### Columbia New Porter School Kitchen To Be Ready in Few Weeks

There's good news for mothers tired of packing lunches and children tired of eating them. Principal George Patros has said the school board expects the cafeteria and kitchen being remodeled at Porter School to be ready in two or three weeks. The board authorized Patros to recall Mrs. Stanley Field, who manages the hot lunch program. He added that she will need the time to re-organize the program and order supplies.

The board appointed Miss Ruth Haver and Guy Beck to represent Columbia on the consulting committee of the Lebanon Regional Voc-Ag Center. They replace Donald Tuttle and Leonard Robinson, the latter a non-board member. Further action on the nursing service program in town was tabled until the next meeting in order to give more time to study the problem. Superintendent Myron Collette told the board that several local physically-handicapped students who were enrolled in the Service Training

Program for Special Education at Mansfield are now working in occupational programs and being paid for their efforts. He added that the Auxiliary Service grant has not yet been received but is expected momentarily. ### California Hit By New Storms

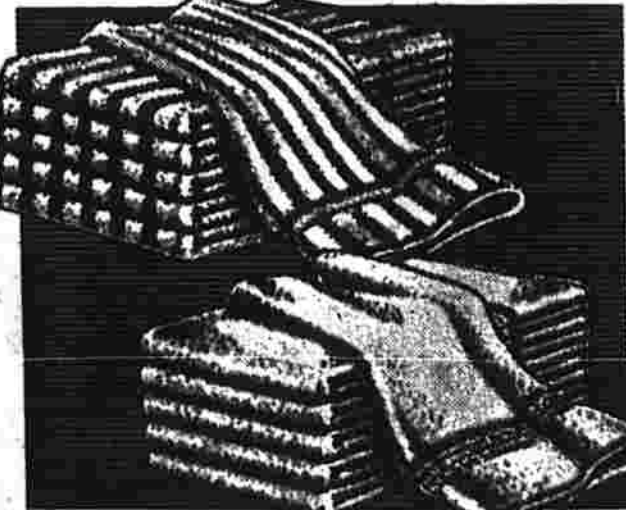

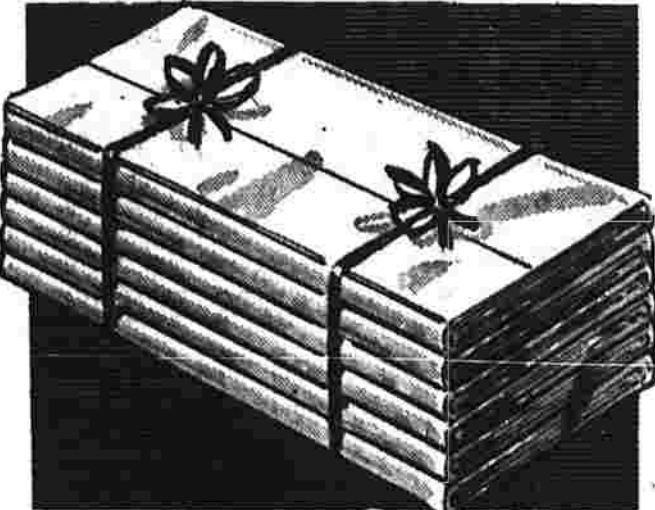

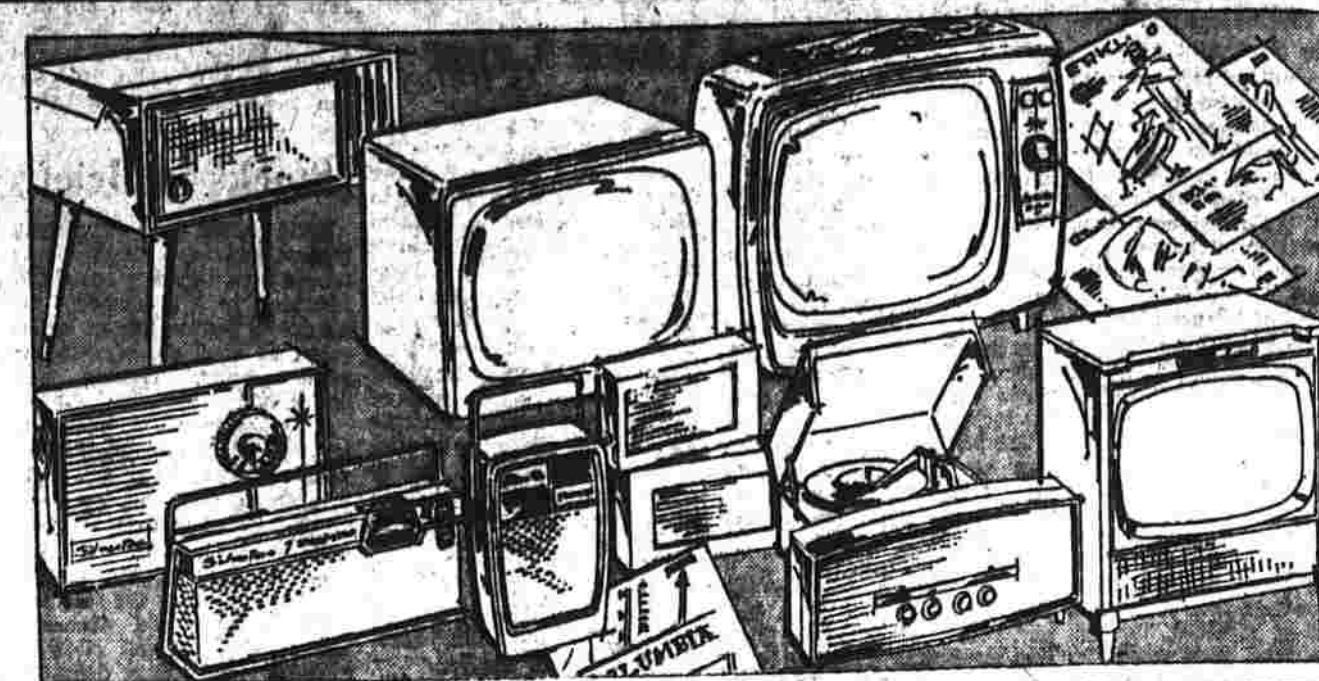

**Kaldemar**  
(Swedish Cabbage Rolls)  
2 1/2 pounds ground beef  
1 cup cooked rice  
1/2 cup cold water  
1 egg  
1 medium onion, grated  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/2 teaspoon pepper  
Head of cabbage

Parboil cabbage in salted water about five minutes. Remove from water and drain. Separate leaves carefully. Place other ingredients thoroughly. Place heaping tablespoon of meat mixture in each cabbage leaf. Roll and fasten with a toothpick or string. Brown on all sides in butter or drippings in fry pan. Place in casserole and pour a little of the water in which the cabbage was boiled over the rolls. Bake in 350-degree oven 1 1/2 hours.

**Rice Pudding**  
3 eggs  
3 cups milk  
1/2 cup cooked rice  
1/2 cup sugar  
1/8 teaspoon salt  
1/2 cup raisins (optional)  
1/4 cup margarine

Beat eggs and mix with other ingredients. Pour into buttered baking dish. Place dish in pan of water and bake in 300-degree oven for about 1 1/2 hours or until thick.

