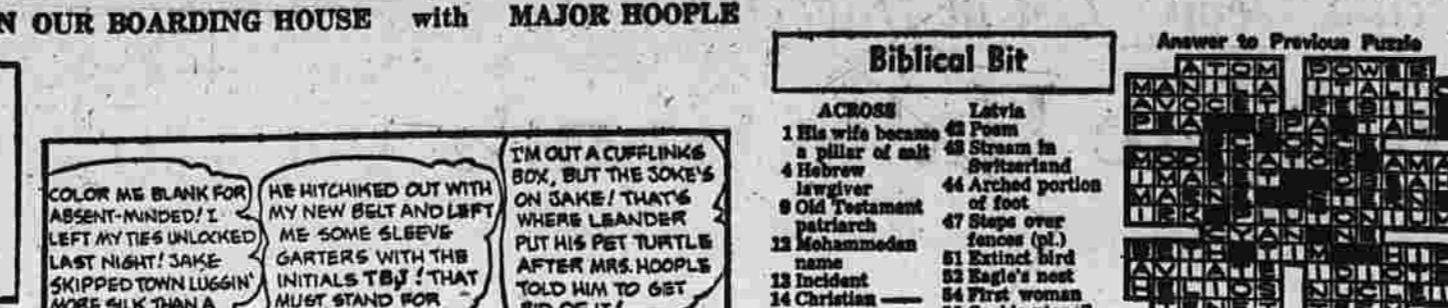

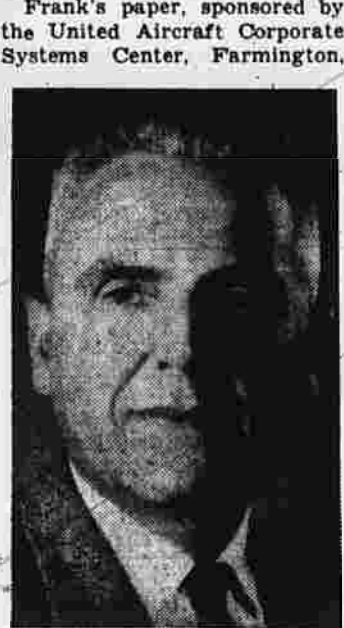

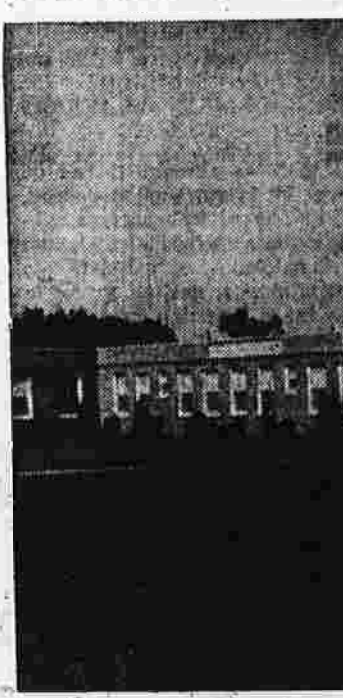

Tradition Is Upset As Season Starts

NEW YORK (AP) — In the old TV tradition, the audience was permitted a long farewell to summer; to take a look at the new Miss America, always picked on the weekend after Labor Day. Then the new season was launched.

But this season, ABC jumped the starting gun by almost a week and NBC slipped a few new shows into the channels Thursday night. Even so, there will be such a wealth of premieres, specials and important movie reruns during the next seven days of network broadcasting that no one can possibly catch all the action.

Taking the goings-on in chronological order, the next few days shape up like this:

"Shane," an adaptation of the 1953 Western movie, will hit the ABC channels on Saturday evening, 7:30-8:30. NBC will present a special variety hour aimed at high school and college students called "class of '57" (9-10) after which the network will devote the usual two hours (10-midnight) to the "Miss America" drama.

Imogene Coca and Joe E. Ross will star in a Stone Age comedy series, "It's About Time," which will have its CBS premiere Sunday night (7:30-8). NBC's "Hey, Landlord," a comedy about two young bachelors in New York (8:30-9) will be followed by the new CBS variety hour, "The Garry Moore Show" (9-10).

ABC's "Iron Horse," an hour Western, and NBC's "The Monkees," a half-hour comedy about a rock 'n' roll quartet, will compete for attention in the 7:30 spot on the Monday night

schedules. "Run, Buddy, Run," a CBS comedy, will have its first outing (8-8:30), followed by NBC's "Roger Miller Show" (8:30-9), a variety program. "The Road West," another Western, arrives on NBC (9-10), while CBS' "Family Affair" starts at its half-way mark (9:30-10). CBS' "Jean Arthur Show," with the film star playing a lady lawyer, winds up the evening's premieres (10-10:30).

