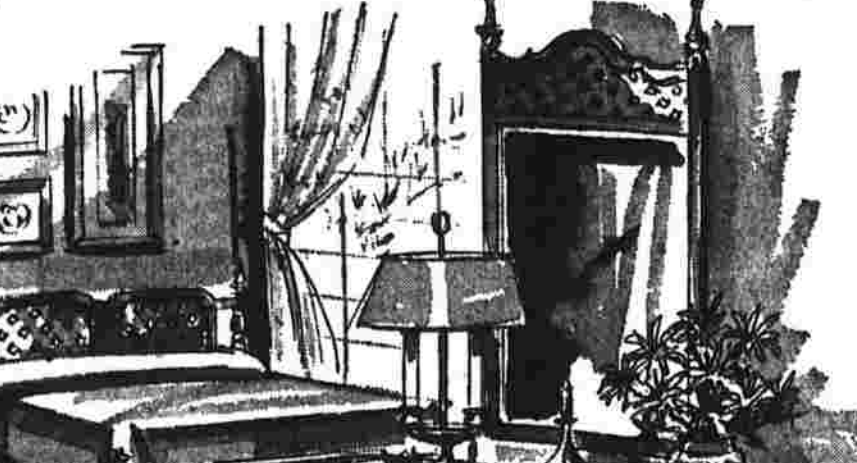

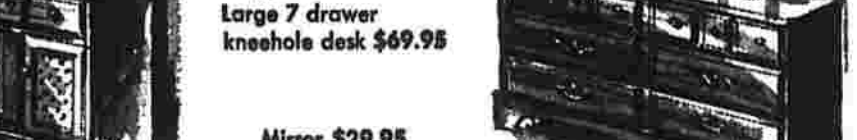

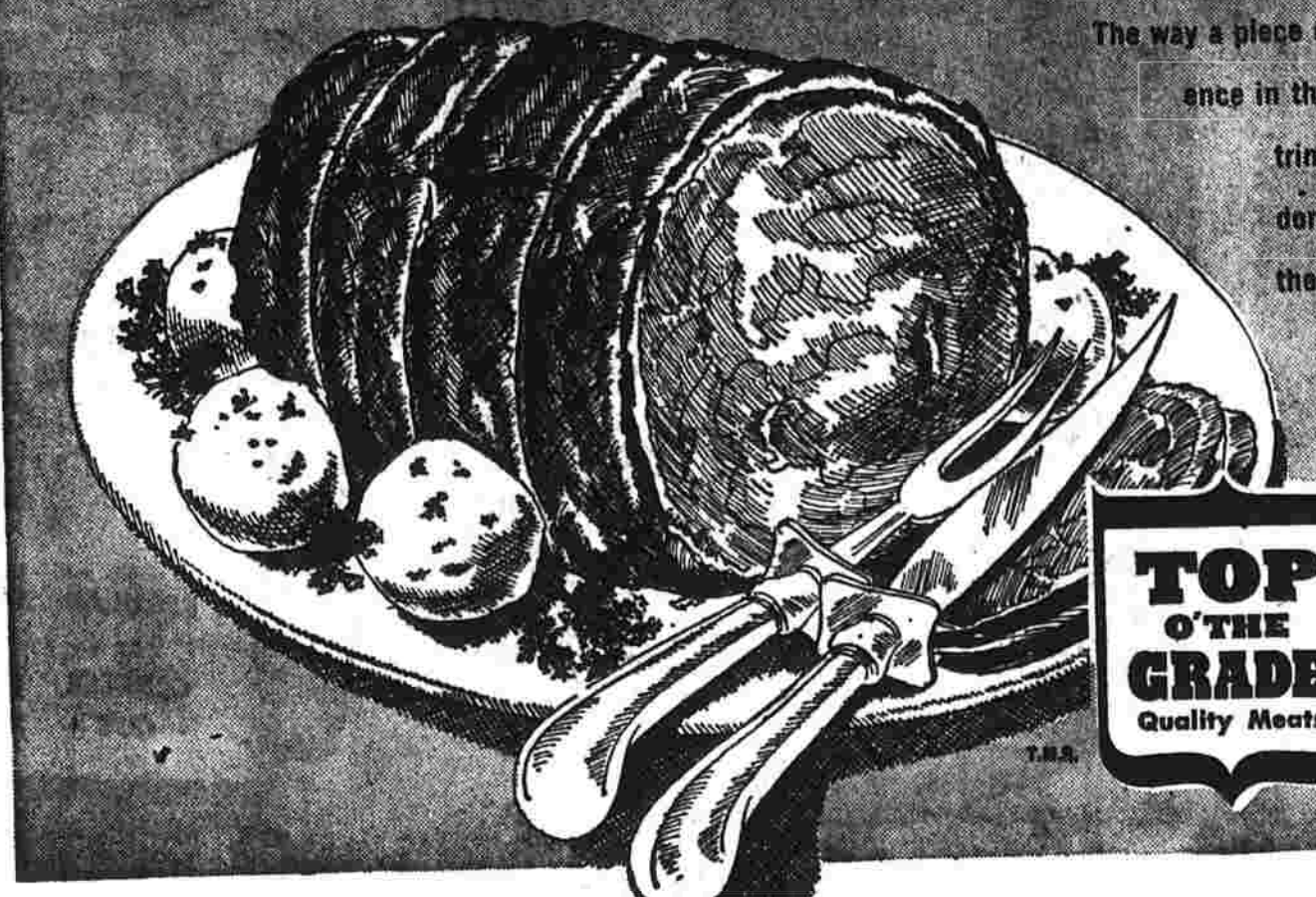

## Puzzling Conference Over But Deep Mystery Remains

WASHINGTON (AP) — President Johnson's meeting in Hanoi with leaders of South Vietnam was one of the more puzzling international conferences of recent years.

Despite a torrent of public and private pronouncements by its participants, the whole meeting retained an element of mystery.

The mid-Pacific party was born in secret, under puzzling circumstances. Johnson announced plans for it last Friday and left for Hawaii Saturday. All evidence at the conference was the earnestness of heavy preparation, at least so far as physical arrangements were concerned.

Then, only hours before the President's arrival, word was torn open in the "Washington Post" that no air conditioning could be installed.

Johnson flew to Hawaii as the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, dominated by critics of his Southeast Asia policy, was holding nationally televised hearings on the Viet Nam situation.

Some of the possible witnesses on the administration side went with him.

Close contacts there was no connection between the conference and the hearings. Before leaving Washington, Johnson said the focus of the conference would be on the planned efforts of the Saigon government to provide economic and political reforms with American aid. All top American officials at the meeting said this was the focal point.

Yet the conference ended with public attention focused on other matters: possible intensification of the war and potential roadblocks to any moves toward a peaceful settlement.

In this particular, Johnson's plans may have gone awry.

When the Saigon officials arrived in Hawaii Sunday, the President welcomed them with remarks aimed at home front critics. He said Americans must stand and fight in South Viet Nam or face inevitable bloodshed elsewhere at unknown cost.

