No Threat Is Posed by Storm Edith

MIAMI, Fla. (AP) — Tropical storm Edith offered no immediate threat to any land areas today as it pursued a west-northwest course toward 1,000 miles east southeast of Miami.

High winds were only about 50 miles per hour over a small area near the center, with gale forces reaching out 100 miles to the north and 80 miles to the south. The fifth tropical storm of the season was centered at 6 a.m. (EDT) near latitude 14.4 North and longitude 84.7 West, or about 80 miles east northeast of Barbados, Windward Islands, and 80 miles east southeast of San Juan, Puerto Rico.

The great turbulent mass moved toward the west-northwest at about 12 m.p.h. The Weather Bureau said, "Little change is indicated in direction of movement for the next 12 hours."

Manned Flight Delayed
WASHINGTON (AP) — The flight of the first manned Apollo spacecraft has been postponed again, possibly until next summer.

Officials indicated the delays are linked with modifications of the spacecraft which were decided on after three astronauts were killed in a launchpad fire last January.

NASA said it is discussing a revision of the spacecraft's delivery date with North American Aviation, Inc., the Apollo prime contractor.

Delivery had been expected around the first of the year. NASA said it will not be possible to set a laundry date until the new delivery time is set.

Red Embassy Set
WASHINGTON (AP) — The 13-acre site of an unused veterans' hospital reportedly has been accepted as the location for a new and larger Soviet embassy, a move which may clear the way for construction of a new American embassy in Moscow.

Each nation has been working in cramped quarters in the other's capital.

Soviet Foreign Minister Andrei Gromyko, the Washington Post reported today, told Secretary of State Dean Rusk the site of the old Mount Alto Veterans' Hospital, now being razed, will be suitable for the building of an embassy to replace the Soviets' present modest-sized chancery in downtown Washington.

Late last week the State Department said the Soviets had offered an apparently suitable 9.8 acre site for a new U.S. embassy. It is located behind the present outgrown quarters in a former apartment building.

Homosexual Study
WASHINGTON (AP) — The National Institute of Mental Health, quoting estimates that "four per cent of the adult men in this country are exclusively homosexual," has named a 12-member task force to do research on the condition.

Group members have been drawn from the fields of psychology, anthropology, sociology, psychiatry, law and the clergy. It is headed by Dr. Evelyn Hooker, a research psychologist on the staff of the University of California at Los Angeles.

Dr. Stanley F. Yulies, director of the institute, in announcing formation of the task force, said homosexuality "presents a social problem of considerable magnitude and one which has been somewhat neglected by scientists, partially due to the stigma which attaches to work in the field."