For years, Sandburg has presided over a newspaper, which is now owned by his son, Carl Sandburg III. He is 57 years old and lives in Flat Rock, N.C.

His father was a poet and a Lincoln biographer. He was born in Flat Rock, N.C., in 1878. He died in 1967.

# New England Ski Resorts Booming

## Early Snow Has Smiles From Owners

BOSTON (AP)—Almost twice as many skiers scudded New England slopes during the recent holiday period than there were fans in Fenway Park during the whole six months baseball season.

Upwards of a million "mounds" of sking are registered on hills and mountains covered with everything from perfect powder to perfect slush.

"The greatest holiday season we ever had," says Commissioner Albert Moulton of Vermont's Development Department.

Moulton estimates that 600,000 skitickets were sold in Vermont in the last 10 days of the year.

"That early snowstorm was worth at least 10 million," says Moulton.

About 80 per cent of Green Mountain skiers come from out of state. Among other statistics, the city skickers have already pushed Vermont's state liquor sales 20 percent over last year.

Champion Mountain in New Hampshire's Franconia Notch, operated by the state and virtually on a hand-to-mouth financial basis before the holiday bonanza, sold \$56,196 in tickets in a week.

# Dallas Punt Defense Ready for Baltimore

MIAMI, Fla. (AP)—"Blow that kick!" is more than a corny yell to the Dallas Cowboys, who meet the Baltimore Colts here Sunday in the National Football League's Playoff Bowl.

It's an exhortation that the Cowboys take seriously. As a result, they are the kick-blocker team in professional football.

"It's not the result of any special preparation or plan," says Tom Landry, the Dallas coach. "We just had some success early in the year and it became a game—a sort of challenge—to the boys."

"They like to see how many they can block," he says. "That's almost a third of the total blocked by all the teams of the NFL—29—and three times as many as any other team."

Blocked field goals set up Dallas scores in four games and resulted directly in victory in three—the 30-31 win over San Francisco at Dallas, the 21-13 win over the Eagles at Philadelphia and the 18-20 final game decision over the New York Giants that sent the Cowboys into the Playoff Bowl.