Tuesday is almost as busy. There is NBC's "The Girl from U.N.C.L.E." (7:30-8:30), followed by "Occasional Wife," a situation comedy, which will conflict with the start of ABC's "Rat Patrol" (8:30-9) about adventures of allied soldiers against Rommel's Africa Corps. "Felony Squad," a police story, will have its ABC premiere (9-9:30). There will also be a CBS news special, "Young Mr. Eisenhower," a documentary of the former president's early years (10-11).

"The Love Song of Barney Kempinski," first of ABC's "Stage 67" series of weekly specials, arrives on Wednesday (10-11).

"Jericho," a secret agent series, has its CBS premiere on Thursday (7:30-8:30 p.m.), and the network will also show the first half of the film, "The Music Man" (9-11).

During most of this period, most of the established shows will be returning with new stories and, in many cases, converted to color. As if this were not confusing enough, there will also be a number of old shows seen in new time slots. It is a good week in which to study the program schedules carefully.

Batman Wrestles With the Script

HOLLYWOOD (AP) — Batman and Robin stood in front of the ornate fireplace of Gotham City's stock exchange board room trying to find a way to save the building from destruction.

A new villain, Minstrel — played by former boy-next-door Van Johnson — wanted money or threatened a big blast. But the problem at the moment was Batman's difficulty in navigating smoothly through one of those elaborate Bat-sentences.

"Gentlemen," said the senior member of the Dynamic Duo, "are you prepared to live in the shadow of this truthless... no, let's try it again. Gentlemen, are you prepared to live in the shadow of this rascally, ruthless tyrant..."

The twice-a-week program is

in production in a sound stage at Desilu's Culver City Studio. And at the moment, a pass to the set is undoubtedly the hottest ticket in town.

Demand, from presidents of sponsoring corporations to ordinary tourists, was so great that on two days a week visitors are permitted visits to the set strictly limited to one hour.

Those days still present problems because often the children — and it is a rare adult who has not been dragged there by a child — are often so young and uncomprehending that the sound track is likely to pick up a little voice piping "What's Batman doing now, daddy?" Then it must be re-shot.

The three little boys edged closer, pausing at a respectful distance, with their eyes glued on the faces of the super-heroes.

West, who as Batman has read so many fulsome lines with meaningful pauses that it has become his off-camera manner of speech, confessed to being a bit fatigued but expressed determination to push on with

TV's First His and Her Shows

HOLLYWOOD (AP) — Stefanie Powers, her long hair dripping, clothes wringing wet and bound with ropes thick enough to dock the Queen Mary, sat uncomfortably in a large, air-conditioned cave on the MGM lot Tuesday while, repeatedly, a heinous Thrush villain set a time bomb designed to destroy her.

In the nick of time — "Hurry, seconds to spare!" — in bounded a golden-haired fellow attired in something like a Boy Scout uniform. He shot off the rope that bound her. (sound to be added later) and the pair scurried off to safety.

And that, friends of television's good guys, is the way it is these days in NBC's new "Girl from U.N.C.L.E.," which with the original "Man from U.N.C.L.E." will constitute TV's first his-her programs.

Miss Powers, under ordinary circumstances a pretty young thing, plays the title role, an intrepid agent named April Dancer. Her companion in adventure is Noel Harrison, Rex's son, who was plucked from a nightclub singing career to play brave Mark Slate. His principal assignment seems to be rescuing April from horrendous plights.

Around the studio, there seems to be an opinion that

"Girl from U.N.C.L.E." is played a little more broadly if possible than the masculine original, but they are in effect twin shows — same creators, same writers and occasionally the stars of one series will turn up in the other.

Success of David McCallum in the senior series appears to have dictated the choice of Harrison as co-star in the new show. He, like McCallum, is slight and boyish looking but, where David assumes his Russian accent, Harrison is permitted to speak with his normal British accent.

Where David's shining blonde hair and bangs have gradually become more sleek and tidy, Noel's are on the shaggy side.

After Harrison finished rescuing Miss Powers to the satisfaction of the director, he discarded his revolver and took an hour lunch at the studio commissary. "I really don't know how the series is going," he said, "because I think it is difficult for anyone really to know when one is so closely involved, don't you?"
