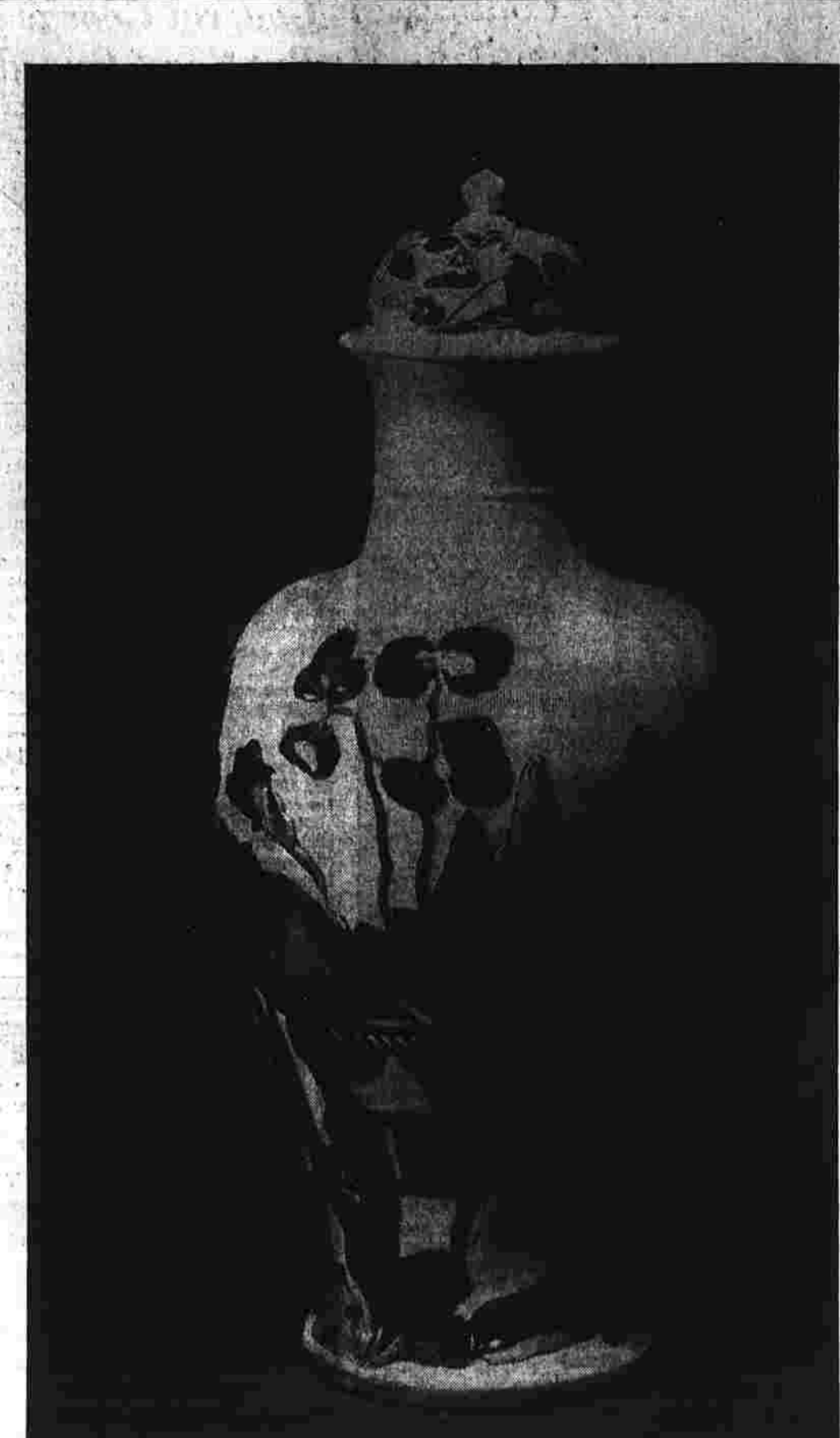

Now that, in modern and civilized times, the British no longer have unlimited exercise of conquest and reward of war after conquest, they do, really, have to look after the home fires and fashion themselves a little more coziness to retire to. A thermostat in the hall can take the most forbidding castle take on a ruddy glow, and added to other more traditional British assets, like mulligatawny, red currant jelly, and a good glass of port, they can have a most occasional dash of proper self-esteem, be close enough to warmth for comfort.

Rowland Evans Jr. and Robert D. Novak... WASHINGTON—Standing in the House Chamber during President Johnson's State of the Union message, presidential confidante, W. Marvin Watson Jr., got an earful from aggressive young Democratic congressmen about the alarming state of their party in the House.

White House Aide Watson thus became the transmission belt for an urgent message to President Johnson. The message was the direct sort of warning that if the President did not wake up to the fact that his party is close to anarchy in the House, his program will be ripped to shreds.