South Viet Nam's chief of state, Nguyen Van Thieu, learned of Johnson's plans in Honolulu. He scribbled his own remarks and prepared an open speech in which he

- Has started a mail order firm to market a cosmetic skin product for men called "Polly Bergen's Whipped Pink Oil of the Turtle."

"The first thing, of course," said Polly gravely, "is to catch the turtle. The whole business depends on him."

What makes Polly run so hard? Perhaps because she was constantly on the move as a child—always starting over in a new place. As the daughter of a construction engineer, she lived in 27 states and attended 46 grammar and high schools.

"At the age of 3 and 4 I was always a dead-on-the-spot prize winner in amateur contests," she said. "But at 8, I had become a has-been."

Then at 14, I got my own radio show at 44 a week. I got \$15 for my first television appearance—and a case of tomato soup.

"I also worked for \$15 a week as a department clerk, \$20 a week as a carhop, \$22 a week as a short order cook. I used to spend hours arguing with me out of ordering pancakes. I could not turn them."

Polly held other jobs briefly as a cocktail waitress, a fur coat model, an usher, and a door-to-door valve peddler.

"I sold three cases of the valve to my father," she said. "We had that valve for years in the basement."

"I did all this while going to school. I was very independent. I really enjoyed it."

Polly still became a band singer, quickly rose to stardom on the supper club circuit—Las Vegas was glad to pay her \$1,000 a week—and in films, the theater, television and the recording field.

"Once when I had two televisions shows going, I had already earned between \$500,000 and a million dollars a year," she remarked thoughtfully.

What kind of a girl is Miss Bergen? She says: "I like chili. My children, when they first wake up in the morning. My husband, except when he's handling the pile. Playing cards either for a lot of money or no money at all. Snow and very cold weather. Taking my shoes off."
