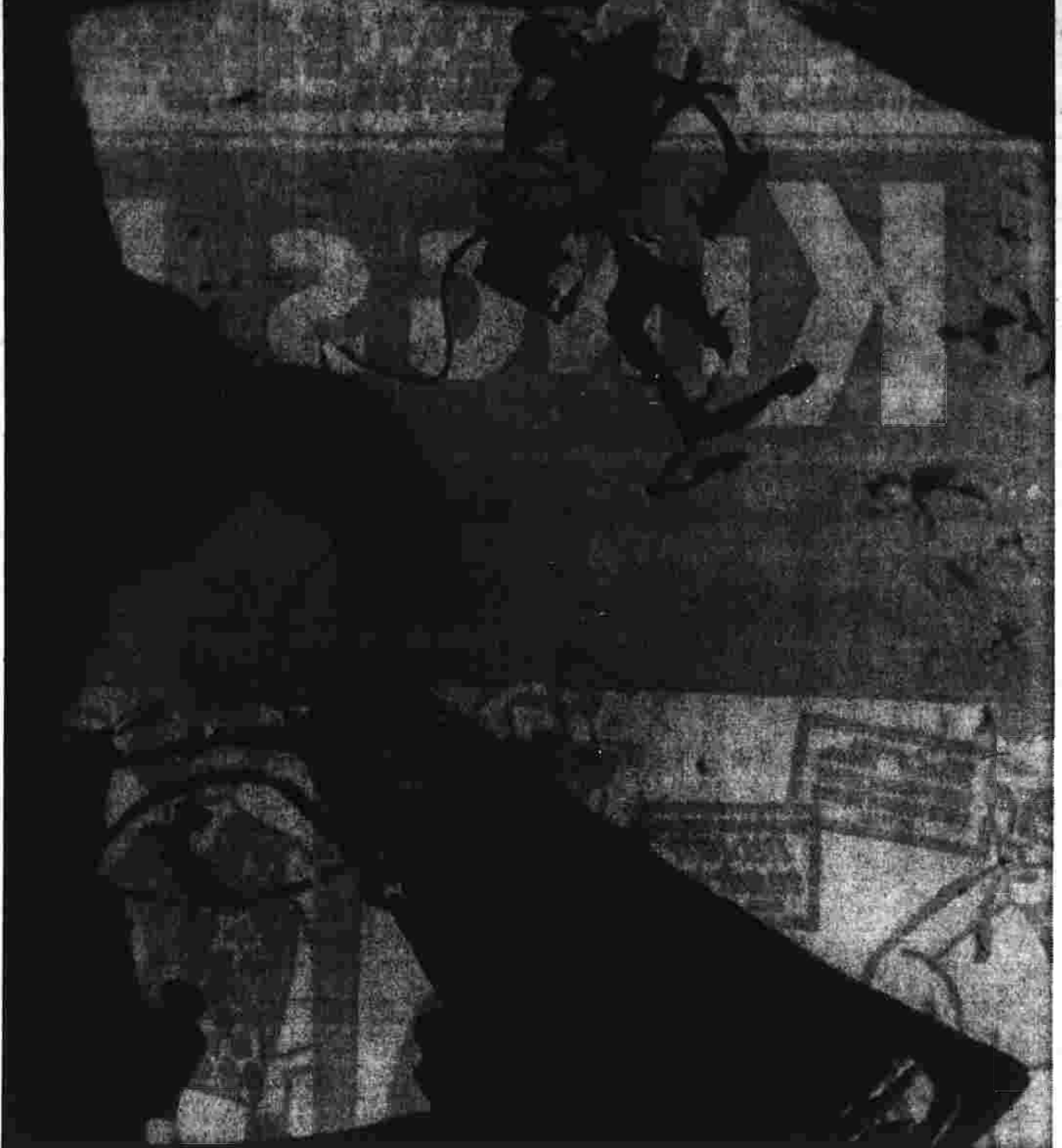
