Clough Blamed In Road Death

The coroner for Hartford County today blamed George A. Clough of 245 Wetherell St. in the death of a companion August 15. The coroner said the death of Maurice Clancy of 187 Highland St. in an auto accident was caused by the "criminal negligence" of Clough.

In a report, Coroner Louis W. Belcher said, "High speed, alcohol, and lack of control on the part of Clough caused this wholly unnecessary death."

Clough, 25, is being charged with willful misconduct in a motor vehicle. The case is in the hands of the Hartford County Superior Court, Clancy, 25, was killed when he was thrown from the car after it struck a utility pole on Charter Oak St.

Belcher said both men "had consumed large quantities of beer." He said witnesses "observed the Clough car zig-zagging and traveling an erratic course at excessive speed."

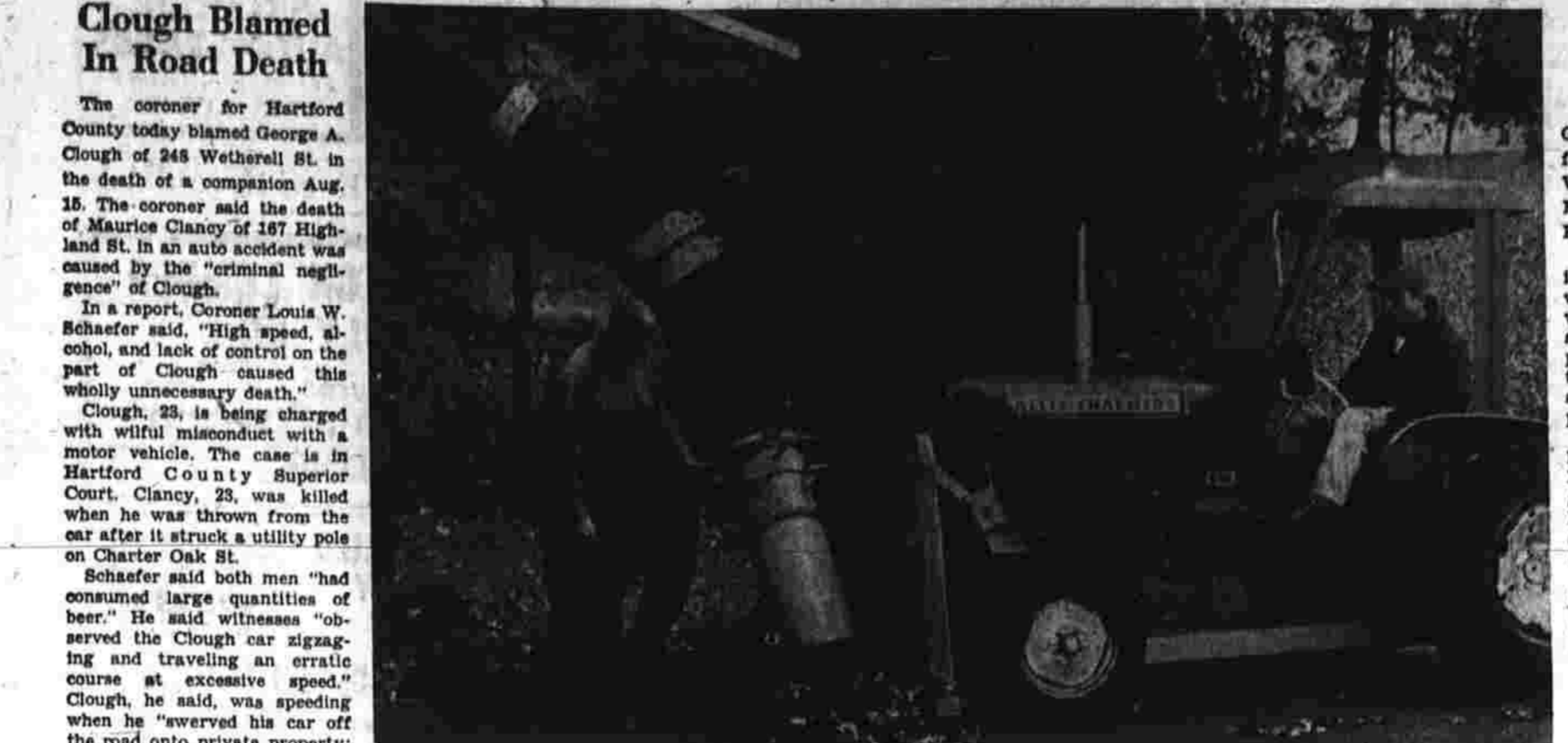

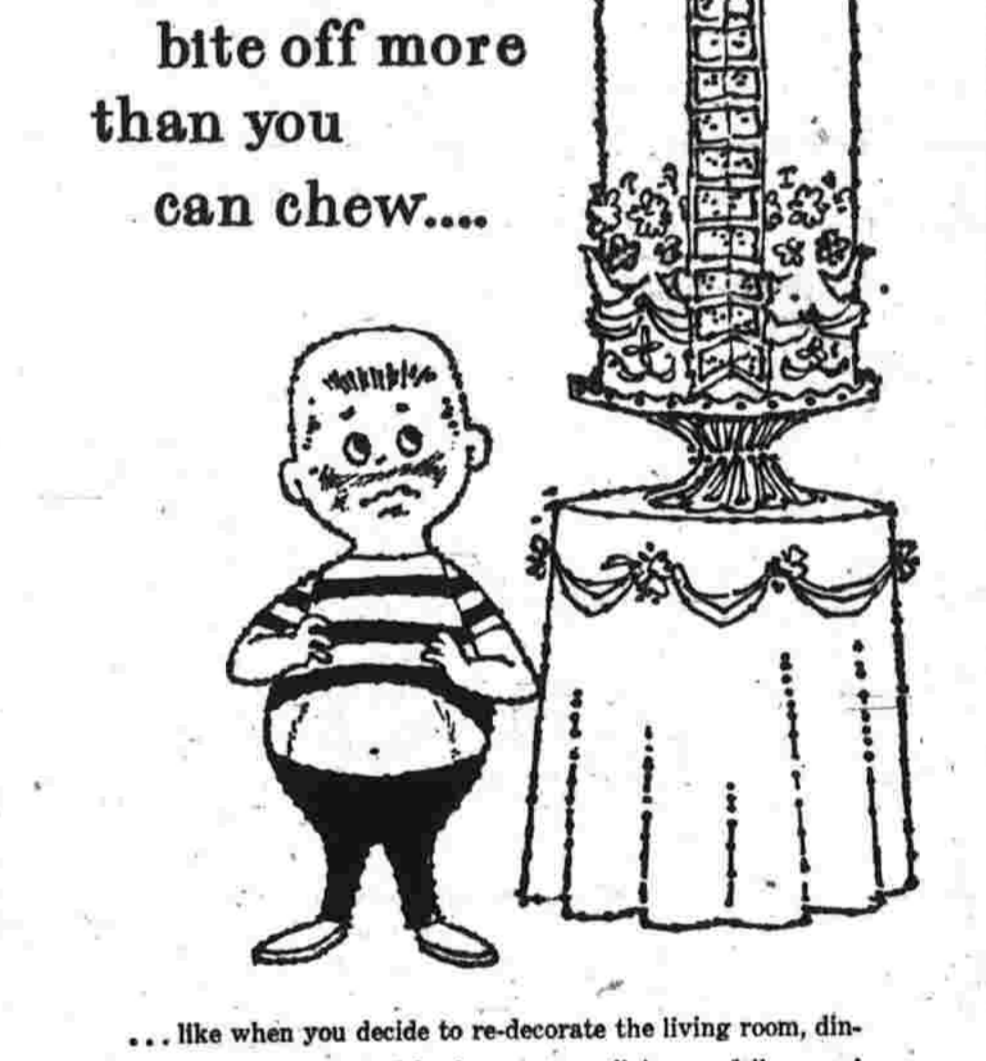

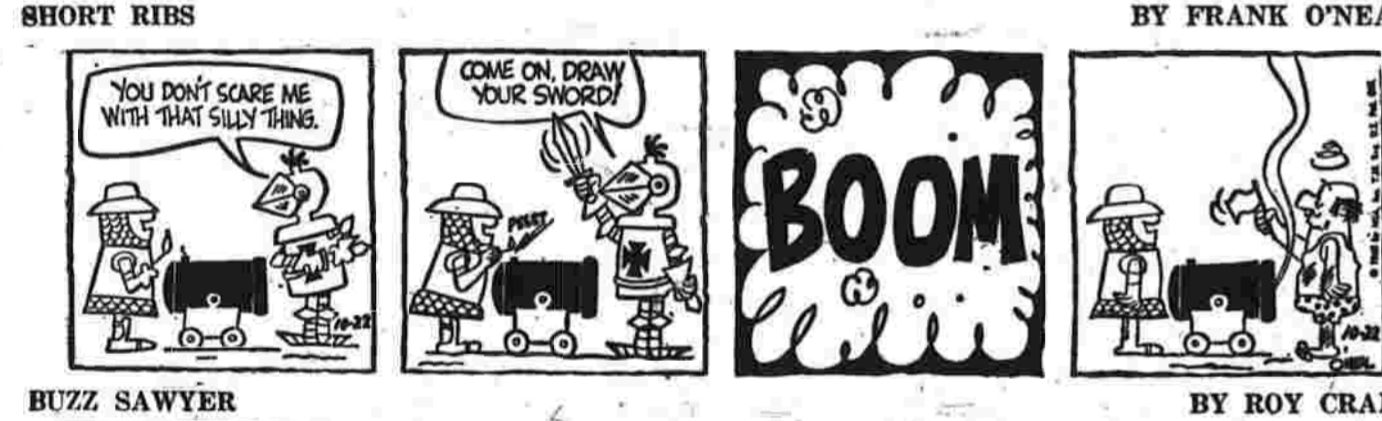

89th Congress Is Ended; LBJ Calls It 'Fabulous'

WASHINGTON (AP)—The "fabulous 89th Congress," as President Johnson described it, has written an historic record in its first session.

With top-heavy Democratic majorities rolled out a tide of major legislation that often drew comparisons with the New Deal days of the 1930s.

It set up a permanent health care program for the elderly, made it easier for Negroes in the South to register to vote, wiped out taxes on dozens of items sought by nearly all Americans, provided more than \$1 billion to improve education for disadvantaged children.

It broke down bars to immigration, set up regional centers to bring to all parts of the country the newest techniques for fighting major diseases and provided federal grants for writers, painters, composers and other artists.

The 9½-month session came to a dramatic and abrupt end at 1 a.m. when the Senate, its ranks thinned by early departures, passed the final bill.

The House had passed the bill 374 to 88, and was waiting on the Senate to pass the bill.

Congress returns Jan. 10. It is the 44th session of the 89th Congress, which began on July 2, 1965.
