Rioting Teens Terrified, Psychotherapist States

NEW YORK (AP)—Teen-agers who riot are in terror of the adult world which they feel is hostile to them, says Dr. Rhoda L. Lerner, a psychoanalyst who specializes in treating youngsters.

Boys who whop it up at several summer resorts last weekend "were expressing lack of confidence in their own masculinity as well as hostility toward their parents and a need to discharge sexual tension in this disturbed way," Dr. Lerner said in an interview.

Many people, says Dr. Lerner, explain the riots as nothing but a search for excitement. "But some young people who act the worst have been subjected to extremely harsh discipline — to harsh," she said.

The adult world seems dangerous to all these youngsters because they feel so inadequate in it. They demand for love, affection and self-control. In a group they give each other support for acting out their childish fears.

Maritime Strike Alters Many Vacationers' Plans

Maritime Strike Alters Many Vacationers' Plans

NEW YORK (AP)—As the maritime strike rages, more than 4,000 vacationers have been forced to seek alternate transportation because of a 42-day strike of ship officers which went into its fourth week today.

Stallings were canceled for the 22,000-ton United States flag ship of the U.S. Lines and the nation's largest and fastest liner, the Grace Lines' 15,300-ton Santa Rosa.

Lapses in passenger bookings to the three lines was estimated at over \$2 million. The U.S. Maritime Administration reported 211 ships tied up. The strike also cost \$2 million per day in lost wages to the industry.

WASHINGTON (AP) — Some Latin-American leaders expressed concern today that the Organization of American States is falling apart at the seams.

At a time when many nations in the hemisphere are displaying new confidence about their prospects, the OAS is running a fever.

Influential leaders say the Dominican episode has been a severe blow to an already ailing organization. Some say it faces the threat of yet another jolt if its special pleyer and conference opens on schedule Aug. 4 in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

It is clear to Latin-Americans that the North American would supply the backbone of any inter-American force. Many Latin Americans are skeptical about the OAS machinery. There is some slow resistance to Rio de Janeiro to an attempt to force the issue of an effective force.

Hue Calm, Beautiful In Midst of Warfare

HUE, SOUTH VIETNAM (AP) — Barely touched by the war, Hue remains one of the most beautiful and most peaceful cities in South Vietnam.

A city with palaces, royal tombs and lush tropical hills along the banks of the gently flowing River of Perfumes. Hue is clean and well-kept. Many of the 2,000 U.S. servicemen in Hue believe it is the most pleasant city in South Vietnam.

Hue has so far resisted the commercialization and quickening pace of life in Saigon and Da Nang. As more Americans pour into the area — some 2,000 U.S. Marines have established a beachhead only 12 miles south of Hue at Phu Bai — this may change.

But the face of an American still is pretty much of an oddity to many of Hue's 120,000 inhabitants.

A highlight of Hue's beauty is the walled Imperial City. Other wars and time, however, have ravaged many of the ornate monuments first erected in the early 18th century under the reign of Emperor Gia Long.

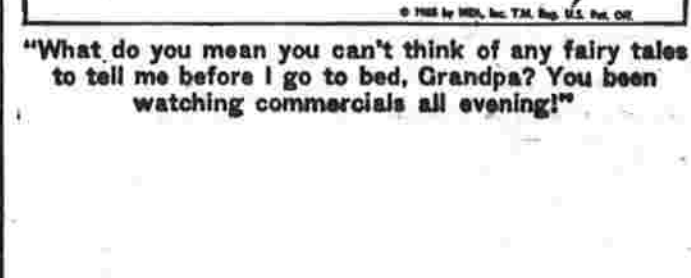

Vernon Town Needs Unified Plan To Get Funds

Members were told that they must bring together Rockville and Vernon's planning programs as soon as possible, "hopefully" even before the federal money can be applied for.

John Marino was selected chairman of the zoning board of appeals with Norman Conroy as vice chairman and Ann B. Humphrey as secretary.

Forsley said the town must have an application in by Aug. 15 to get funds early next year for a neighborhood study under the 701 program.

The study, which will take a year, is a required step before the town can apply for funds toward open space or recreation areas.

Rockville had applied earlier this year for funds toward such a study but the state, which acts as agent for the federal government, returned the application because of a conflict of interest.

The plan, Forsley said, must be one that looks ahead to a variety of federal programs that will be available in the fall.
