U.S. Warplanes Elude Red Missile Barrage
(Continued from Page One)
In the only major ground action reported, a government regiment of about 3,000 men clashed four times with Communist forces in a 42-mile-square area of Saigon Tuesday. A spokesman said the Vietnamese troops killed 81 Viet Cong and captured a 57mm recoilless rifle, four machine guns and 27 other weapons. He said 10 Communist casualties were light. But American pilots flew the unusually high number of 445 sorties in South Viet Nam Tuesday, claiming damage or destruction of about 80 Viet Cong huts and fortifications and causing 50 secondary explosions. They also reportedly destroyed 28 Viet Cong. South Vietnamese air force pilots flew 26 sorties. U.S. B-52 bombers hammered two targets today: a Viet Cong base camp and training center near Cambodia, 60 miles northwest of Saigon and a Viet Cong troop concentration 38 miles southwest of Hue, on the central coast. A U.S. spokesman announced the loss of three small two-seat observation planes in South Viet Nam today. One was shot down 25 miles southwest of Quang Ngai and another was shot down 20 miles southwest of DaNang but the cause was not known. The two fighters in each of the three planes were rescued by helicopters. On the political front, Premier Nguyen Cao Ky set up a special disciplinary committee of 20 generals with concurrent powers to judge five other generals involved in the recent Buddhist-inspired revolt in the northern provinces. The latter included Lt. Gen. Nguyen Chan Th. Ky's rival, created as commander of the army's northernmost 1st Corps area last March, precipitated the unrest, and Gen. Tho

LBJ Seeks Support In Viet Policy

WASHINGTON (AP) — Four days after he became president, Lyndon B. Johnson declared: "I cannot bear this burden alone. I need the help of all Americans, and all America."

And now, in mounting an offensive for the Viet Nam policy, Johnson is using his patented personal technique once more — in speeches.

"There is no human being in all this world who wishes in peace to come to the world more than your president of the United States," he said last week in Omaha.

And if you are too busy or not inclined to help, please count 10 before you hurt," he told a crowd assembled on the banks of the Missouri River.

At his news conference Tuesday at Johnson City, Johnson vowed high praise for the U.S. forces in Viet Nam and added this patriotic note:

"I am fearful that sometimes we do not give enough thought to those men we are at here in the luxury of our front porch and lawn, that we don't recognize the men that are dying for us out in the paddies."

In part, what Johnson is doing is seeking to square the nation from the step in the war's tempo by wrapping his policy in patriotism.

