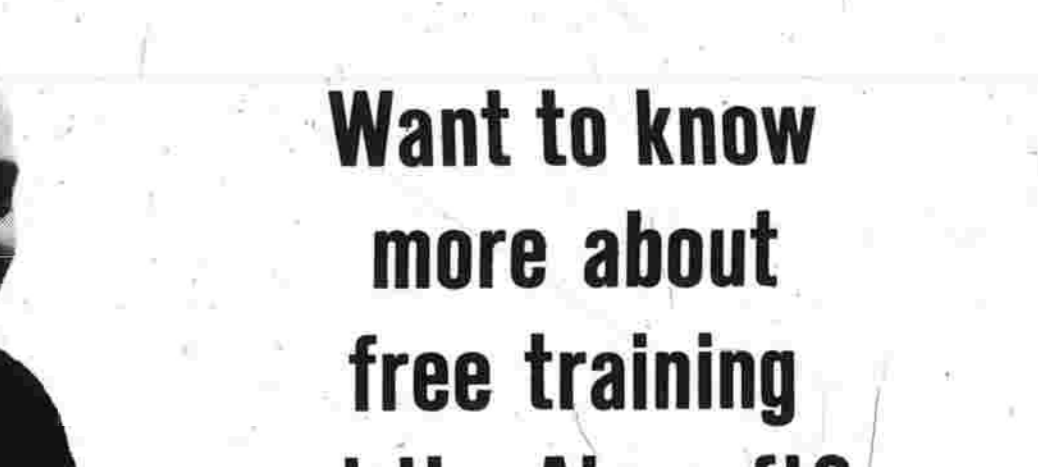

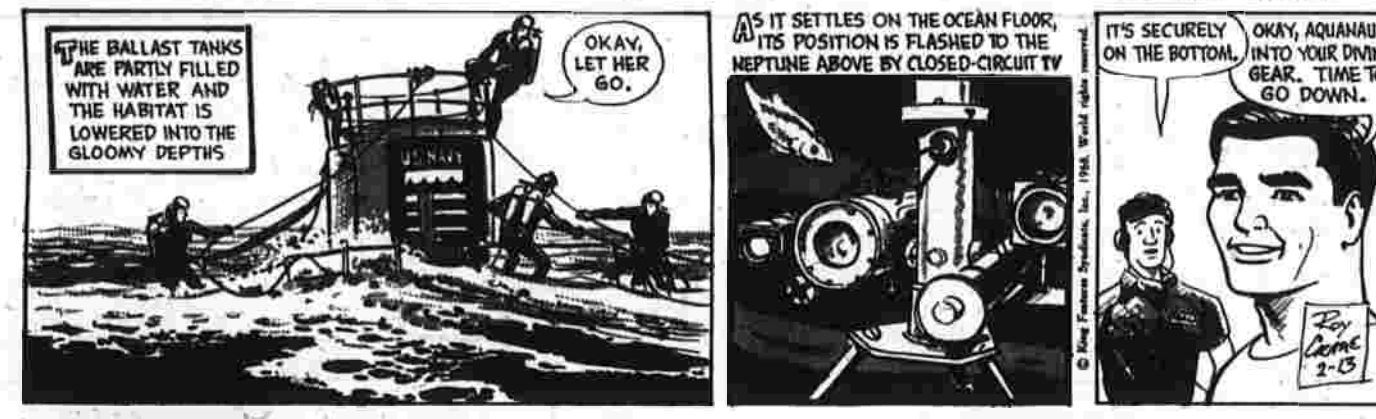

Col. David O. Williams Jr., of Eagle Pass, Tex., and Lt. James P. Feighly, 25, of Fort Walton Beach, Fla., were credited with one of the kills. Maj. Rex S. Howerton, 33, of Phoenix, Ariz., and 1st Lt. Ted L. Voigt II, 25, of Nelsonville, Ohio, were credited with the other.

The U.S. Command said that during strikes against North Vietnam Tuesday, Air Force and Navy bombers attacked the airfield six miles southwest of Haiphong, the Hai Thung field, 70 miles south of Hanoi, and the Vinh airfield 140 miles north of the demilitarized zone.

Navy pilots reported leaving a large hole in the center of the Hai Thung runway, but heavy overcast prevented assessment of damage at the other two fields.
