### Corbuser's Windows

All the hymns of praise for his greatness and freedom of concept as an architect which have greeted the death of Le Corbusier raise the envy of ordinary mortals who are any way relegated to have more than a single gravestone lingering after them.

An architect has his chance to leave his mark, his individuality, by stamping his own particular genius upon his work. And if he selects the right building material in the right climate, and doesn't run into too many removal projects, his fame can be relatively secure.

About Corbuser, there is no doubt that he did have freedom of thought and concept, by his designing and in his theories, and no doubt at all that he did more to inspire contemporary architects than any other person.

It is also significantly true that, in the relatively few instances in which he himself was able to get his theories translated into buildings, the result has been beautiful.

But, if we are not mistaken, we have detected that, in some of the masterpieces of his early maturity, there is a concentration upon maximum light, which was once famous, and that, in some of the masterpieces he created when he was at the full tide of his creative powers, he is almost completely with the only windows included resembling the apertures in the walls of medieval cathedrals.

Such of these side issues provides its own special view of the architect.

SEVEN DAYS AND NIGHTS of continuous concrete pour, from Tuesday, Aug. 17 to Monday midnight, Aug. 23, built the new six-complex at the Central Connecticut Farmers Cooperative Association on Apple Place.

### Bolton Town Growth Seen Affected By Rt. 6 Relocation Project

The relocation of Rt. 6 was discussed at Monday's meeting of the board of selectmen, who explained the need for the next ten years.

Philip Liguori, superintendent of schools, wrote in a report outlining building needs that the construction of Rt. 6 from East Hartford to Bolton North will be of "tremendous significance to the town's future growth."

With the metropolitan area of Hartford less than 15 minutes away, the town should anticipate a rapid population increase between now and 1975, with the full impact being realized during the 1968-69 school year," the report says.

"This is the year when the report predicts, the junior-senior high school will have reached capacity, operating at 80 per cent efficiency scheduling. The enrollment figures are projected on the basis of present population, and do not include any allowance for population growth in the town."

The figures used in the report are based on a present population of 3,500. This, Liguori said, is based on last year's telephone company estimate of 3,385. When the town census, taken this summer by Stanley Liguori and Nalpers, is complete, the population figures will be adjusted, he said.

For the time being, there can be only speculation as to what Rt. 6 will do to the school growth figures.

Guidance counselor Suzel reported at Monday's meeting that he had talked with state highway officials, who explained that the relocated Rt. 6 will probably cut through Camp Meeting Rd. and West St., on its way from Manchester to Willimantic, connecting road between Rt. 44A and the new Rt. 6 is proposed somewhere near "Punch Trail" in Assisid Acres, Suzel said.

Present highway department plans are for the construction of Rt. 6 from Manchester via the connector to Rt. 44A at its junction in the North first, with the cut-off down West St. toward Willimantic planned sometime in the future.

Suzel said that Rt. 6 will "radically open up Bolton and Coventry." He said also that last year, when he was looking for a home to buy, he realized that towns like Vernon would eventually reach a saturation point in development, and that the overflow would start coming in to neighboring towns.

In his report, Liguori predicts that Vernon will reach a saturation point, unless there are zoning changes, in 1968-69—the same year he predicts the impact of Rt. 6.

Liguori also pointed Monday to the eventual straightening of Cider Mill Rd. as another opening-up of the town.

### Hop Brook to Split Lanes Of Relocated Rt. 6 Traffic

Motorists four or five years from today leaving along Hop Brook, contained in an 18-foot wide median between three lanes of traffic in each direction.
