Bolton GOP Caucus Will Settle Contests for Seven Posts

A contest between five men seeking two Republican nominations for position on the board of education will be held in Bolton tonight at a GOP caucus. There are also contests for the posts of selector and comptroller. The remaining nominations are uncontested, and the caucus will be asked to endorse the candidates who have filed for the various posts.

The caucus, in which all registered town Republicans are eligible to vote, will be at 8 at the Community Hall. The town committee will meet at 7:30 in the fireplace room.

Democrats will caucus July 20 to endorse a slate picked by the town committee. Unlike the GOP, nominations at the Democratic caucus may be made from the floor.

John McCarrick is seeking his second term on the board of education because, he says, with his experience, he feels he has something to contribute "toward a continuity of effort."

McCarrick was chairman of the board of education during World War II and graduated from Brown University in 1945 with a BA in math. He has worked in engineering and insurance and is employed in the data processing section of Span in Hartford.

Pechman says he "feels a responsibility to do what he can for the town." He picked the board of education because "it's a hard-working board and has a major share of responsibility in a town."

Morris Silverstein, a lifelong resident, is also seeking a nomination for school board candidate. He says he would like to produce programs rather than just get out of hand. He has served on the board of education since 1952.

McCarrick grew up in Williamstown, attended St. John's Military Academy in Washington, D.C., studied engineering at the University of Wisconsin, then worked with the Merchant Marines for ten years, has run a restaurant in Ohio, has been a stock broker, and is now owner of the Hartford Trust Shopping Center in Hartford.

Allan Hoffman, one of four newcomers seeking terms on the board of education, has lived on Loomis Rd. for almost six years. His wife, a nurse, lives in a field service engineer with Pickering Nuclear.

Columbia GOP Hats Still in Ring Despite Committee Slate

The president-shattering defeat of the Republican Town Committee to recommend a slate of officers for the Bolton town election has apparently made no difference to supporters of the slate.

Robert Treat, the fifth aspirant for the school board, has lived in town most of his life. He attended Manchester High School and graduated from Phillips Andover Academy. He received a degree from Yale University in 1941 in mechanical engineering. He has worked for Travelers Insurance Co. and returned last year from United Aircraft Co. to run a tree farm on Bolton Center Rd. He was a major in the Air Force during World War II.

The slate includes two sons, one a sophomore at Yale, and one a sophomore at the University of Connecticut. Treat says he has been urged by various town residents to seek nomination on the school board. He says he would like to "contribute to steering the town toward the middle of the road financially."

Although Steward Tibbitts has been endorsed by the committee, Tibbitts has not been named as a candidate for the board of education because he has been a selector since he came back from the war in 1945. Tibbitts is a member of the board of finance, says he feels financially "at ease," and in which he can help the town, and points out that the state is "superintending the conduct of the town."

Cooper is a manufacturer's representative in the New England area and a participant in the town's educational program. He has been a member of the board of finance since 1952 and completed a course on modern technology and administration at the University of Connecticut.

Incumbent Thomas Chapman, a member of the board of finance, is being challenged by Joseph French and Albert Pello.

North End Parcels Zoned for Industry

In acting on four zone changes in the North End last night, the Town Planning Commission (TPC) further opened the area to industrial and business uses but also made some concessions to its rural and residential character.

The Rogers Corp. request to change three parcels in the Oakland Hill St. area from residential to industrial was approved, the exception being the parcel on the southeast corner of the intersection of Mill and Oakland Sts.

The TPC also would "constitute an inappropriate use of the land and an intrusion of an industrial use into a residential area."

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSES
