Enrichment Class Results Lauded by School Officials

A pilot program designed to improve the lives of some of the poorest children in the Vernon school system was lauded last night by school officials.

Some of the children are non-verbalizers, he said, meaning that they cannot talk to anyone.

Some of the students participating in the work-study program are being trained to work in the school.

William West, coordinator of the enrichment center, said that the program is being expanded to include other schools.

Other participants in the program explained their functions. Mrs. Dorothy Johnson, a psychology teacher, explained that she had been studying in order to reach the maximum enrollment of 16 for the program.

Mrs. Helen Abusz, a part-time social worker for the school and a former elementary school teacher here, explained that 72 children were studied in order to reach the maximum enrollment of 16 for the program.

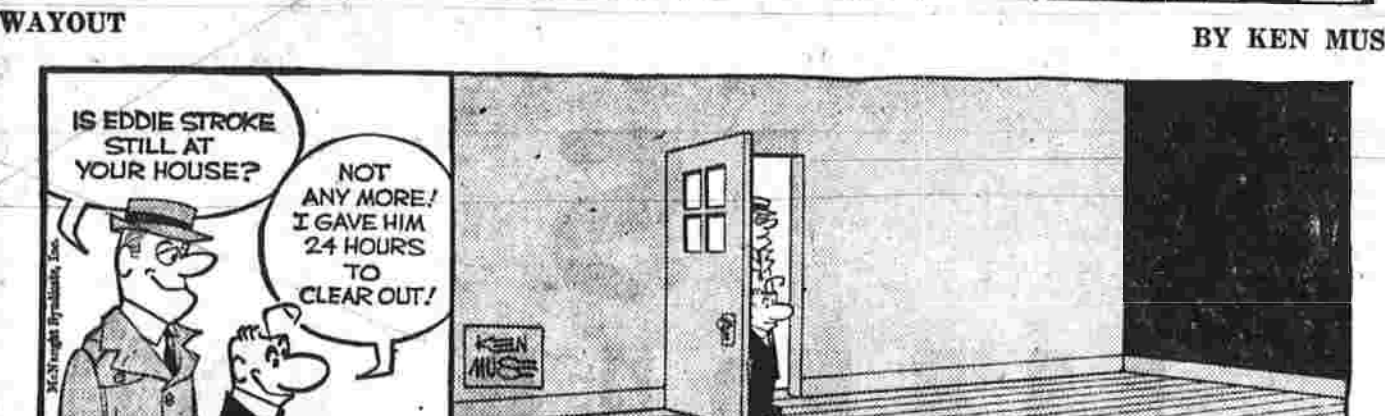

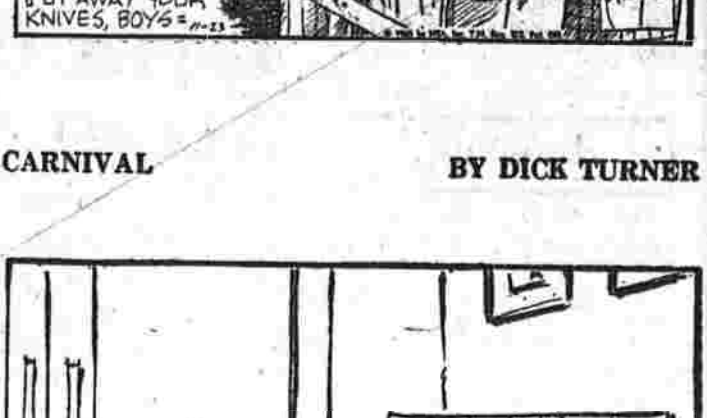

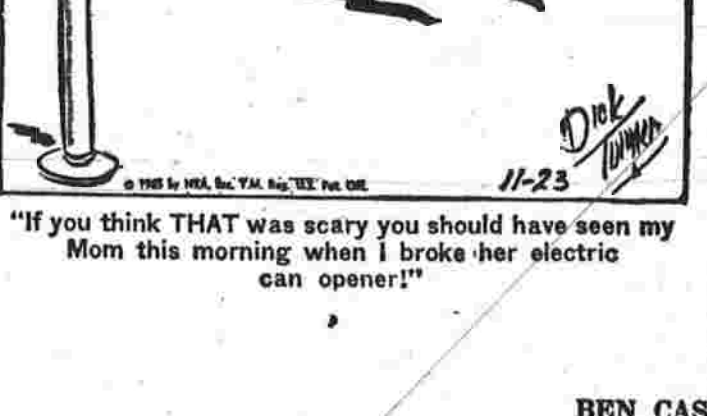