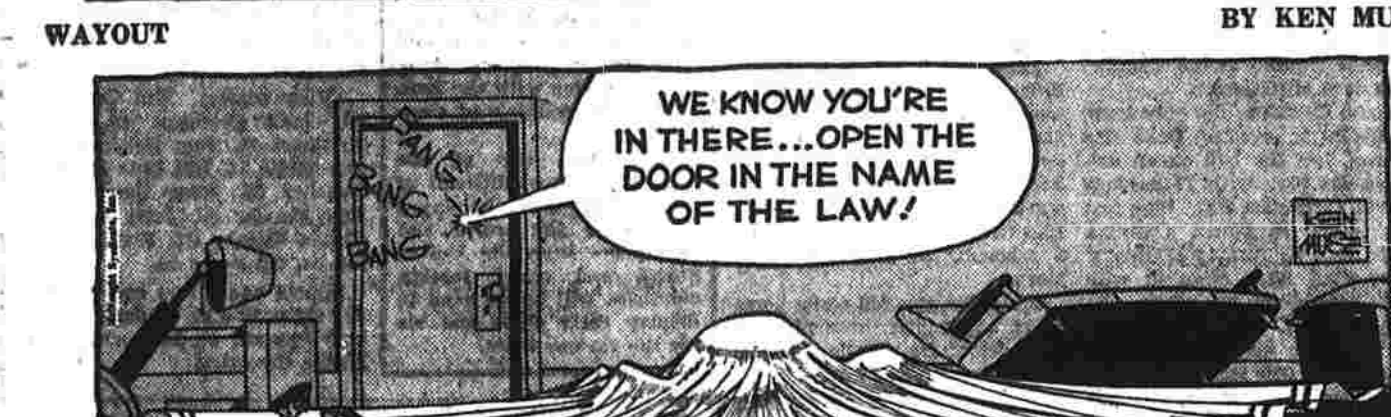

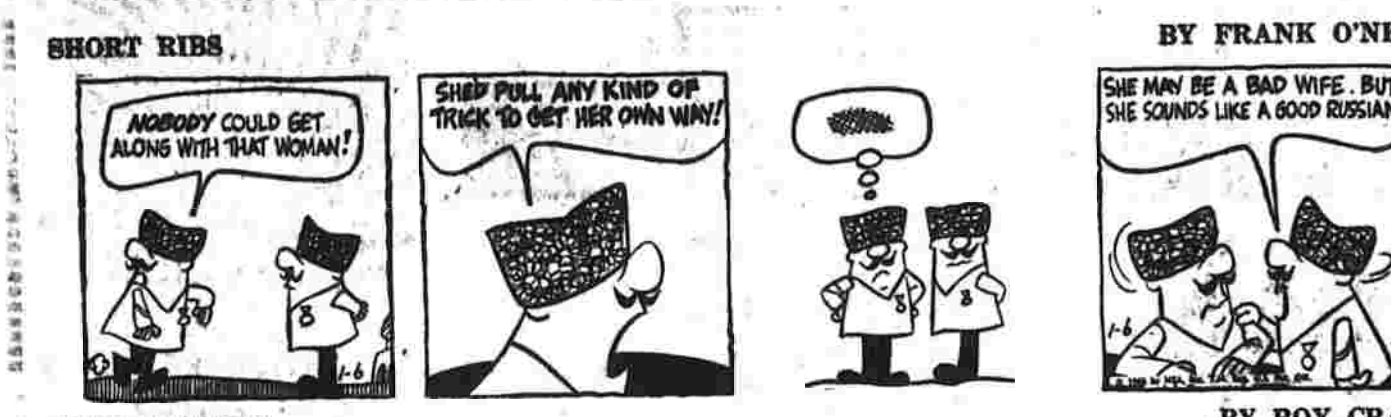

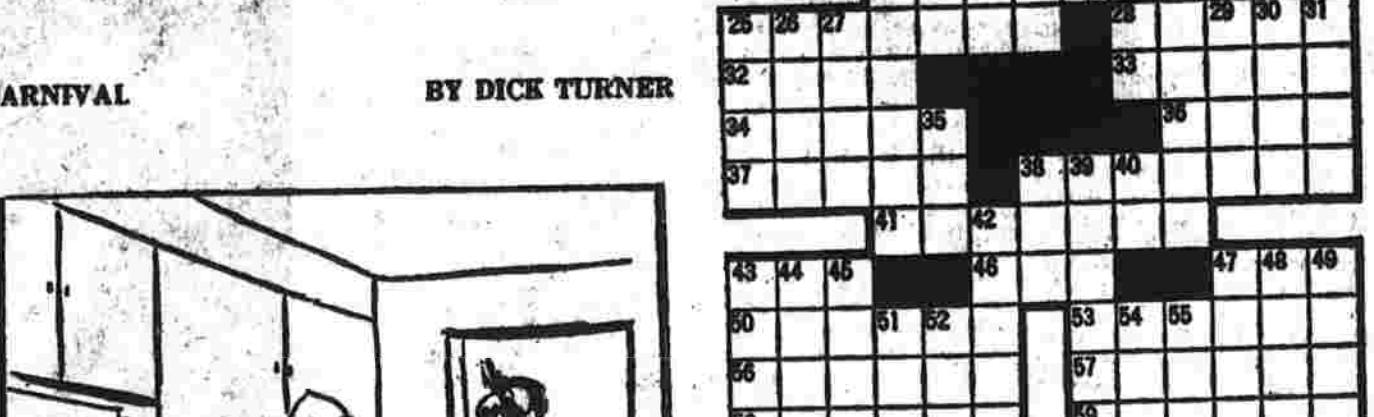
