**Merit System Board Hears First Grievance Tonight**

The newly formed town merit system board will conduct its first hearing tonight, to hear a grievance submitted by Ronald Anello, recently dismissed from the town's public works department. The board, under terms of the charter, must consider the application of employees dismissed from the town's classified service.

As a veteran town employee, Anello is considered within the classification when the new charter became effective. The immediate placement of Anello in the town's classified service is a transitional maneuver. After July 1, new hired town employees must serve an apprenticeship period before they are considered classified.

A behind-the-wheel driver education program will be instituted at Manchester High School this year as a part of the board of education. The board approved the program at its meeting last night. The program will include actual driving time on the driving program work for approximately eight hours a week with a maximum of ten hours a week, said Rogers.

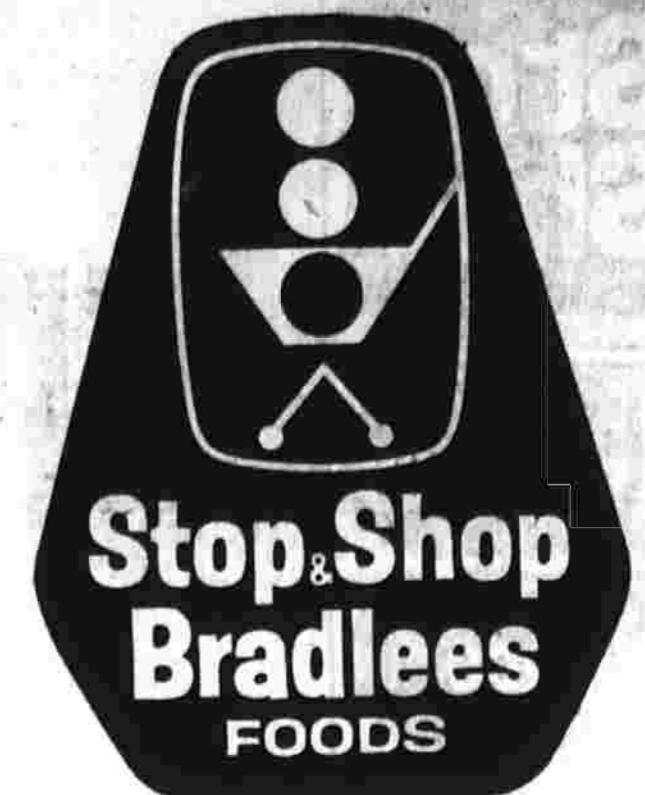
