Communist Defector's Book Doesn't Blame Party, Stalin

Enemies, said her interrogator, "are not people—we're allowed to do what we like with them." And so, for one Soviet woman, began what she called a "geography of madness," not only for herself but for hundreds of thousands of her compatriots—years of fantastic horror, cruel suffering, inhuman torture, presided over by Stalin's secret police, the NKVD.

But there is another kind of horror in this stark account of the great Soviet purge. It is that so many of Stalin's victims, even in the depths of their torment and degradation, still loved Stalin, still refused to blame him for the ocean of insanity which engulfed a vast nation.

The author of "Journey into the Whirlwind," published by Harcourt, Brace & World, Inc., Eugenia Semionovna Ginzburg, herself blamed Stalin. But unlike the Stalin's daughter, Svetlana Alliluyeva, Mrs. Ginzburg would not place blame on the Communist party or the Soviet system for the terrible hell she describes through the eyes of one who suffered through 18 years of it.

Mrs. Alliluyeva, as a defector from communism, noted in a New York television interview in October that "not much has changed in the last 50 years" in Russia. Mrs. Ginzburg, released from a living death in 1955, two years after Stalin died, concluded that "great Leninist truths" have come into their own in our country and party, today people can be told of things that were the beginning of the worst. That was the year of the purge trials. She was wrong. People out of imprisonment in exile of tens of thousands of army officers, tens

of thousands of party members, tens of thousands of others who had no politics at all.

Mrs. Ginzburg's turn came in February, when she was expelled from the party, arrested and interrogated as an "agent of international imperialism." To her astonishment, her interrogator told her "it is known to the investigators that you belonged to a secret terrorist organization among the editorial staff of Red Party." They sent her off to the cellar of Black Lake Prison, and swarmed to confess all.

Before embarking her in solitary confinement, they made her fill out the inevitable bureaucratic form. "It seemed I needed one even to get into hell," she wrote.

And hell it was for her and the swarms of other women cast into the lightless dungeons with her. There were sophisticated forms of torture: the "standing cell," in which the walled-in prisoner, in a tiny cubicle below ground, could only stand upright with arms at her side; the "conveyor belt," in which prisoners were interrogated for days and nights without food or sleep, by shifts of NKVD men, until the victims would, in delirium, sign any wild accusation at all. There was filth, and the worst of all, the execution of the innocent.

And there were the Olympian ironies. Stalin, in his mad quest for power, purged the purgers. Henryk Yagoda, the NKVD chief, went to his doom and Nikolai Yezhov took his place. The frightful regime spilled the blood of untold thousands and sent other untold thousands and sent other untold thousands north. There was the execution of Yezhov himself and the rise of Lavrenty Beria as Stalin's final hangman.

And for Mrs. Ginzburg, in the depth of nowhere in Kólyma, there was the cold satisfaction of seeing her original NKVD tormentor, the major who con-