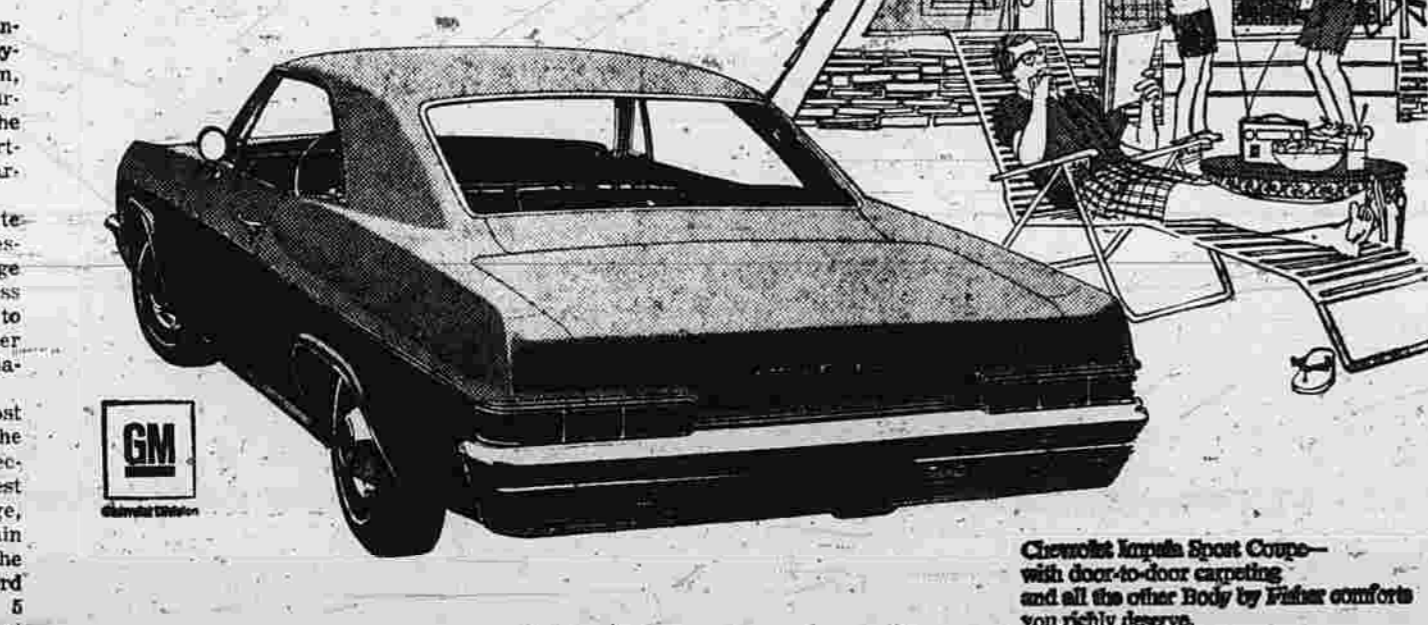

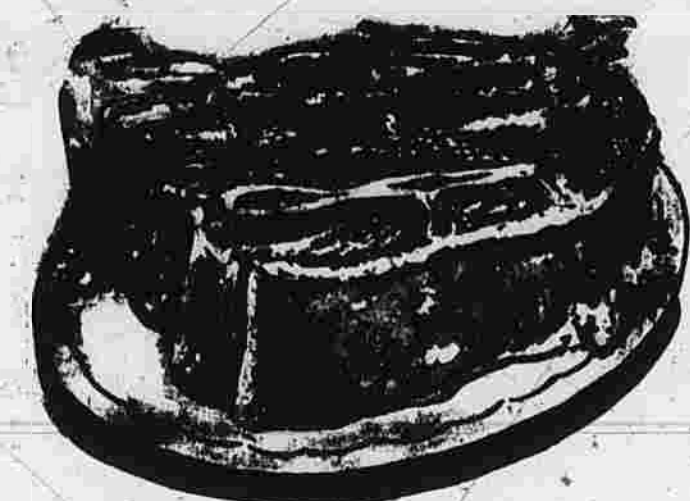

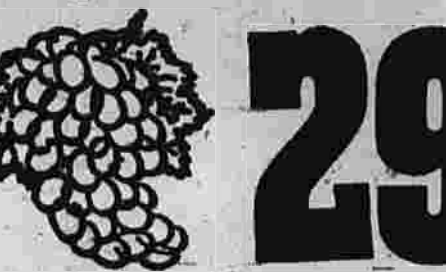

Library of Congress

Help Is on the Way For Overstuffed Hall

WASHINGTON (AP)—The original building, special library of Congress, growing at the knowledge explosion...

At the end of a tour, a staffer looked out over the cluttered great hall. "I don't think there will ever be room for the staff Christmas tree this year," she said sadly.

At least two years have been lost, protesters Rep. Tom Street, D-Ohio, a library buff who is chairman of the appropriations subcommittee...

"A lot of people had to be satisfied," Gray said. "Some of the people making up the commissions involved are such as the speaker and some of the most senior members on both sides Democratic and Republican."

The result was legislation that gives some role in the planning and construction of the building to the House Building Committee, the Capitol Building Commission, the James Madison Memorial Commission, the architect of the capitol, who is not a professional architect but an executive officer for the commissions, and a special committee of the American Institute of Architects.

Under Rayburn's leadership, Congress acquired a square of land near the original library and cleared it, raising a small business section and some lovely restored old, Capitol Hill houses.

The square has stood vacant ever since, a prize sought by three groups. One wants it for the library, another for an office building, and the third wants to build a memorial to James Madison, sometimes called the founding father most neglected by posterity.

When the redoubtable Rep. Howard W. Smith of Virginia, chairman of the Rules Committee and head of the Madison forces, agreed the fight was over. Only five votes were cast against the bill. Of course, the Madison Commission got on the control group.

More people are needed to operate the legislative reference service, the copyright office, the cataloging section, that produces most of the cards used by the libraries of the United States, the program for the blind and a dozen teaching laboratory activities, to say nothing of the shelving books and of the scholarly assistance given 85,000 individuals in 1965.

Girl Lifeguards Prove Ability to 'Skeptical Male'

BLURNEMOUTH, England (AP)—Girls as lifeguards? "No," said ex-wrestler Hank Coombes, 48. "It won't work. Frolicsome bathing beauties don't have the strength to do the job."

Coombes reacted with a letter of protest to his local newspaper after six girl lifeguards had been assigned for the summer at this resort city.

But the girls made him regret his words. They challenged him to let them prove they are good lifeguards. Coombes accepted the challenge.

He agreed to swim out in the English Channel and pretend he was drowning. Janet Trump, 18, and Susanna Barrow, 17, went out to subdue and rescue him.

As agreed upon, Coombes, who weighs 160 pounds, struggled against the girls' efforts to rescue him.

After two minutes and 20 seconds, Coombes was subdued, and puffing, panting and coughing up salt water, was hoisted in like a hooked fish and beached.

"I was wrong," he admitted. "They did the right thing at the right time. What shook me was their sheer brute strength. I would recommend them as lifeguards anywhere."

Coventry School Board Must Decide How to Handle Evaluation

Primary discussions of the Coventry High School evaluation report ended last night with the school board looking ahead to implementing the report's recommendations.

Summing up the five public meetings on the contents of the report, Board of Education Chairman Donald Young said, "The job of the board of education regarding this evaluation is just beginning. Now we must decide what recommendations are realistic, or practical, and which are financially feasible."

The evaluating committee visited the high school last November. Its report is available through the superintendent's office. The 44-page document includes commendations and recommendations in all curriculum areas, in guidance, in health and library services, and in the school plant itself.

The completed report was turned over to the board of education, which began its investigations with its five public hearings. All interested citizens were invited to the hearings to air their views.

In December, the New England Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools recommended that Coventry High School be accredited for a ten-year period. The administration of the high school must report to the association in December of 1967, and again in December 1970, what action has been taken on the report.

At the end of the 10-year accreditation period, the committee will again visit the school. The evaluation committee based its study on state standards about the school plant itself.

Wilton Tully, superintendent of schools, has stressed that "in some cases, state standards are 'loose' which are not necessarily valid for our situation, as a discussion of the report will continue at regular board of education meetings, which are open to the public."
