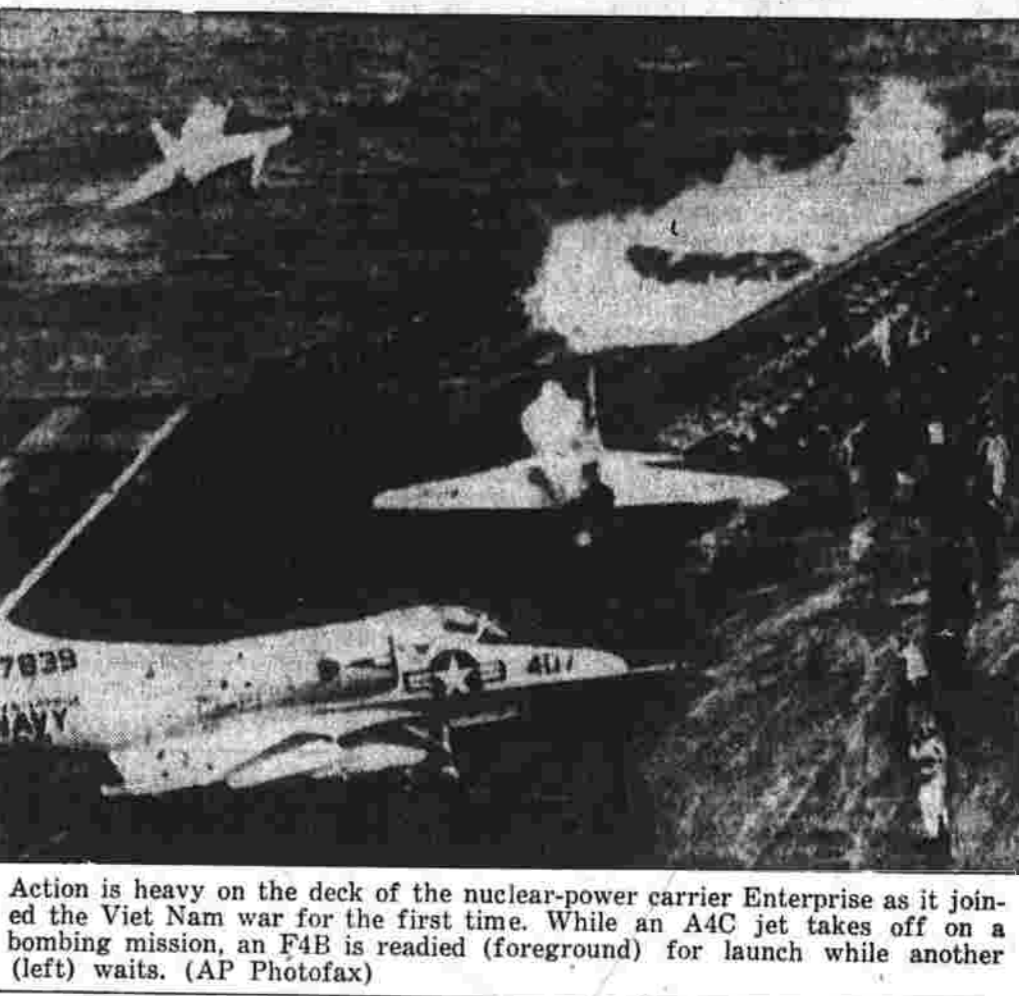

# South Windsor \$15,000 Voted for Air Map, Auditor and Plan Debated

The town council voted last night to appropriate \$15,000 from the town's contingency fund for the first of a series of aerial survey maps which will eventually cover the entire town.

The council also heard a number of reports and made some appointments. It took no action on three pending matters: appointment of a town auditor, appropriation of \$10,000 for a comprehensive plan, and approval of specifications for new sidewalks.

Although none of the three pending items was brought to a vote, much of the meeting was turned over to discussion of them.

The aerial survey maps were requested by Town Engineer William O'Neill in a report submitted to a previous council meeting. The \$15,000 will pay for most of the cost of a series of six maps that will cover the total potential industrial land along Rt. 5.

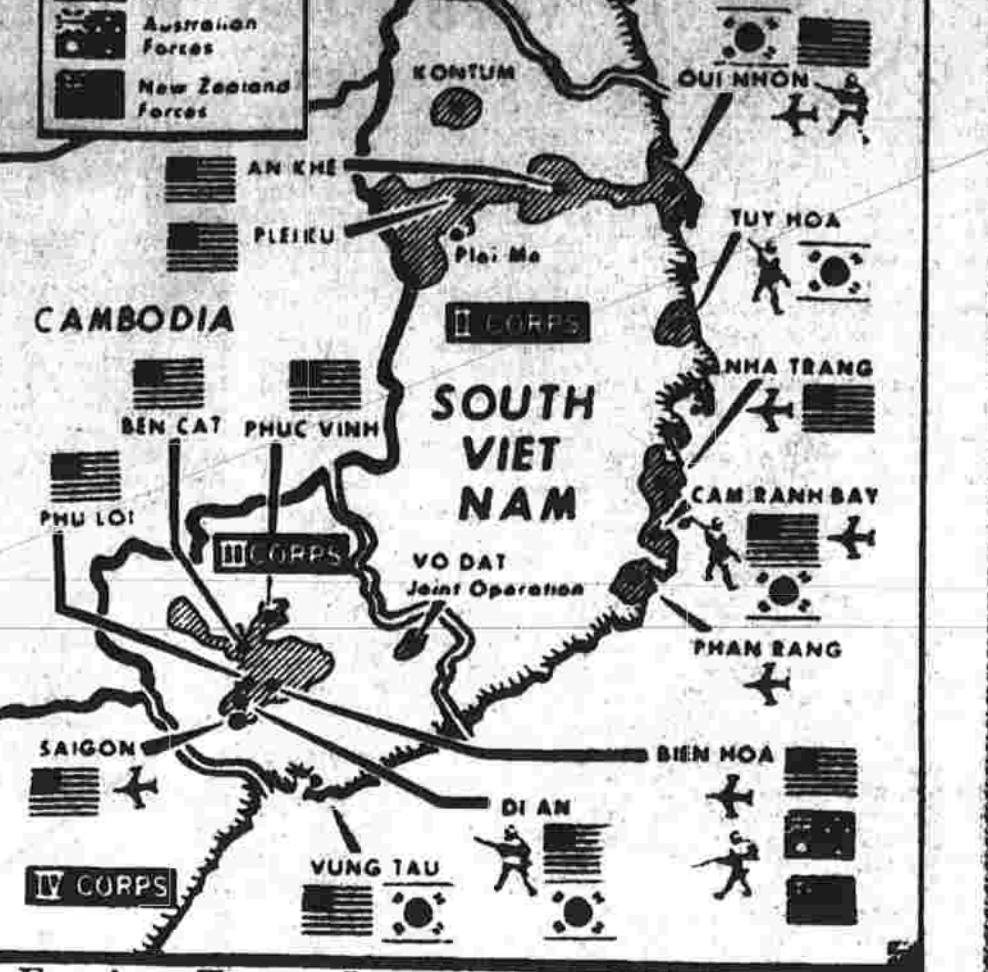
