Tolland Caucus Will Decide Town Clerk Contest

Both Mrs. Maxine Backes and Mrs. Irene Gay are vying to win the Democratic Town Committee endorsement for town clerk according to a statement released last night by Preston Harding, Democratic caucus chairman.

Harding's statement began "In order to clear up the confusion which must be confronted by the caucus members planning to attend the caucus tomorrow evening, with respect to the endorsement of the position of town clerk, let me say that the names of Mrs. Backes and Mrs. Gay have both been made in good faith and as a result of a procedure which is not specifically covered by any rules governing the conduct of our meetings."

"At our June 26 balloting for the office of town clerk, with twenty-one members present and voting, the first ballot ended with Mrs. Backes receiving eight votes, Mrs. Gay, seven, and Mrs. Edith Knight, (also a candidate for the post) retaining five."

"There was disagreement at that point whether Mrs. Backes had received the committee endorsement. After some discussion and the completion of balloting for all offices, a second ballot for the office of town clerk was taken on July 11, Backes 8, Gay 11, and Knight 1."

"Since this ballot was obviously inconclusive, a third ballot was taken with Mrs. Backes 11, Backes 8, and Knight 1. The meeting adjourned shortly thereafter, with a summary committee members still in the hall at that time, and a third ballot was taken on July 11, Backes 11, Backes 8, and Knight 1."

"A subsequent meeting was called last Wednesday, with the purpose to see if an agreement on the endorsement of the town clerk could be reached. At that meeting, after a good deal of discussion concerning the previous balloting, and being of the opinion that the endorsement had been made, the committee voted 8 to 4 to accept that ballot as the endorsement of the town clerk position. This endorsement was made at a meeting where 21 members were present, and many votes a candidate must receive at a meeting where 21 are voting to be the candidate endorsed by the caucus."

"Mrs. Backes had obtained a majority of one vote during the first balloting, and had a majority of three and a plurality of one (one vote more than the total cast for the other two candidates) on the third."

"The caucus received 21 in the above situation, the candidate who receives eleven votes is plurality on any one ballot, of the delegation is considered the endorsed candidate of the committee, thereby, in effect, endorsing Mrs. Backes as the town clerk candidate on the June 26 meeting, and endorsing Mrs. Gay."

Harding stated, "Whether or not the subsequent vote at the July 11 meeting served to invalidate all action taken at the June 26 meeting, I am not prepared to give an opinion. However, in light of the foregoing, I think each candidate is entitled to claim the endorsement, and I leave the resolution of those claims for our caucus Saturday night, which I am sure will settle this matter in the traditions of the Democratic party. I hope this explanation will enable every Democratic voter in Tolland to understand why we have two sincere candidates each claiming the town committee endorsement."

The approved Democratic Town Committee date of candidates for presentation to the caucus tomorrow night is as follows: town clerk, Mrs. Maxine Backes; treasurer, John Burrows; secretary, William Summers; assessor, incumbent chairman William Blanchard; tax collector, Walter Blodgett; Board of Education, Edward Jandruck; incumbent, to serve out an appointment to a vacancy; and Kenneth Kayser; board of tax review, incumbent Chester Lemak; planning and zoning commission, Paul Bakke and Samuel Leone; alternate to the planning and zoning commission, Marilyn Dandurand and Michael Danopoulos.

Candidates for the zoning board of appeals, Edith Knight and Uriah Michelson; alternate to the zoning board of appeals, Ernest Jennings and Jean Aupert; library director, Robert Norman.

Constables, Larry Stronahan, Donald Crawford, Joseph Nedwell and Clarence Gault.

Incumbent selectman John Burrows thanked the Democratic Town Committee for their endorsement of him for a second term.

After his talk Thursday, Harriman said only that he had "some significant information" which he had called to President Johnson. But there were indications that disarmament also loomed large in the talk, and it could not be learned whether Harriman's significant information concerned Viet Nam or disarmament.

A Kremlin spokesman told Communist correspondents: "Harriman illustrated the points of view of his government on the international situation, and the situation of Viet Nam could not be omitted."

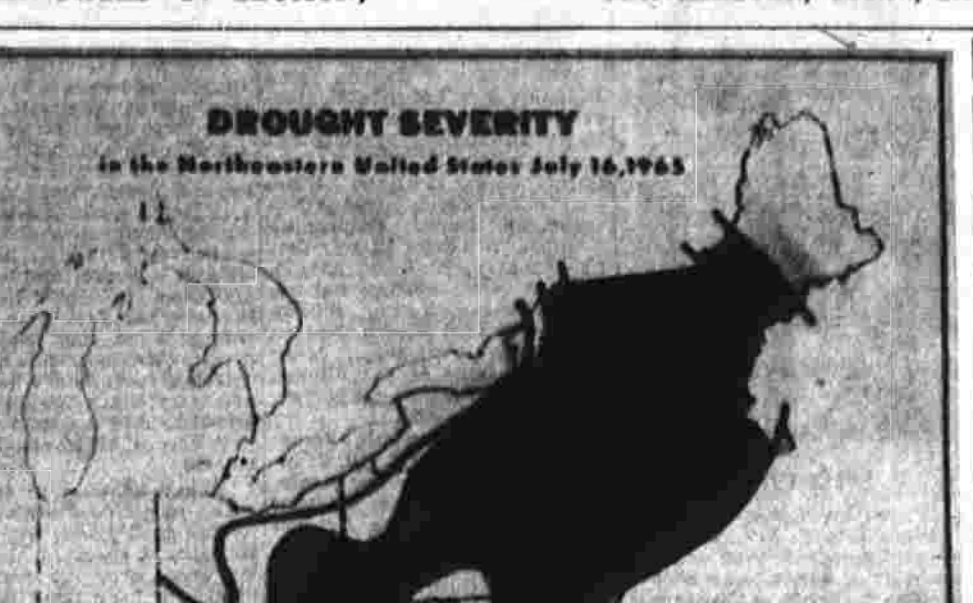
