R.R. Moves
Step Closer
To Merger

NEW HAVEN (AP)—The New Haven Railroad has taken another step on the path toward what its trustees hope will be an eventual merger with the Pennsylvania and New York Central Railroads.

The New Haven has been given federal court permission to file a reorganization plan with the Interstate Commerce Commission.

The reorganization plan was granted Monday by U.S. Circuit Judge Robert F. Anderson at which the New Haven trustees asked permission to proceed with presentation of the reorganization plan to the ICC.

At that meeting, strong mortgage bondholder opposition was expressed to the sale price of the New Haven Railroad and to its proposed inclusion in the merged Penn-Central system.

The sale price, estimated at about \$140 million plus shares of Penn-Central stock, was sold by some bondholders to be inadequate.

The New Haven's trustees have avoided giving precise estimates of the sale price and have said the final figure would depend on the value of stock at the time of closing.

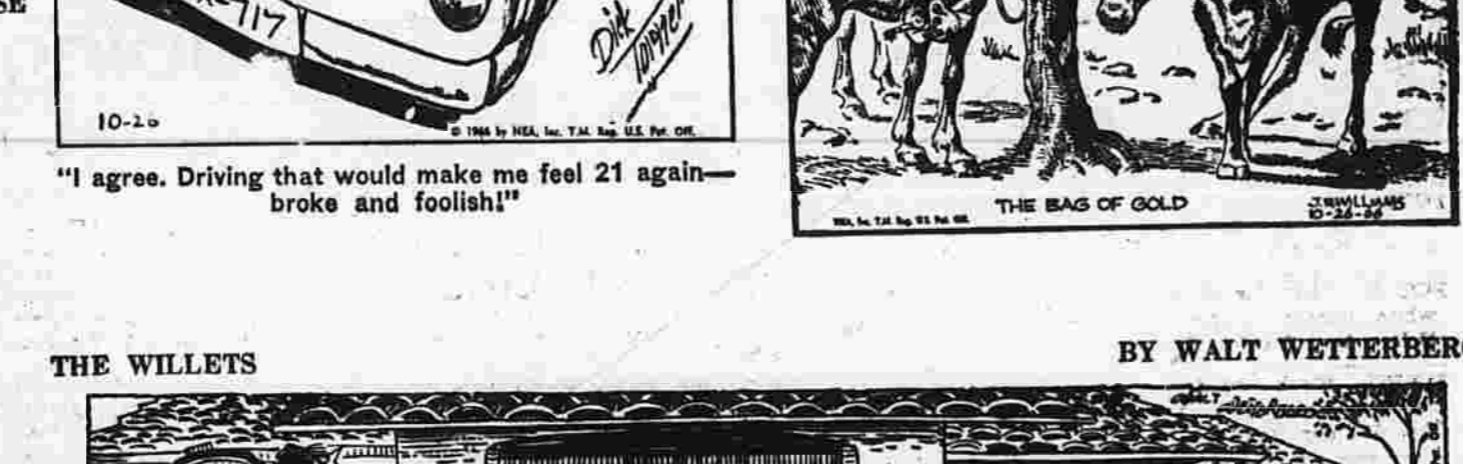
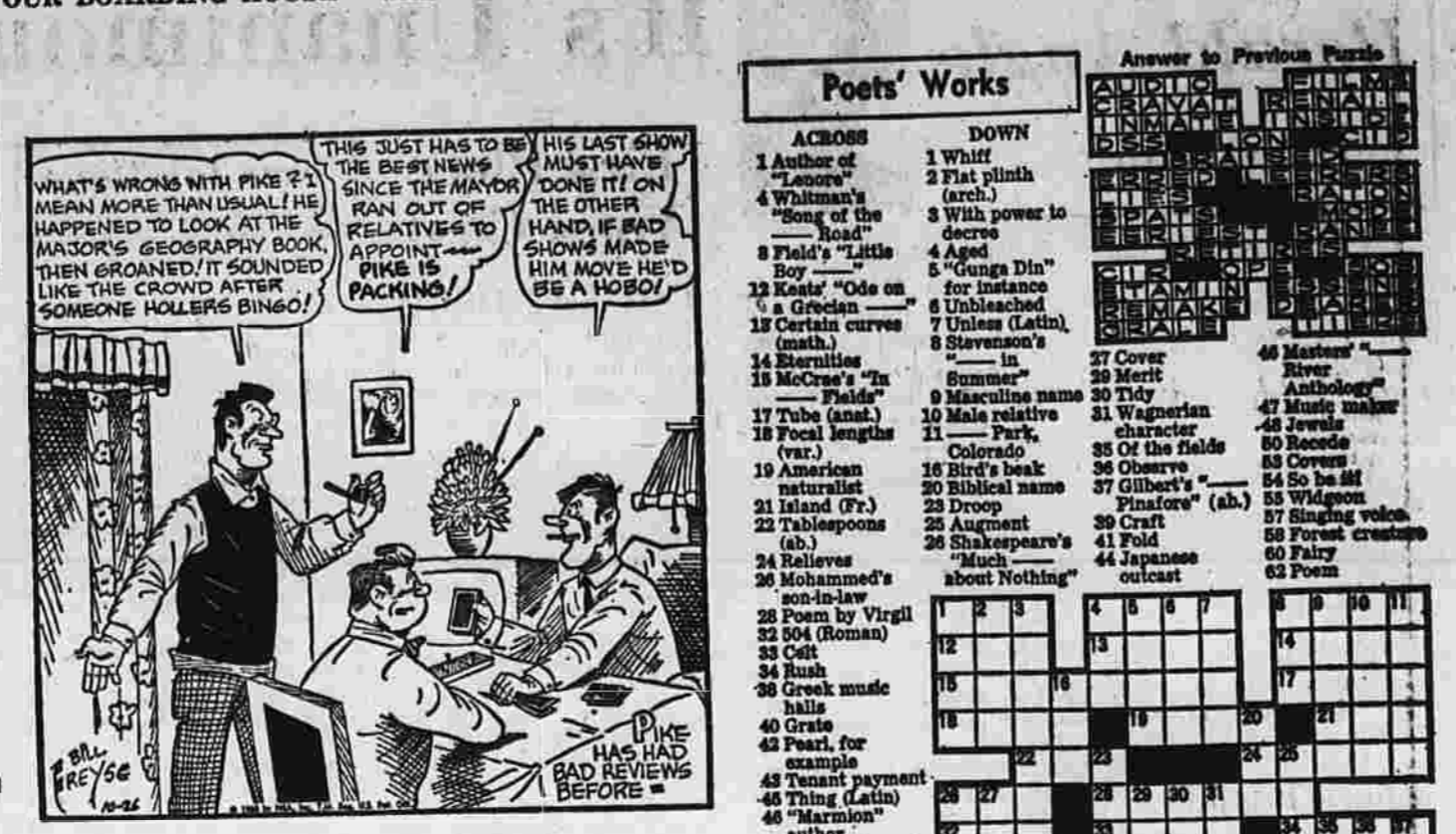