It is not a moment too soon. Routed in his first two encounters with the aggressive, high-spirited Republican minority, 75-year-old Speaker John McCormack of Massachusetts is badly out of touch with the House and no longer has massive Democratic majorities to compensate for it. Nor does he have the accustomed help from his able top assistant, Majority Leader Carl Albert of Oklahoma, who is forced to reduce his activity because of a heart attack last year.

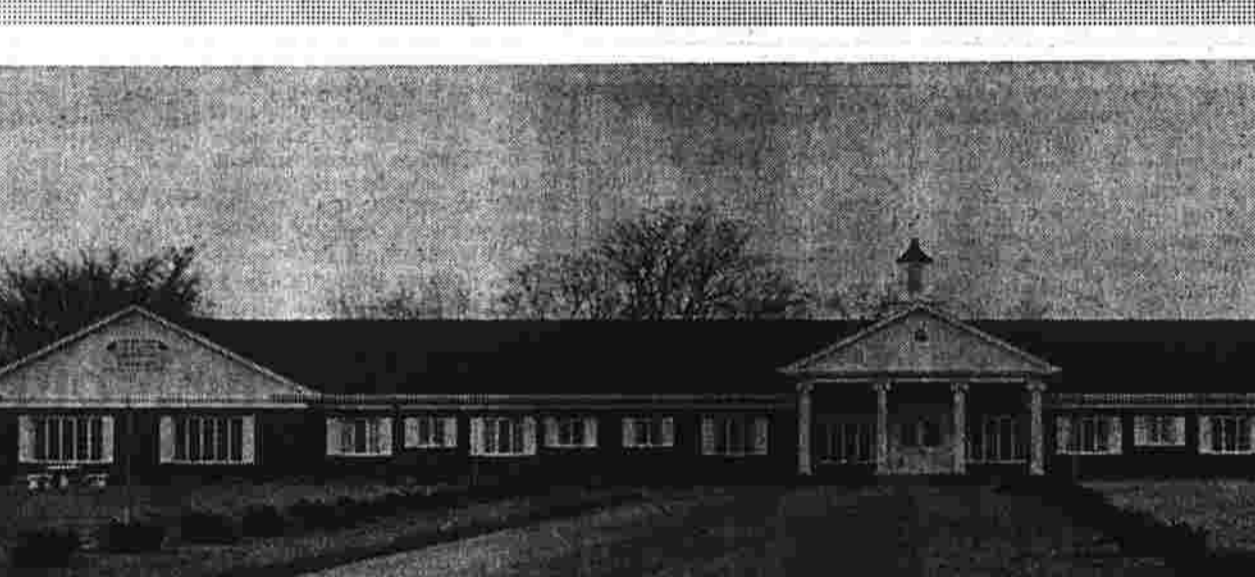

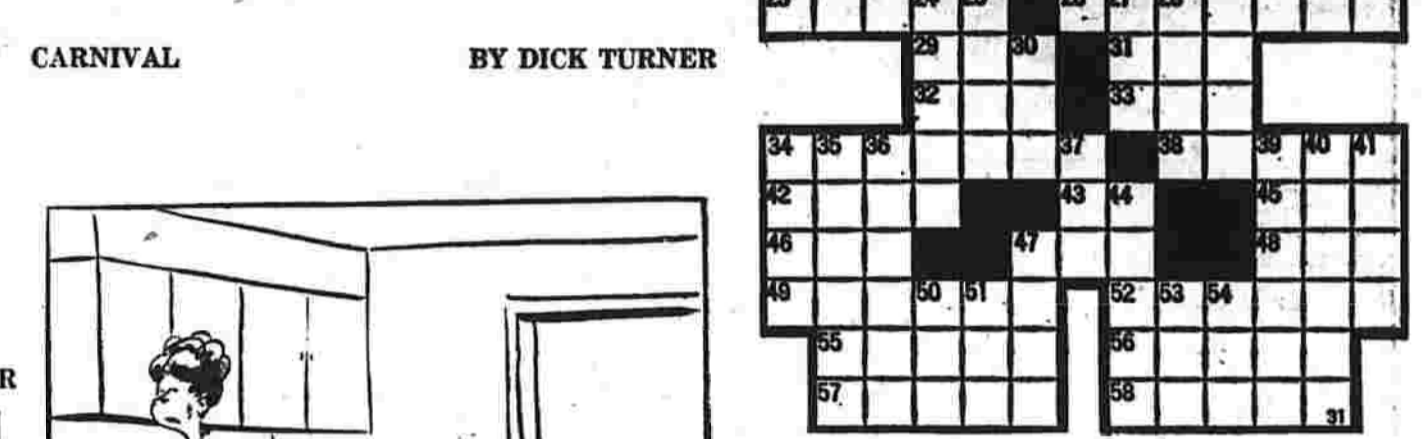
